


#### Wind Speeds






There is a low chance for severe thunderstorms on Sunday, with the primary threat being damaging wind gusts up to 70 mph.



As a result of showers and thunderstorms occurring within this relatively humid environment, heavy rain will be possible. Given that, and the abundant rainfall lately, flash flooding will be possible--particularly in areas that have seen the most rainfall of recent times.


**Forecast for Sunday** 



There is a medium (30-60%) chance of showers and thunderstorms today with the higher chances across the Coastal Bend and Victoria Crossroads. Highs in the upper 80s east to the upper 90s west. Southeasterly winds will generally range from 10-20 mph.



Low to medium chances for showers and thunderstorms returns to the area today, mainly over the coastal plains and I-35 corridor this afternoon and evening. Otherwise, highs will range from the upper 80s over the coastal plains to the upper 90s along the Rio Grande.




Highs will be a degree or so warmer today than yesterday. Best chances of rain will be in the Davis and Chinati Mountains, as well as the Marfa Plateau.






