


Hazardous Weather



Much of our Four-State area is highlighted in a Marginal to Slight Risk of excessive rainfall for both Tuesday and Wednesday of this week as multiple rounds of showers and isolated thunderstorms are expected. Total rainfall amounts will generally range between 2-4 inches for most areas with lesser amounts north and west of the I-30 corridor. Keep in mind that locally higher amounts will be possible in the circled area. Light freezing rain or a mix of freezing rain is expected late tonight across the southern TX Panhandle and adjacent portions of the South Plains and Rolling Plains, which may result in light ice accumulation and slippery roads. A cold rain is expected elsewhere.




A High Wind Warning is in effect from late this evening to early Wednesday evening for the Guadalupe and Delaware Mountains.




Fire Danger Forecast



Burn Ban




Keetch-Byram Drought Index
