
Thunderstorms will be possible late this afternoon through the evening. Some storms may be strong to severe with primary hazards being guarter size hail and strong winds up to 60 mph.



Severe thunderstorms will be possible late morning/early afternoon and again late tonight. Large hail and damaging wind gusts will be the two potential hazards. The tornado risk will be very low.



Storms will develop to our west in the afternoon and progress east towards our area through this evening.



Highs remain at least 10 degrees above average today and tomorrow, with afternoon/evening storms possible during the afternoon and evening. Highest chance of storms on the leeward side of the Davis Mountains into Stockton Plateau and Permian Basin. Main threats with any strong to severe storms are damaging winds and large hail.




