



# State of Texas Weather Threat Brief

March 3, 2025 (Update)

## Situation Overview

- Critical to extreme (levels 2-3 of 3) fire weather conditions today through Tuesday for portions western/central/south-central TX and the Panhandle.
   Significant fires more likely with a moderate to high chance of wildfire outbreak.
   Wildfire threat will return Thursday and Friday across W TX.
- Slight to enhanced risk (levels 2-3 of 5) of severe weather late tonight through Tuesday across northern TX into east TX. Several tornadoes, scattered to numerous severe wind gusts and large hail possible.
- Marginal to Slight risk (levels 1-2 of 4) for heavy rainfall leading to flash flooding today and Tuesday in Regions 2, 3.
- Minor river flooding will continue in E Texas. Rain not expected to create significant river flooding, but may lead to new minor river rises.

Tuesday: Slight to enhanced risk (levels 2-3 of 5) for Regions 2, 3, 4, 8

#### Flash Flooding:

Monday: Marginal risk (level 1 of 4) for Region 2







- High wind watches, warnings, and advisories today into Tuesday for gusts of 50-70 mph
- Red flag warnings and fire weather watches today into Tuesday for critical to extreme conditions


























## Overnight RH Recovery - Max Relative Humidity















## Wind Gusts Outlook







- Gusts of 40-60 mph today.





Greatest risk for severe weather across north TX will be after midnight. Impacts to DFW Metro could occur during morning commute.







• Large hail, damaging winds, and a few tornadoes are possible.





## Tomorrow's Rainfall & Flash Flood Threat Areas









## Potential Evolution of Storms Tomorrow




Medium chance of new / renewed minor river flooding for tributaries of the Sabine, Neches, and Upper Trinity river basins


