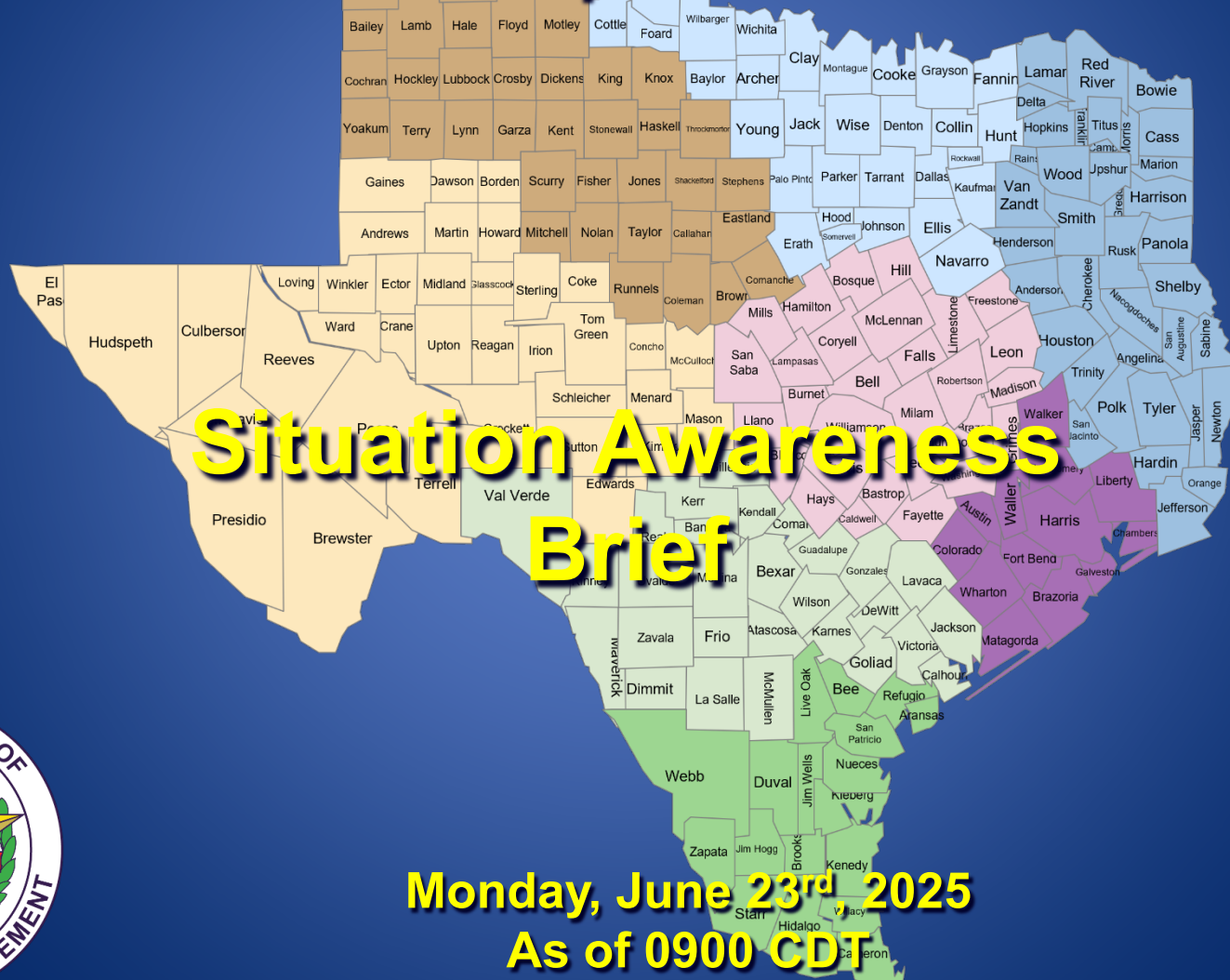

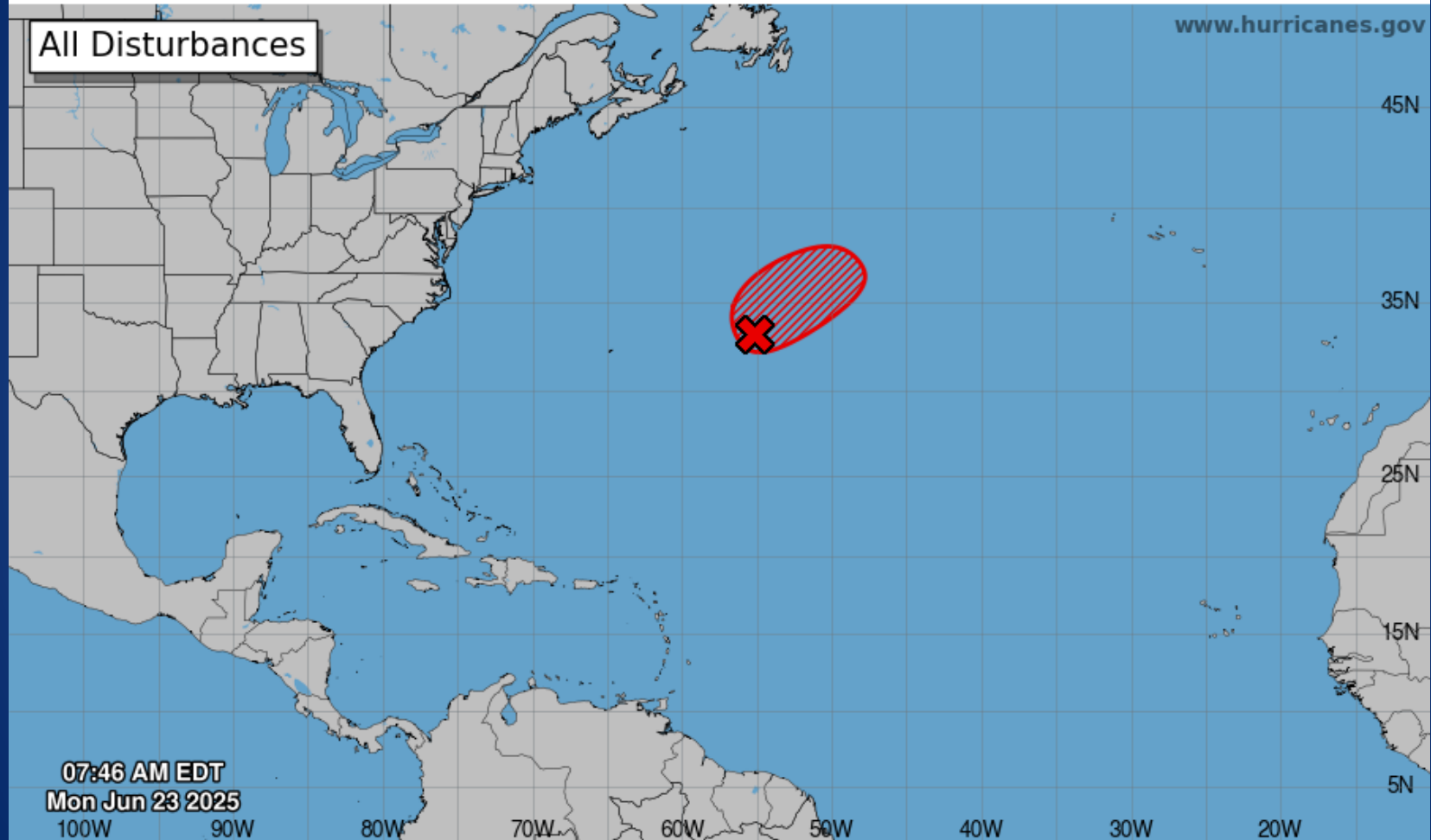
Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

