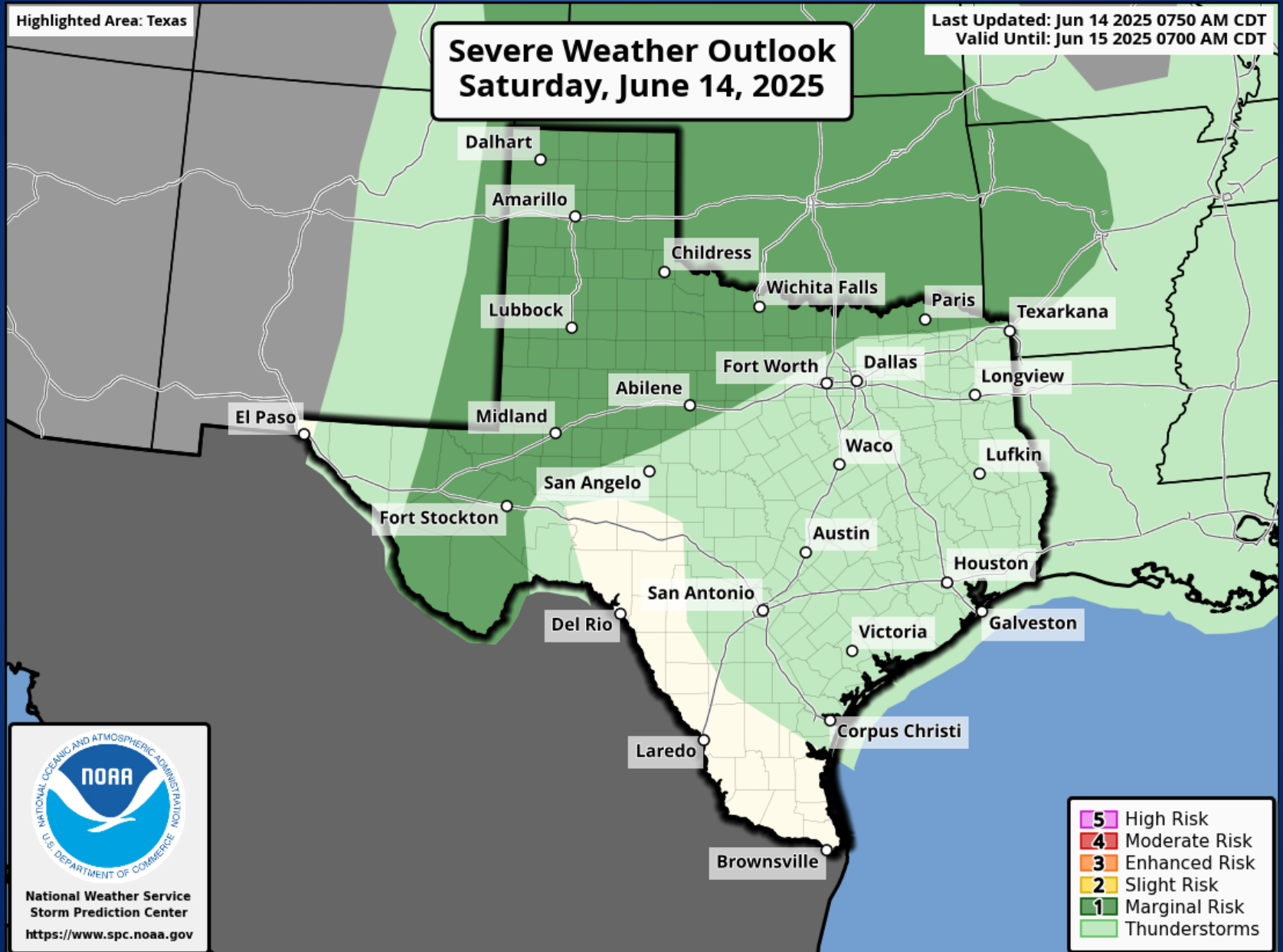

We could see a few rounds of severe thunderstorms on Saturday. Storms could form into a line of storms Saturday morning and sweep across north/central Oklahoma this morning before exiting early afternoon. Then, another round of severe thunderstorms could develop along an outflow boundary this evening and into early Sunday morning.

Today

The risk for flash flooding will remain through the afternoon as scattered thundershowers lay down additional precipitation over areas with well saturated soils from antecedent rainfall

Turn around and don't drown if you come across flooded roadways.

