A Heat Advisory will be in effect from 12 PM to 8 PM on Tuesday for much of northern, central, and southern Oklahoma and portions of western north Texas. High temperatures will range from 97 to 103 °F, and heat indices of 105 to 109 °F are expected.




Fire Danger Forecast








Burn Ban




