

Severe Weather Outlook Tuesday, May 27, 2025

Hazardous Weather



Another round of showers and storms is forecast to develop late Tuesday afternoon and evening along the Rio Grande and move east Tuesday night. Isolated to scattered severe thunderstorms are possible, with the greatest risk in the yellow highlighted area. The primary hazards with any severe storms are large to very hail and damaging winds. An isolated tornado or two is also possible. In addition, isolated to scattered instances of flash flooding are possible.


Strong to severe thunderstorms are expected to develop Tuesday evening over east Mexico and the Del Rio region and progress eastward across through the region late Tuesday night, clearing the coast by Wednesday morning. Environmental conditions favor a primary threat for large hail with diameters potentially up to 2", followed by damaging winds greater than 60 mph and a low chance for tornadoes (2%).



There is a slight (Level 2 of 5) risk of severe thunderstorms this afternoon and evening, mainly across the Stockton Plateau and lower Trans Pecos. Any severe storms that do develop will be accompanied by large hail and/or damaging winds and/or an isolated tornado. Have multiple ways to receive warnings and shelter immediately if a warning is issued.

Strong to severe thunderstorms are expected to develop over the Fort Stockton area and progress eastward across the Northern Edwards Plateau, and portions of the Concho Valley and Northwest Hill Country this afternoon and into the overnight hours.






Keetch-Byram Drought Index

Keetch-Byram Drought Index


