- <u>Severe Weather</u>: Today, enhanced risk (level 3 of 5) risk for C/ETX, SEAR, N/W LA. Marginal (level I of 5) risk in far STX Saturday. Slight risk (level 2 of 5) in SWTX Monday.
- Flash Flooding: Today slight risk (level 2 of 4) for SE OK, AR, C/ETX, N/W LA. Marginal risk (level 1 of 4) for Far STX, SE LA Saturday and E NM, TX Panhandle Sunday. Slight risk Monday in E NM, **TX/OK** Panhandles, **NWTX**, then shifting east Tuesday into Thursday across the ArkLaTex.
- Fire Weather: Elevated to critical (levels I-2 of 3) Sunday afternoon in SW NM and elevated (level I of 3) in S NM, W TX Monday.
- <u>River Flooding</u>: Moderate to isolated major flooding across OK and NTX through Saturday. Through May 7th, isolated major flooding in SE LA.



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

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

Slight risk (level 2 of 4) for flash flooding for SE OK,AR, C/ETX, N/W LA.




Today's Tornado & Severe Wind / Hail Probabilities



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

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

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

Tomorrow's Tornado & Severe Wind / Hail Probabilities



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

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






Porecast Rainfall
