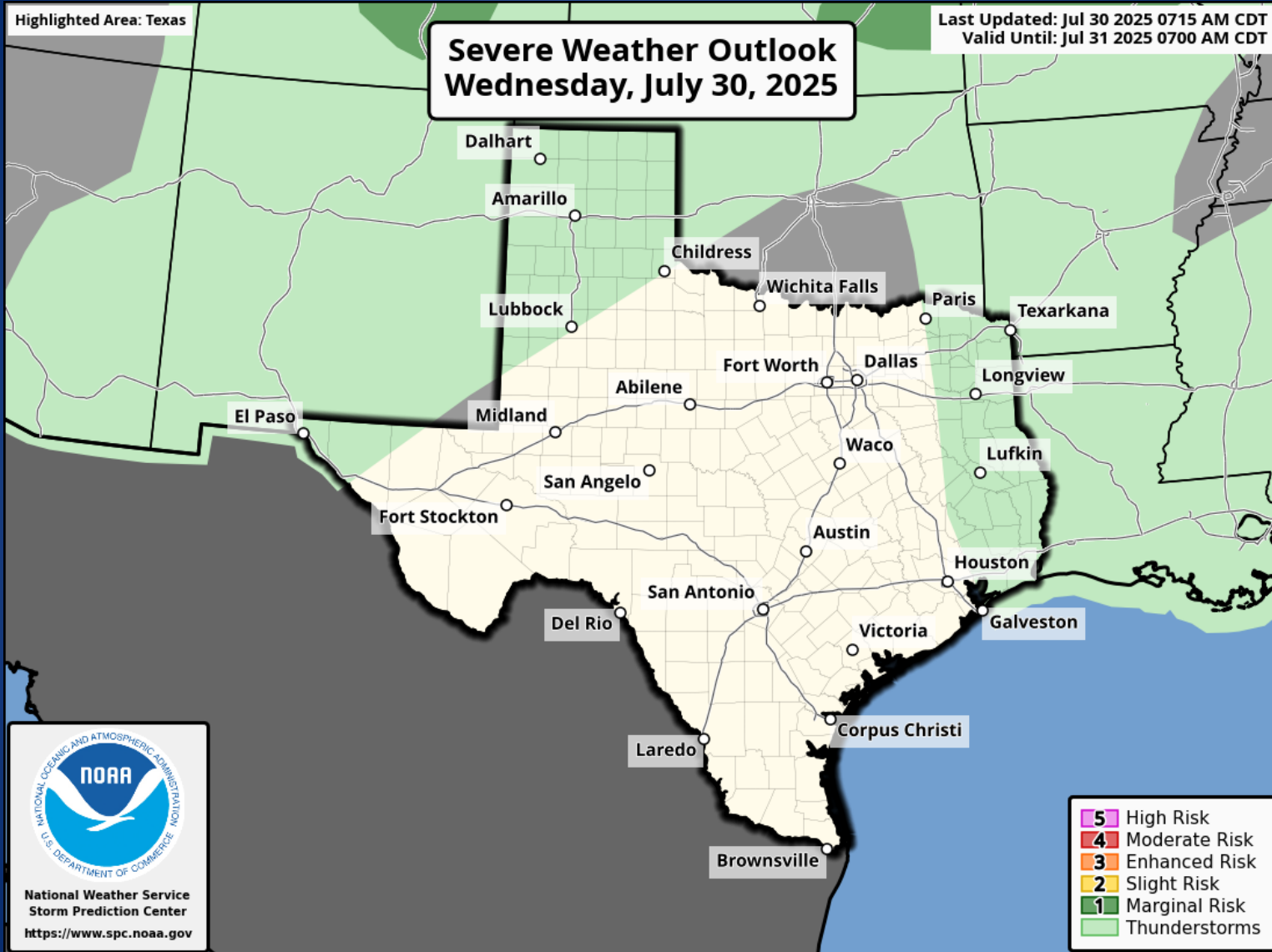

## Heat Advisory Continues Today

Hot and humid conditions will prevail today, with a Heat Advisory in effect across most of North and East Texas.

### Wednesday's Highs



Heat Advisory Area: Highs up to 104°F and/or heat indices up to 108°F.

### What to Do

- Recognize the symptoms of heat illness.
- Drink plenty of water, even if not thirsty.
- If outside, take frequent breaks in the shade.
- NEVER leave kids or pets unattended in vehicles.
- Limit time outside to the cooler part of the day.