Low lying areas near bayous, creeks, and streams may flood if repeated or training thunderstorms occur.

Scattered Showers & Storms Expected Through the Day

Key Messages

- Another round of showers, some locally heavy and storms are expected on Saturday
- Rain and storm chances will be increasing after mid-morning, continuing into the afternoon
- Localized flooding potential, especially along roadways, low-lying areas or locations with poor drainage

Potential Impacts

- Locally heavy rain, resulting in minor flooding
- Strong gusty winds and frequent lightning

Actions

- If you encounter flooded areas, please, do not attempt to drive through them!
- Check the forecast for updates!

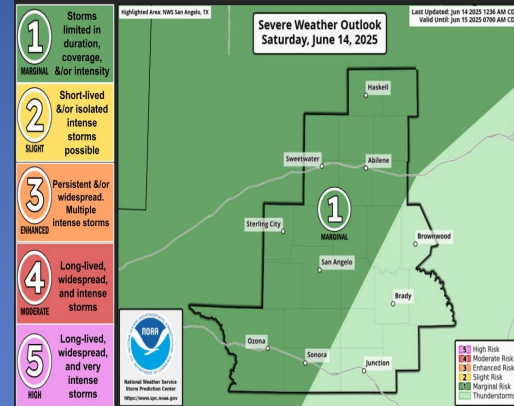

Highest Local Risk: **Marginal** (Risk Level 1 out of 5)



There is a marginal risk for severe thunderstorms across much of the Big Country, Concho Valley, and Northern Edwards Plateau this afternoon/evening. Large hail & wind gusts to 50-60 mph will be possible if any severe thunderstorms develop and move into West Central Texas.

