





Elevated fire danger will occur across northwest Oklahoma this afternoon, due to gusty winds combined with RH values in the mid to upper teens.






Gusty northwest winds 15 to 20 mph expected with gusts as high as 30 mph.




Near Critical Fire Weather conditions are expected across south central Texas today due to dry air and occasionally gusty north winds. A Rangeland Fire Danger Statement remains in effect from 9 AM until 3 PM for north winds of 10 to 15 mph with gusts to 20 mph and minimum relative humidity values of 15 to 25%.