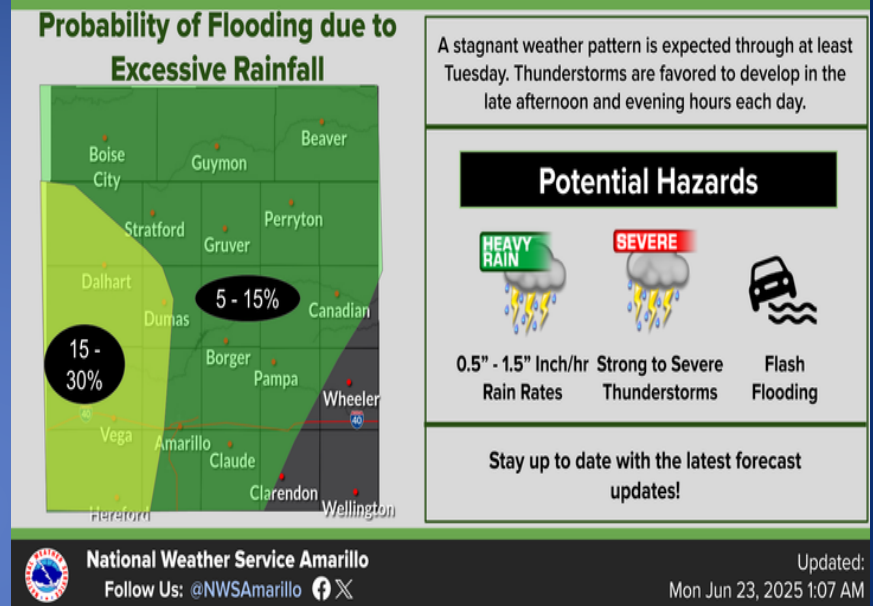
Hazardous Weather

Severe Thunderstorm Chances Today



We will be watching the potential for a few marginally severe thunderstorms this afternoon and evening. Damaging winds are the primary risk along with low hail potential.

Heavy Rain Potential Through Tuesday



A stagnant weather pattern is expected through at least Tuesday. Thunderstorms are favored to develop in the late afternoon hours and continue into at least a portion of the evening. Thunderstorms, along with heavy rainfall rates from repeat rounds of rain could lead to localized flooding or flash flooding. Please check back for updates throughout this forecast period.

