


Hot weather will continue today with highs mostly in the triple digits and heat indices up to 107 degrees. A Heat Advisory is now in effect for most of North Texas from 12-8 PM tonight. The arrival of a weak cold font will result in a few storms mainly north of I-20, some which could produce strong to severe wind gusts. Gusty and erratic winds from any storms will be dangerous to those outdoors, particularly for anyone boating on any area lakes. Stay cool and be weather aware for any storms that develop.




Dangerous heat will continue today, with heat index readings of 107F - 111F expected and actual air temperatures approaching the triple digits in some areas.

Hazardous Weather



An Extreme Heat Warning is now in effect through 7 pm Thursday for portions of South Central Arkansas, extreme Northeast Texas and much of Northern Louisiana. Elsewhere a Heat Advisory is in effect for the remainder of the Four State Region. Hot temperatures combined with the humidity, will result in heat indices of 105-116 degrees over Warning/Advisory areas. Please use caution if outdoors, by drinking plenty of water and taking frequent breaks.



Dangerous heat will continue today, with heat index readings of 107F - 111F expected and actual air temperatures approaching the triple digits in some areas.






Fire Danger Forecast
