A Fire Danger Statement is in effect from 1 PM today to 8 PM tonight for much of the Brush Country due to the combination of southeasterly winds 15-20 mph with gusts around 25 mph, extremely dry fuels, and minimum relative humidity values as low as 23%.



Another round of elevated to near critical fire weather fire weather conditions is expected today due to dry air and breezy winds over the Hill Country and southern Edwards Plateau. Avoid outdoor burning if possible. A Rangeland Fire Danger Statement is in effect from 1 PM to 7 PM today for southern Edwards Plateau and Hill Country, including Williamson County.



A Red Flag Warning will be in effect today from 11 AM to 5 PM. Relative humidity values will fall into the teens across most of west central Texas as winds increase from the southwest at 15 to 25 mph with gusts up to 40 mph. This will provide critical fire weather conditions.



Near critical fire weather conditions are expected on Saturday afternoon for southeast New Mexico and the Permian Basin. Be sure to avoid activities with open sparks and obey local burn bans!




Burn Ban

Keetch-Byram Drought Index