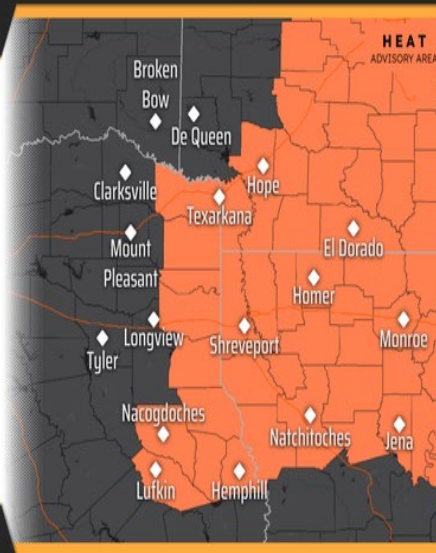

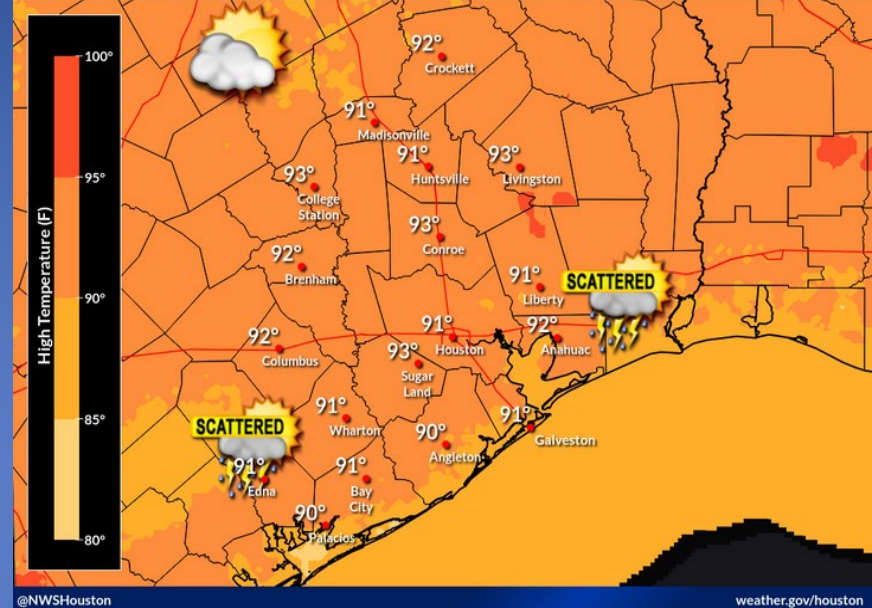

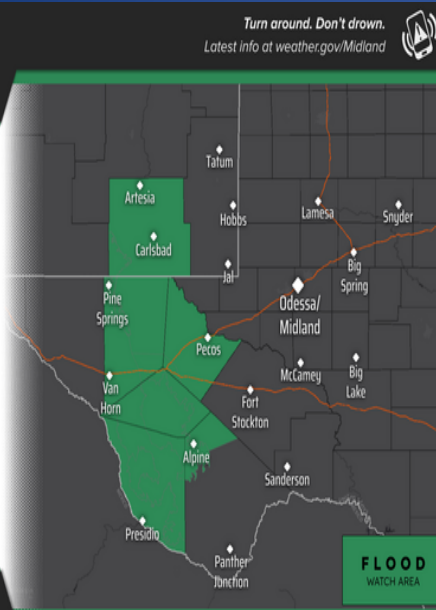

A Flood Watch remains in effect through this evening for western portions of the area. Many of these locations could see additional rainfall totals between 0.5 and 1.5 inches, with much higher totals locally. Remember to turn around, don't drown!

A Flash Flood Watch is in effect for Otero, Hudspeth and eastern El Paso Counties for today through Wednesday evening. There is a good chance that we will see heavy rains of 1 to 3 inches over the next several days, which could lead to flash flooding, especially locations in and near recent burn scars.