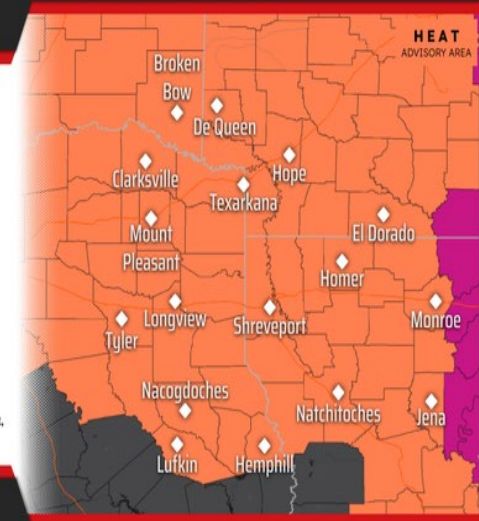

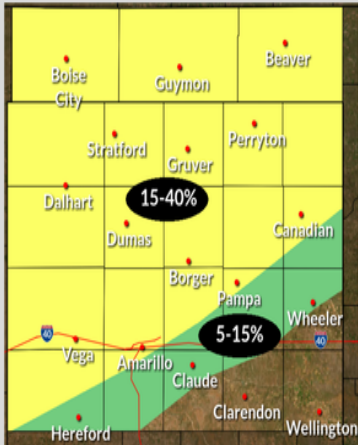

Thunderstorms will start to form this afternoon across the Panhandles but more widespread storms are expected this evening through Thursday morning. Thunderstorms tonight could produce heavy rain with rainfall rates upwards of 1 to 3 inches per hour. These thunderstorms could lead to flash flooding, especially for urban or low lying areas. Isolated areas may pick up 2-4 inches of rainfall from the storms.

