Probability of Flooding/Flash Flooding







Thunderstorms will start to form this afternoon across the Panhandles but more widespread storms are expected this evening through Thursday morning. Thunderstorms tonight could produce heavy rain with rainfall rates upwards of 1 to 3 inches per hour. These thunderstorms could lead to flash flooding, especially for urban or low lying areas. Isolated areas may pick up 2-4 inches of rainfall from the storms.




Isolated thunderstorms this afternoon are expected to increase in coverage this evening through tonight. The best chance of storms will be over the far southwestern Texas Panhandle and western portions of the South Plains.



Fire Danger Forecast




Burn Ban