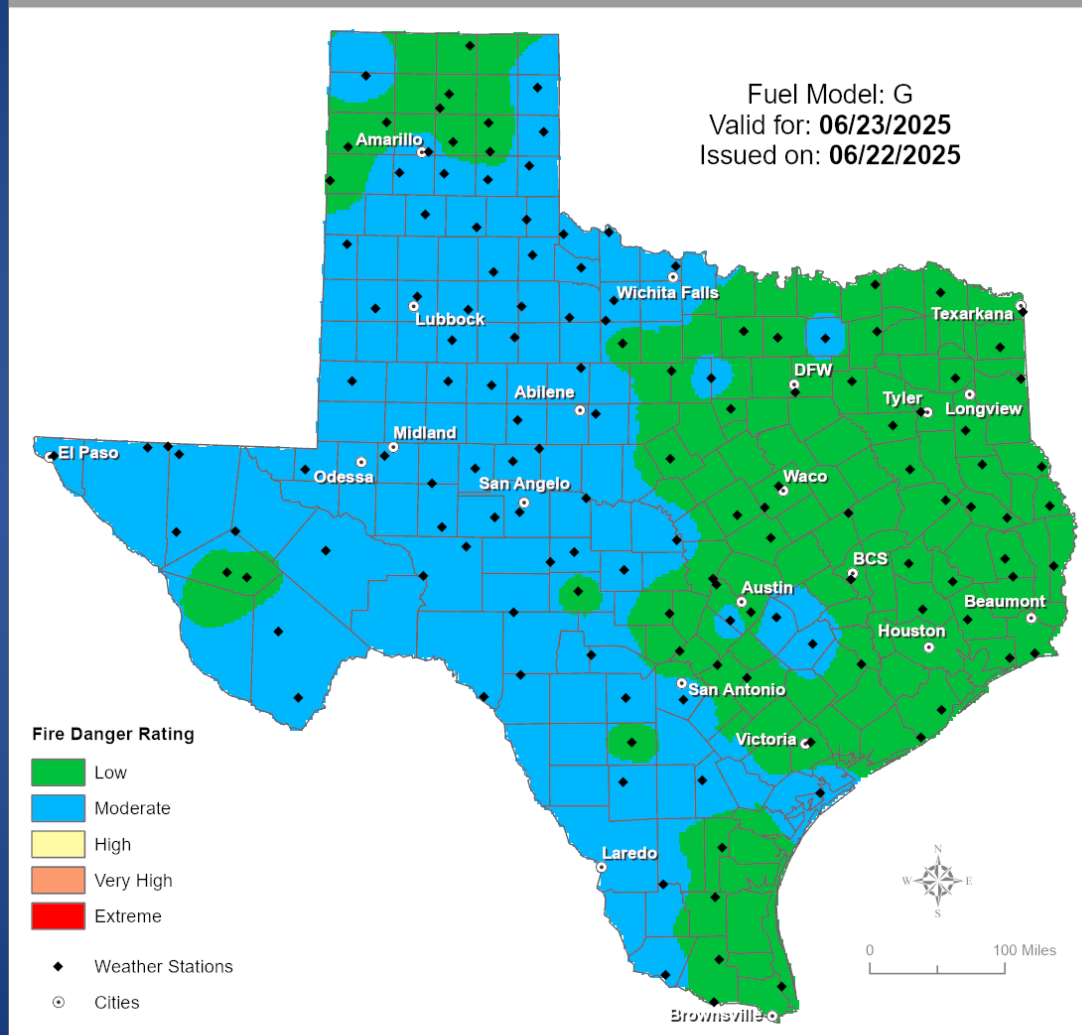

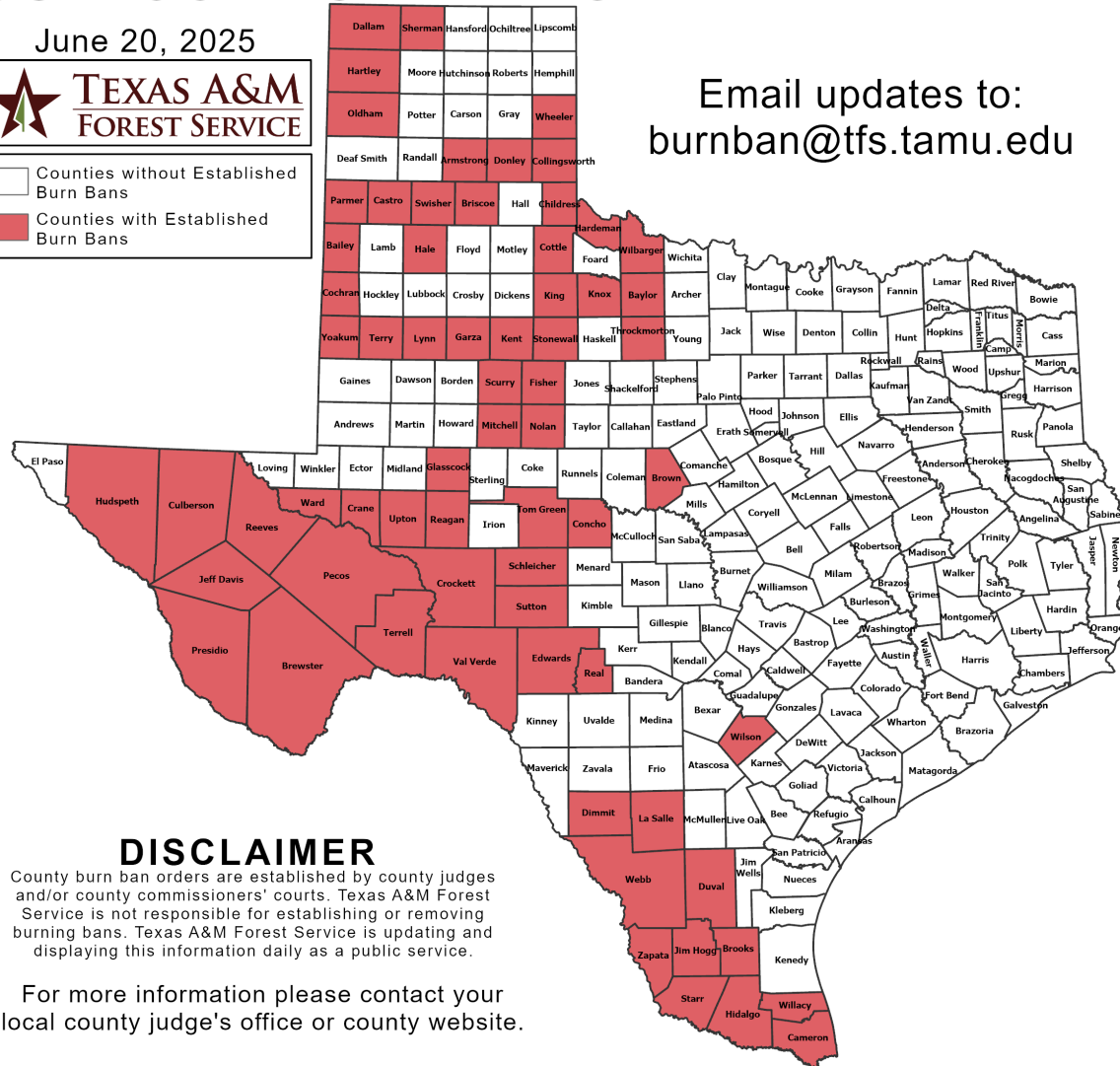

