## Storm Chances Saturday, Clearing Sunday



## Flash Flood Risk



### Details:

- Heavy rainfall is expected with storms this morning.
- The severe weather threat will gradually diminish through the early morning hours.
- The thunderstorm complex is forecast to slow down, governing a heightened risk for flash flooding.



- 4 - HIGH**  
Widespread and severe flash floods expected. This magnitude of flooding is very rare.
- 3 - MODERATE**  
Numerous flash floods likely with some significant events possible.
- 2 - SLIGHT**  
Scattered flash floods possible. Mainly localized. A few isolated significant flash floods possible.
- 1 - MARGINAL**  
Isolated flash floods possible. Mainly a result of rapid runoff and confined to poor-drainage areas.



 This morning through 7PM this evening.






# Keetch-Byram Drought Index