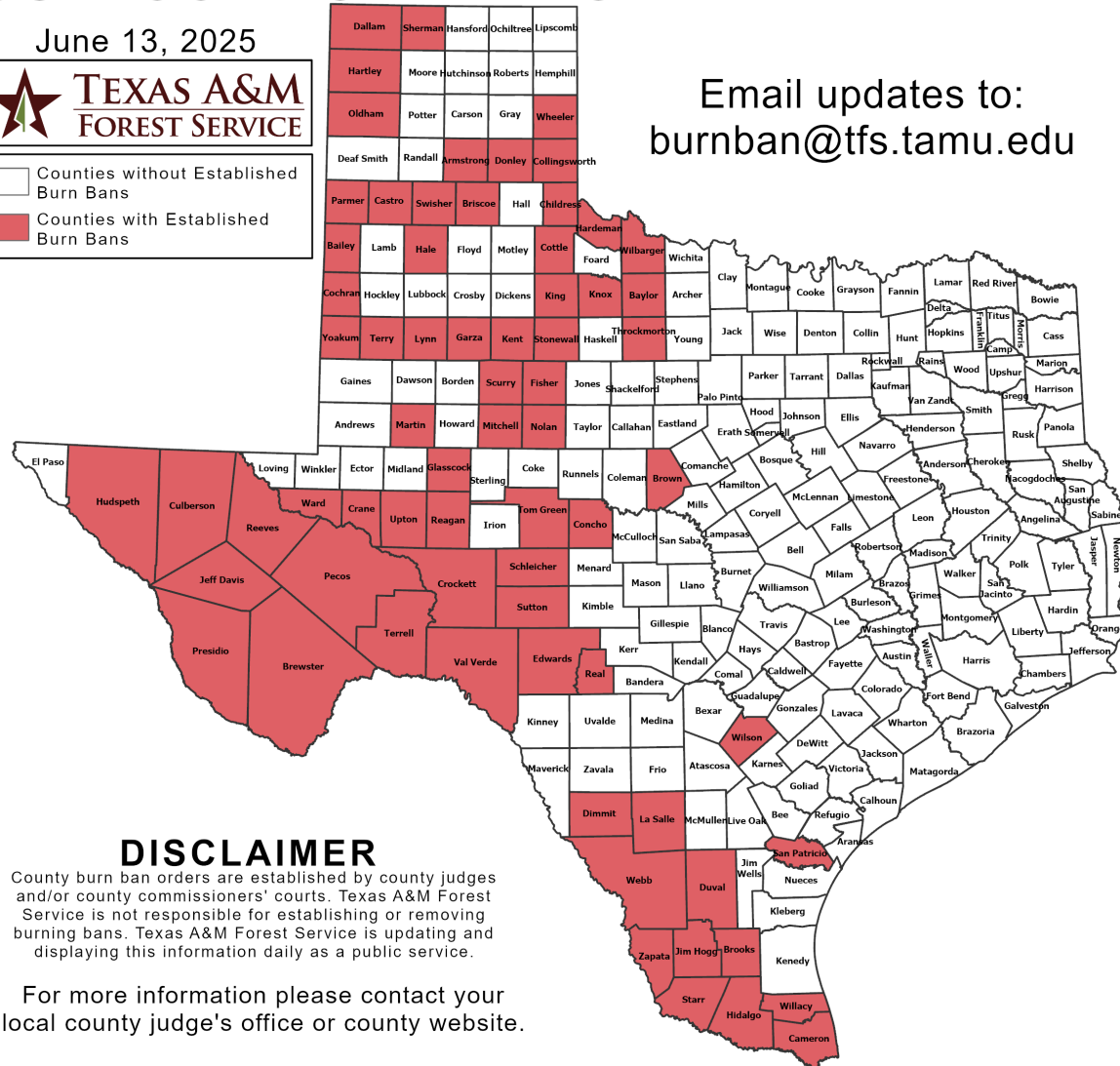

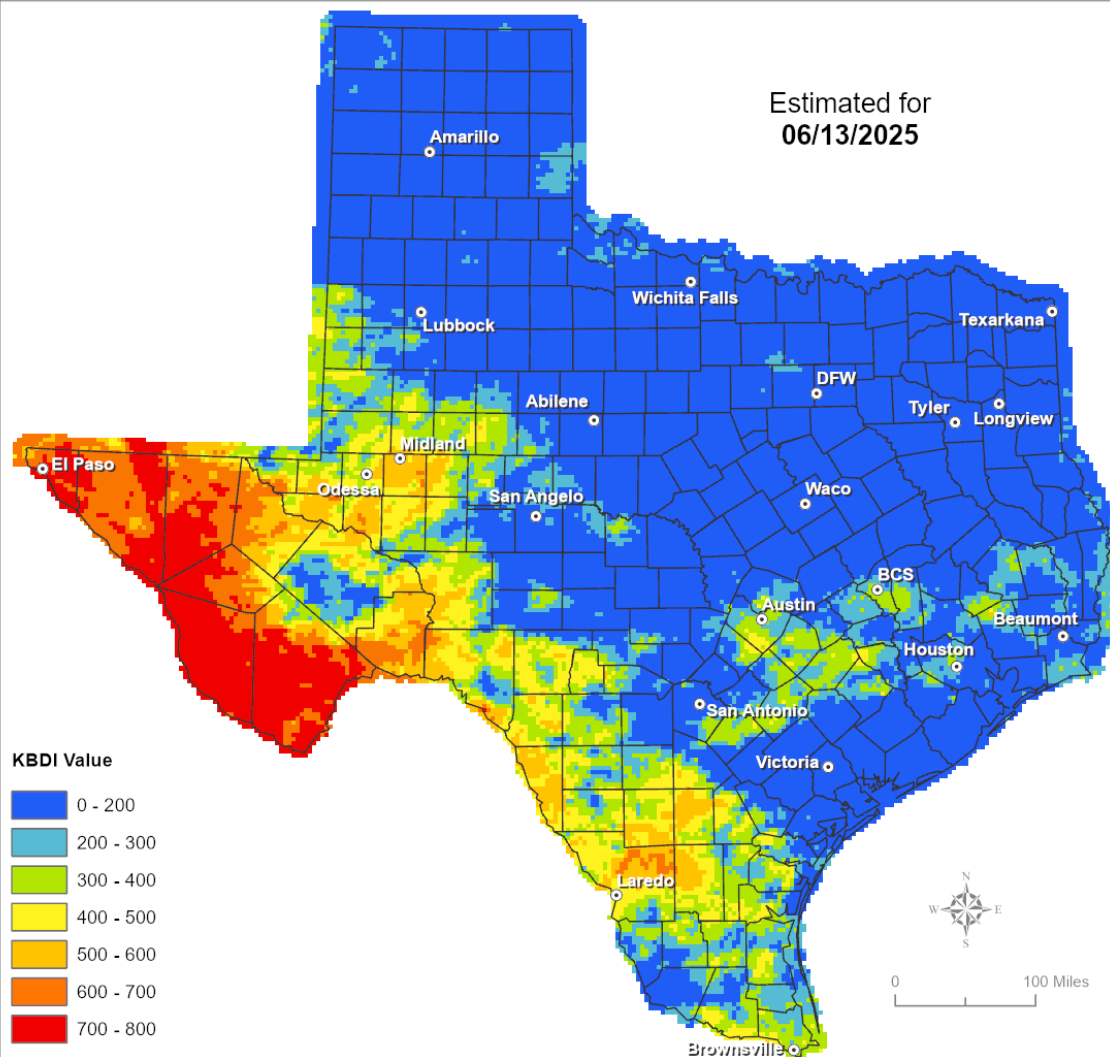

