A cold front will bring scattered thunderstorms to parts of Central and East Texas late Sunday afternoon into Sunday evening. A few storms could be strong to severe with large hail and gusty winds.



South winds and increasing cloud cover will persist today ahead of an approaching cold front, pushing high temperatures into the upper 70s to lower 80s. The cold front will advance farther southeast into the region tonight with strong to severe storms possible, mainly south of I-30.

Hazardous Weather






Forecast Fire Danger








Burn Ban



Keetch-Byram Drought Index


