


Another period of strong to severe storms is forecast for Late Tuesday afternoon into the early morning hours Wednesday. Isolated severe storms could form over parts of Llano and Burnet Counties as early as the late afternoon hours Tuesday. Then in the evening hours, a developing squall line is possible with storm focus shifting south into the rest of the Hill Country, Edwards Plateau, and the I-35 corridor areas near and north of Austin through late Tuesday night.



Isolated to scattered dryline storms are likely west of I-35 late this afternoon and evening with primarily a large hail threat and a very low tornado threat. A more widespread round of showers and storms will push through North and Central Texas along a cold front later tonight into Wednesday morning with primarily a damaging wind and locally heavy rainfall threat. Make sure to have multiple ways to receive warnings!


Severe thunderstorms will be possible this afternoon into this evening across the Rolling Plains with large hail and damaging wind gusts.







### **Burn Ban**




## **Keetch-Byram Drought Index**