Keetch-Byram Drought Index

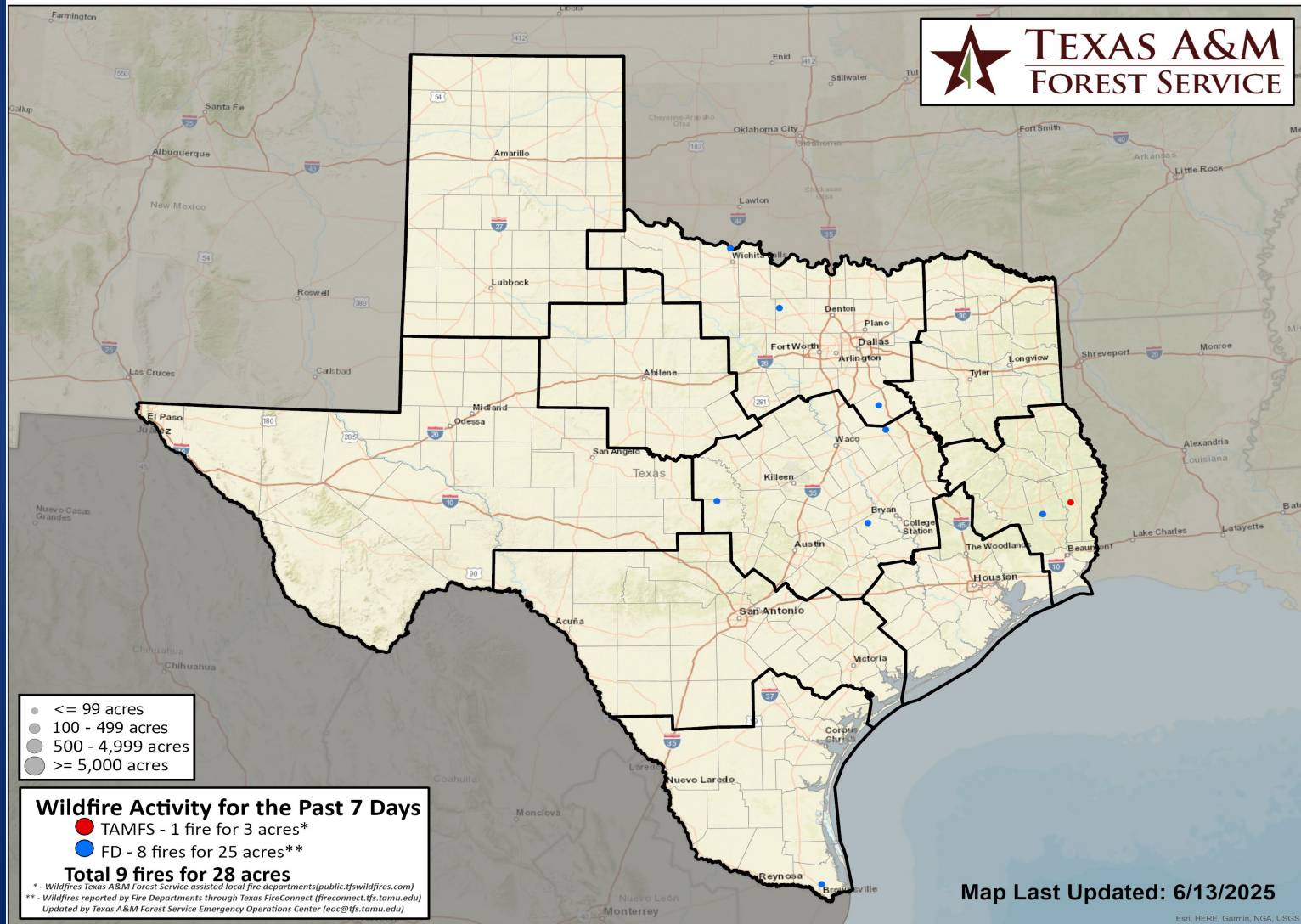
