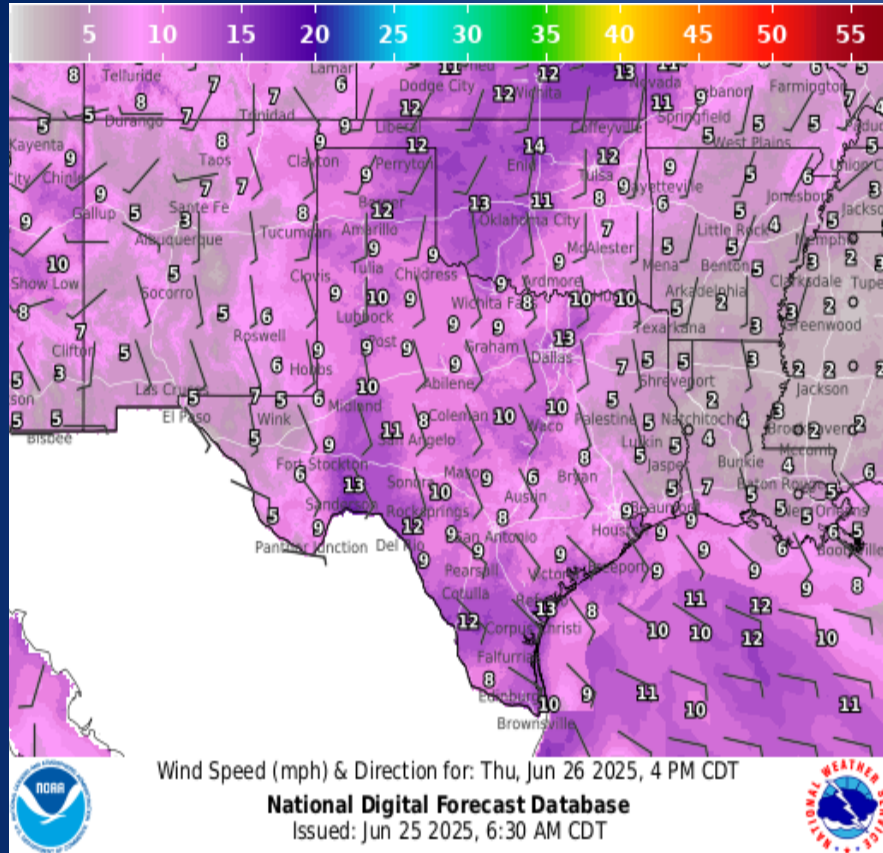

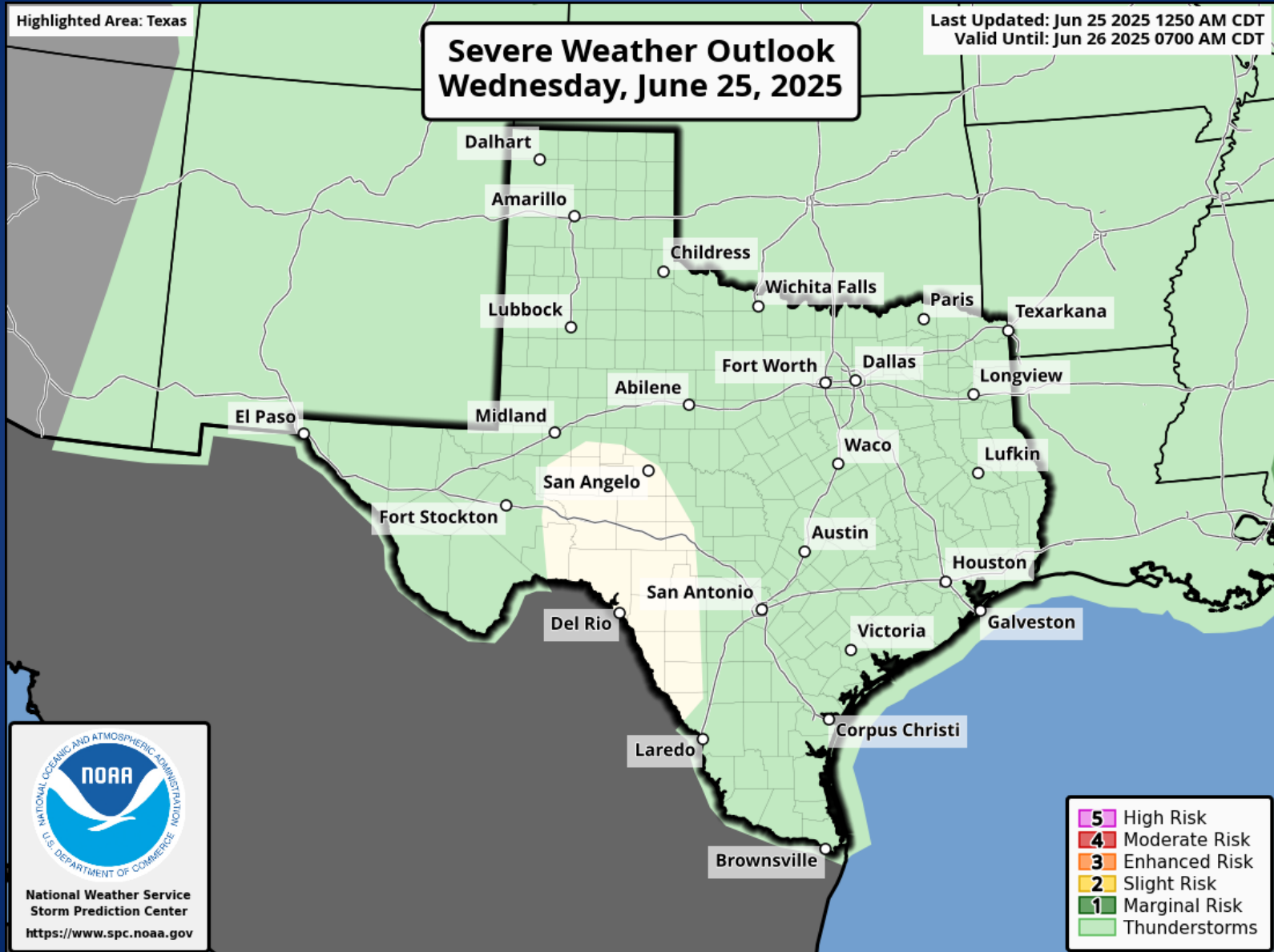

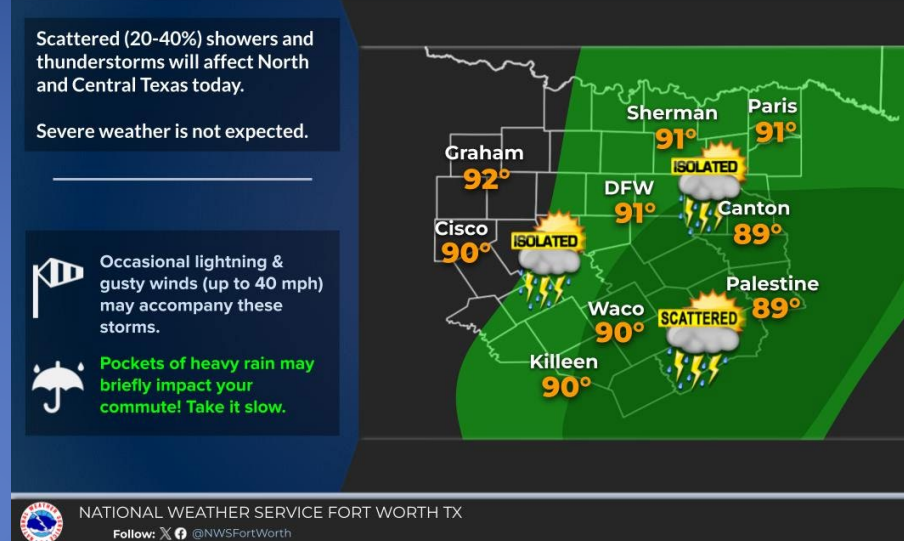
## Rain Chances Today



Monsoon pattern will once again bring additional rain chances today, favoring the western Panhandles. Any thunderstorms that develop will be capable of producing heavy rainfall rates and strong wind gusts. Repeated rounds of heavy rainfall will also result in localized flooding concerns.

