


A Heat Advisory will be in effect on Monday from 12 PM to 8 PM for much of northern, central, southern Oklahoma and portions of western north Texas. Temperatures will be in the 90s to near 100 with heat indices of 105 to 110 degrees.



A Heat Advisory is in effect until 8 PM this evening for entire Four State Region. Hot temperatures combined with the humidity, will result in heat indices of 105-109 degrees over the Advisory area. Please use caution if outdoors, by drinking plenty of water and taking frequent breaks.




Temperatures will creep back up toward 100° areawide with humidity pushing heat index values as high as 107° this afternoon and again Tuesday afternoon.




Fire Danger Forecast