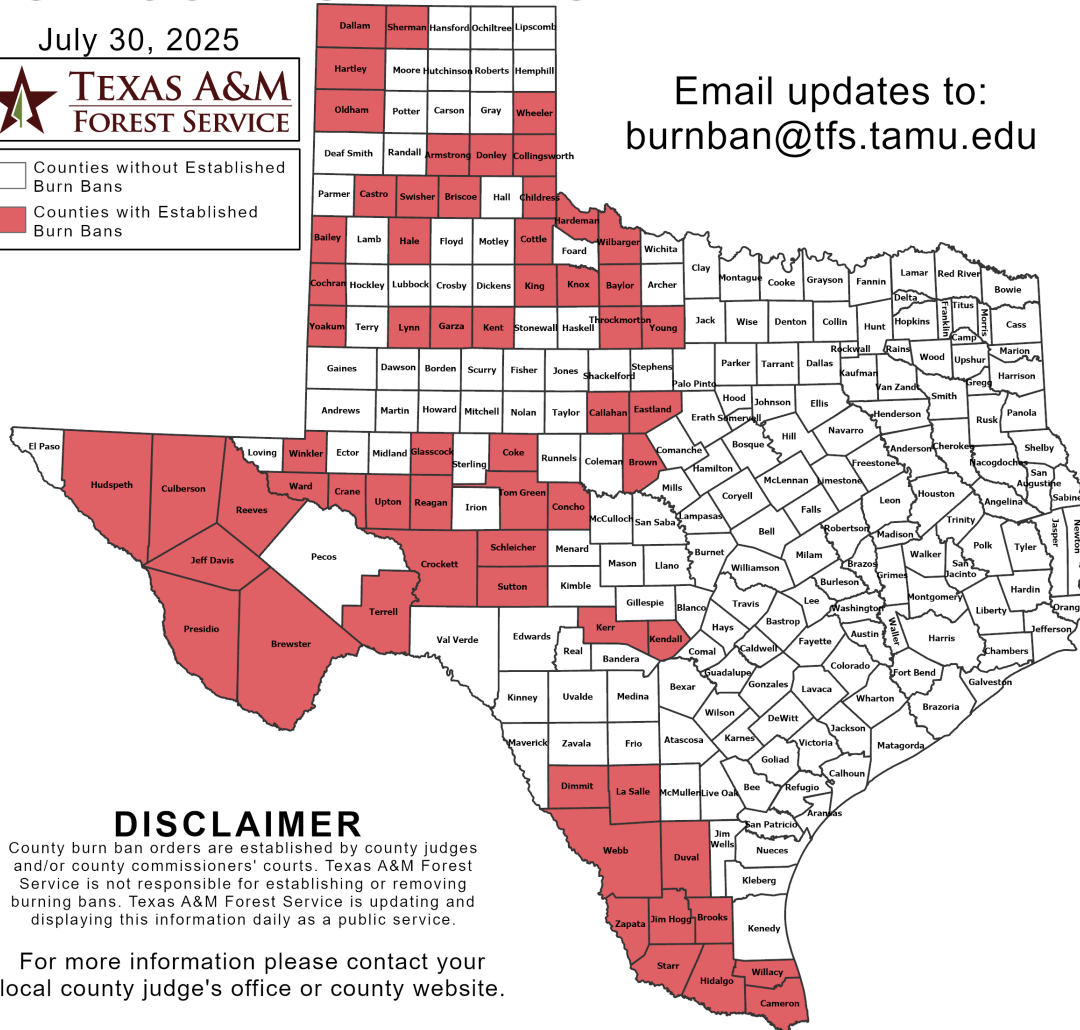

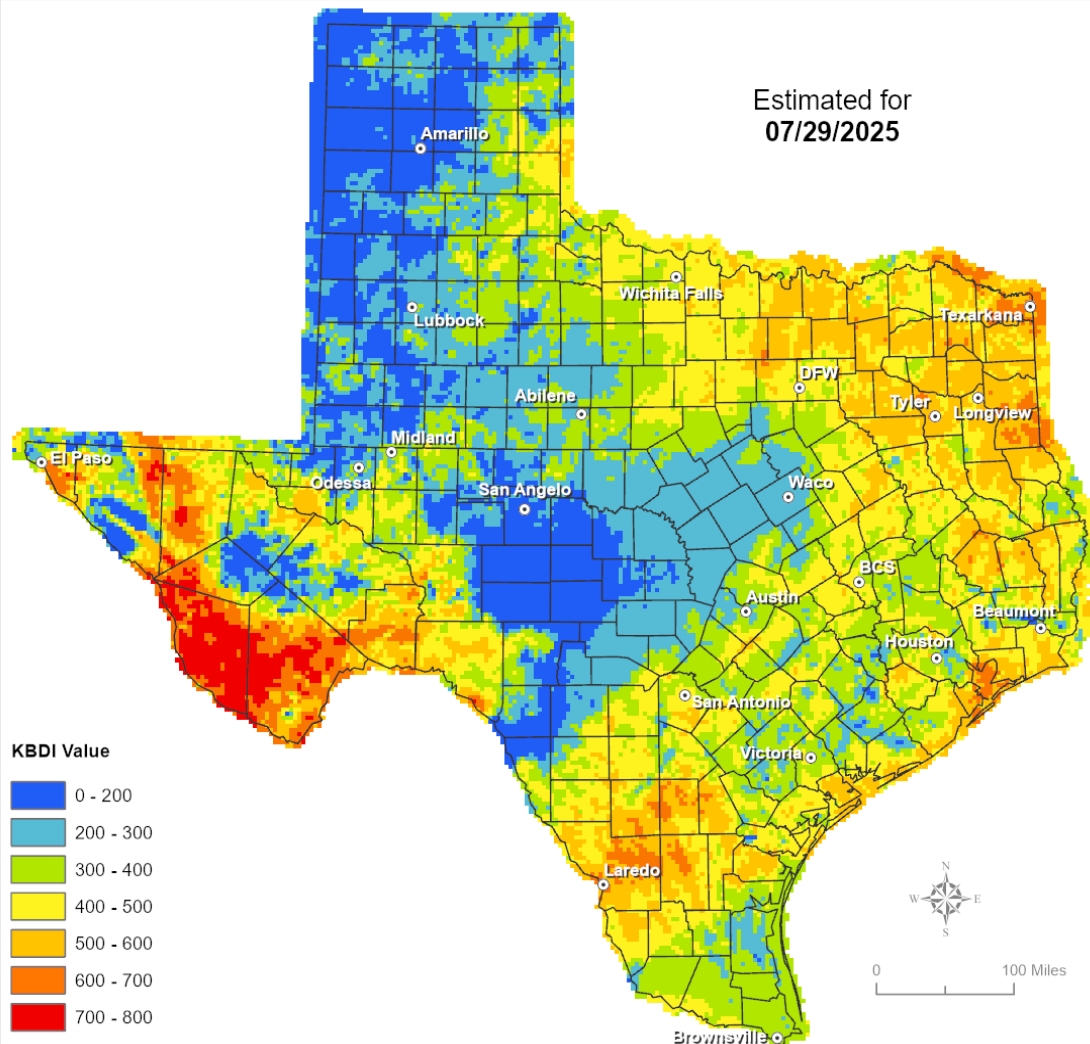