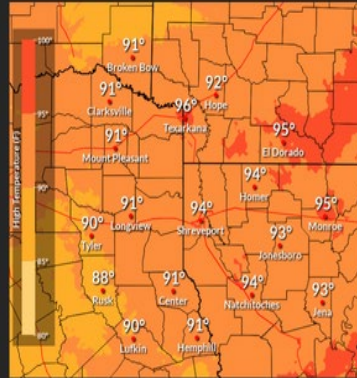

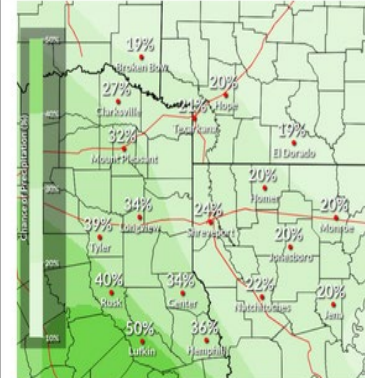

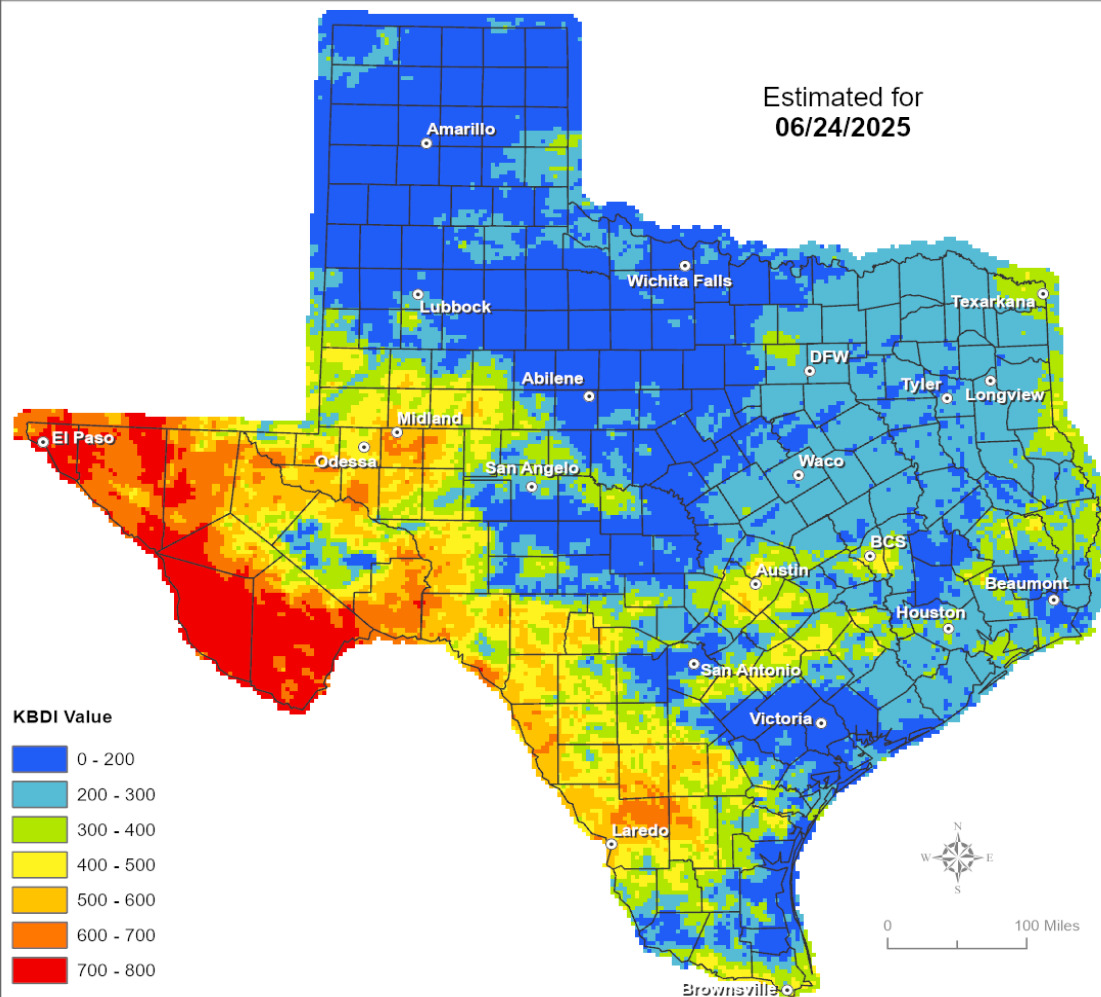


