



A low pressure system is forecast to remain across the Western United States for early next week. This pattern will allow moisture to surge northward across the High Plains which will lead to daily chances for heavy rainfall across the Panhandles. This excess rainfall could eventually add up and lead to flooding and flash flooding issues. At this time best chances continue to trend for Monday into Tuesday. However, there are still a lot of uncertainties when it comes to exact amounts, so make sure to check back with us over this weekend!



## Keetch-Byram Drought Index


