





The cold air is already here!! High temperatures will be in the teens and 20's, but they certainly won't feel like it. Here's a chart showing how cold it will feel throughout the next couple of days. Have a plan to stay warm when spending time outdoors!




A Cold Weather Advisory is in effect midnight Tuesday night through noon Wednesday. Wind chills will range from the single digits to around 20 degrees. Protect people, plants, pets and pipes.



As the Arctic front moves through North and Central Texas today, there will be a potential for light freezing drizzle/rain. Icy conditions could begin as early as midday across western portions of North Texas, with temperature falling below freezing across the I-35 corridor by early this evening. Minimal accumulations of ice may still pose a travel hazard, especially to bridges and overpasses.



Sharply colder has arrived early this morning and will continue through at least Thursday with the potential for dangerous wind chills area-wide and light wintry precipitation in the north. An Extreme Cold Warning is in effect for the entire area from Tuesday night through Thursday morning. Continue to watch our forecasts for the latest updates!



Hazardous cold morning/overnight temperatures are anticipated Tuesday niaht through **Thursday** morning. Wind chills as low as zero to -5 are expected for much of the Permian Basin. Wind chills from zero to 10 degrees are expected southwestern parts of the Permian Basin in west Texas, much of the Trans-Pecos, and Lea County in New Mexico. Bundle up in multiple layers and stay warm!





Frigid air and breezy winds will lead to dangerous wind chill values today through Thursday across Oklahoma and into western north Texas. The coldest wind chill values will be Wednesday morning due to breezier winds with values as low as -15 to -25 degrees across north and central Oklahoma and values as low -10 to -15 degrees across southern Oklahoma and western north Texas.



An Extreme Cold Warning is in effect for all of west-central Texas, from Tuesday evening until Noon on Thursday. Temperatures during the overnight into the morning hours are expected to be in the single digits and teens, with wind chill readings as cold as zero to -10 at times.