# Keetch-Byram Drought Index

## Keetch-Byram Drought Index

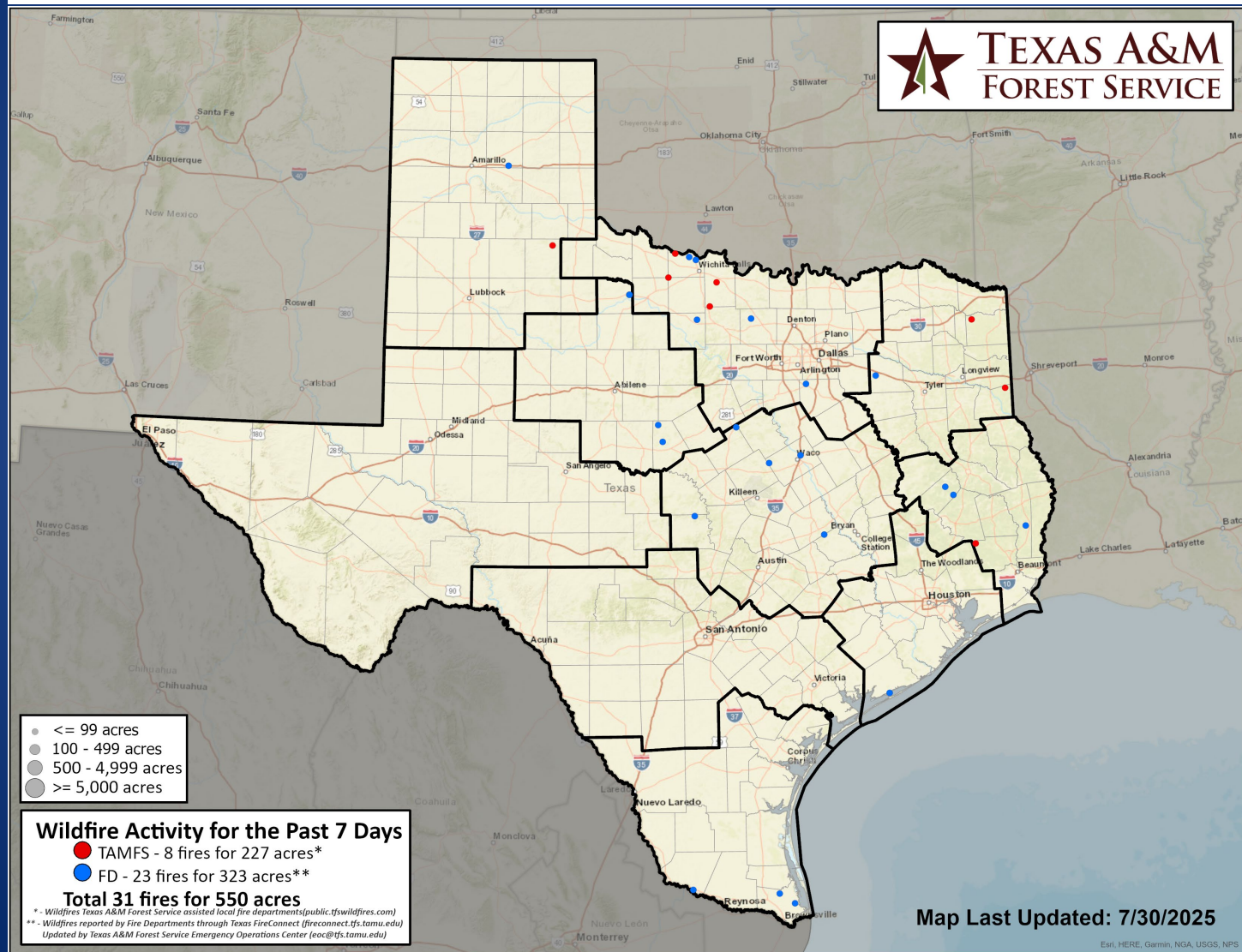