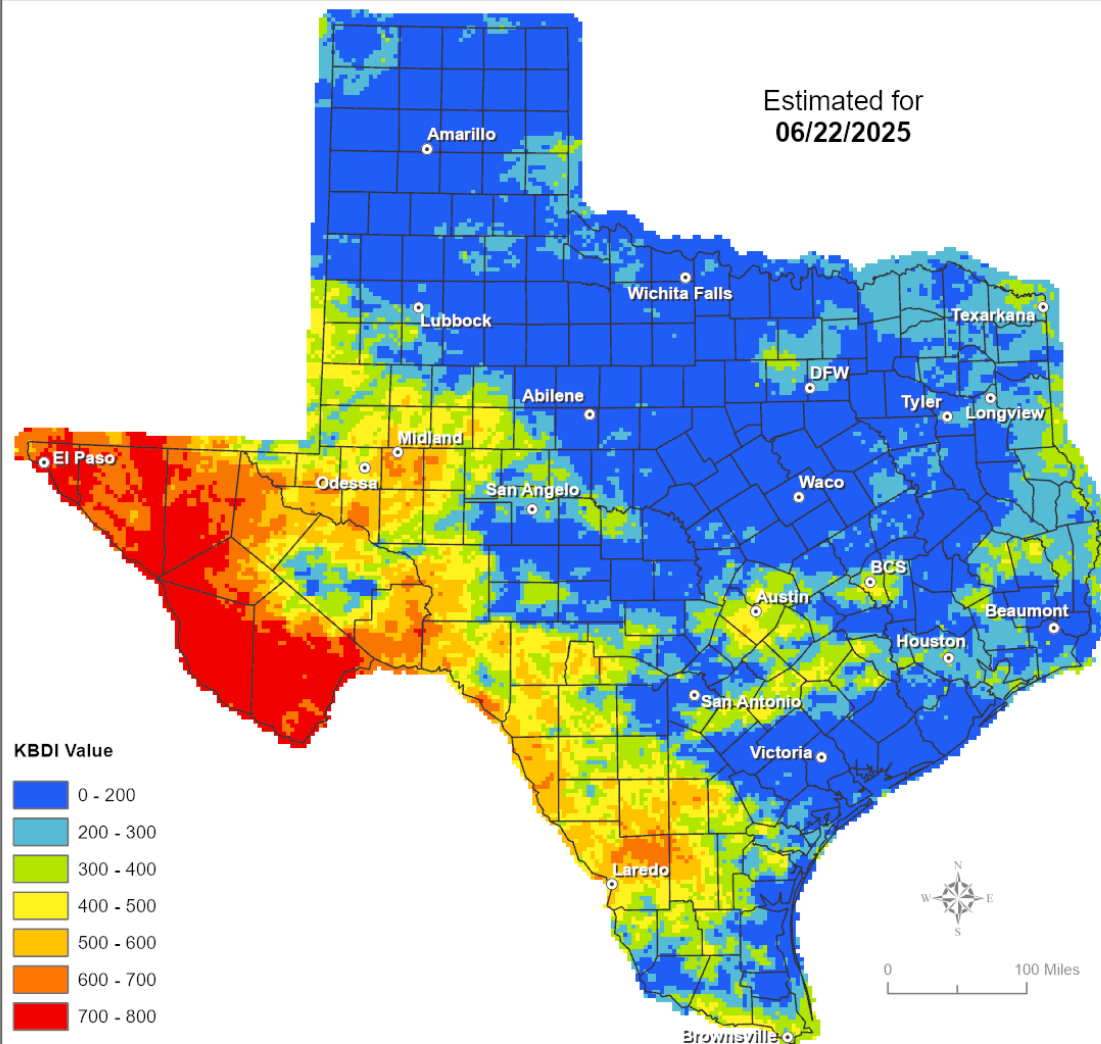

