Storms Again Today

Storms most likely near the coast and east/northeast

Key Messages

- → Scattered storms should develop along the coast this morning.
- As the day progresses, we'll see these showers and storms shift further inland.
- → Some strong storms and some localized, heavy downpours are a possibility.
- Marginal (level 1/4) risk of excessive rainfall.
 Areas around Matagorda bay still prone to flash flooding due to recent heavy rains.

Potential Impacts

- → Localized, minor street flooding.
- → 25-50 mph wind gusts.
- → Small hail.





Fire Danger Forecast




Burn Ban





Report of 342 (No Change) fires and 85,017 (No Change) acres have been burned this year. There are 68 (-1) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 25 (+2) counties with an average over 400.
