
to severe storms across the Panhandles. Any storms

that are severe could have large hail and damaging


winds as the primary hazards.

Scattered thunderstorms may develop along a weak cold front near the Red River this evening. A few of these storms could be severe with a threat for damaging wind gusts and large hail. The most likely timing for the severe weather threat will be between 7 PM and 3 AM.

SEVER



There is an increasing risk of severe weather this weekend, mainly along and north of I-20 late this afternoon into the evening and overnight hours. The higher risk categories expand farther south by late Sunday into Sunday night as multiple thunderstorm complexes are expected to impact the region this weekend.



Summertime heat is expected this weekend with heat index values topping 110 in some areas. Be careful if spending time outdoors and be sure to stay hydrated.