Keetch-Byram Drought Index

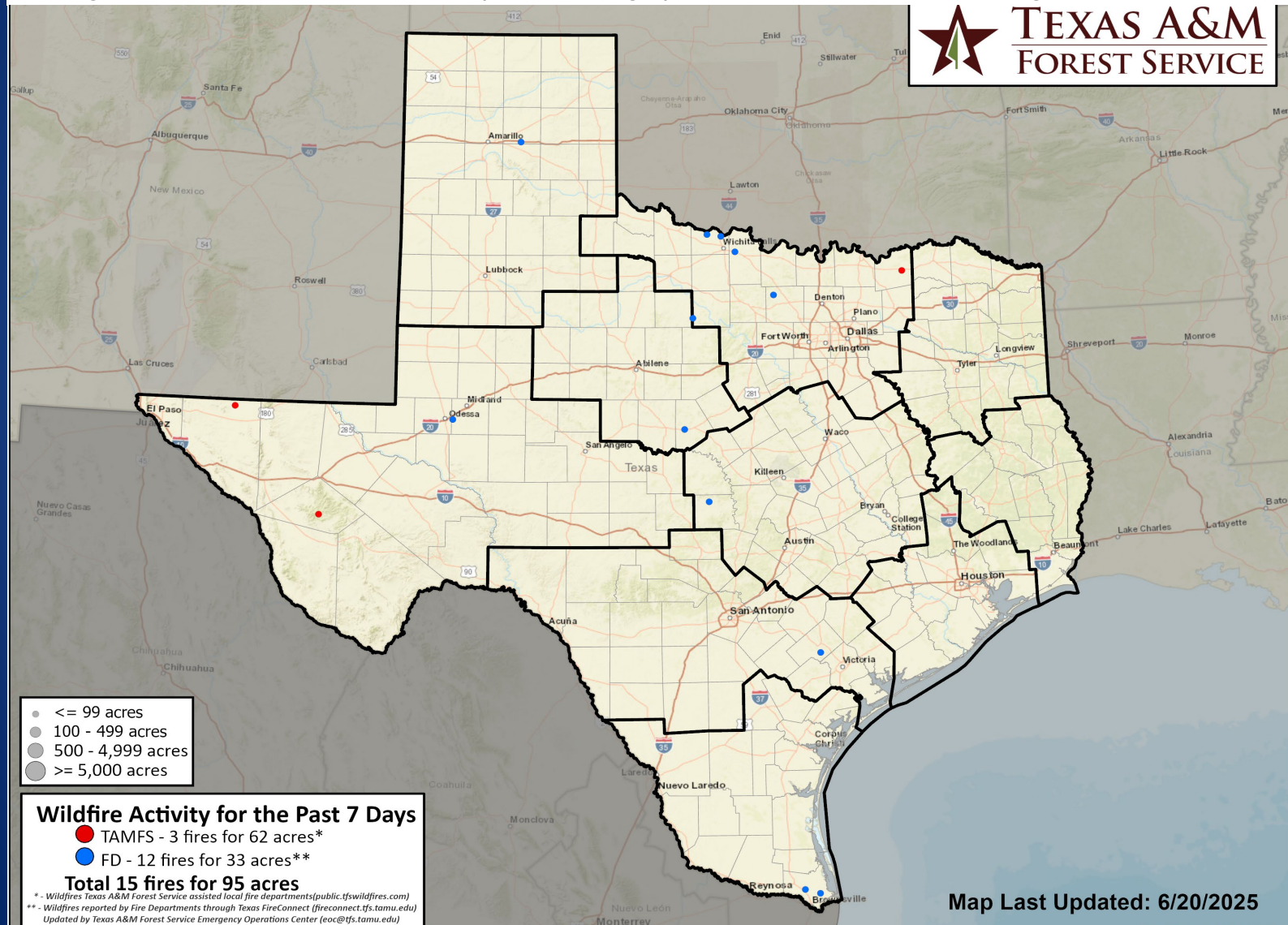