# Keetch-Byram Drought Index

## Keetch-Byram Drought Index

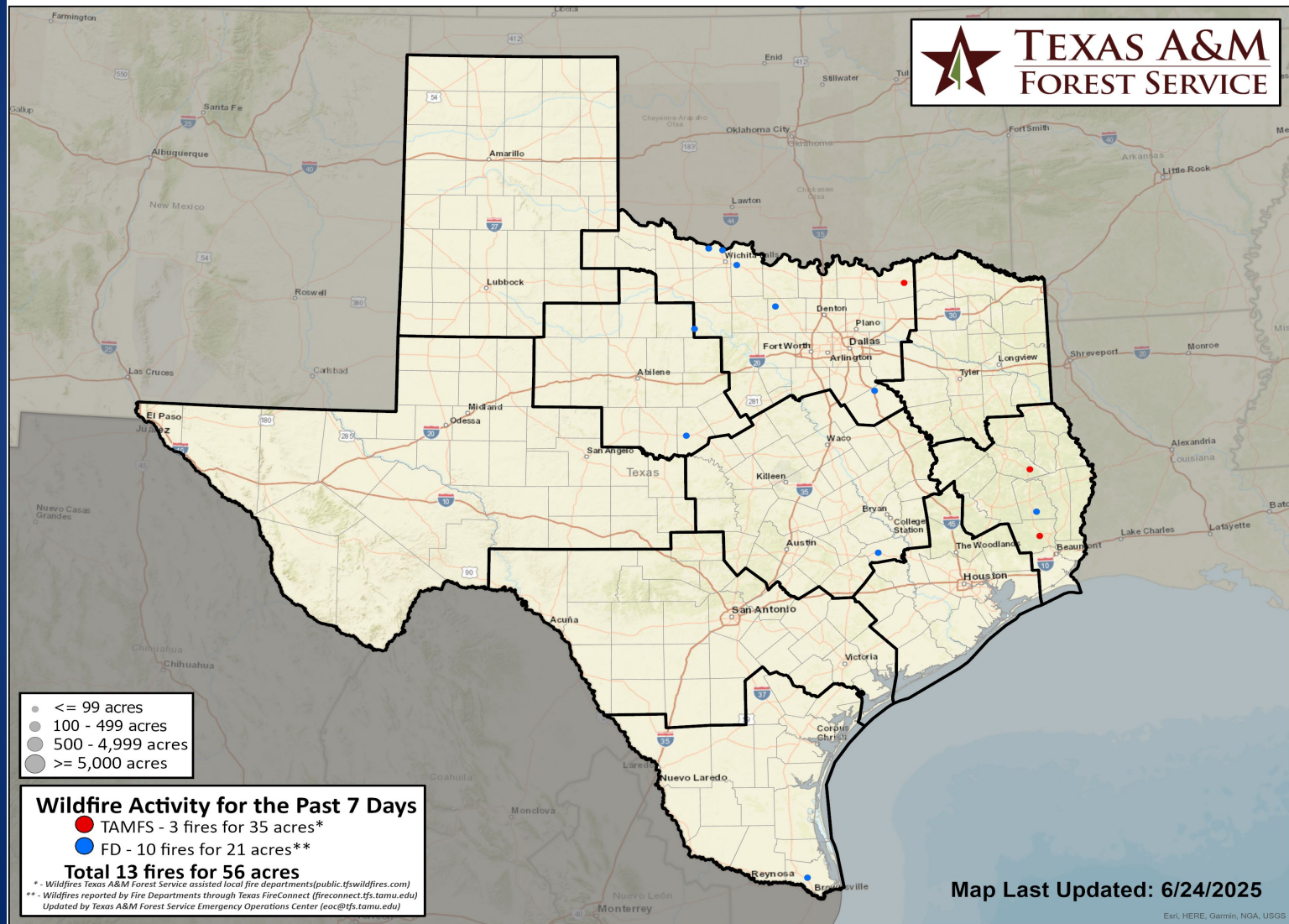
