


Hazardous Weather

Strong to severe thunderstorms will develop north of the area Sunday afternoon, then move south into the area Sunday night into early Monday morning. Large hail and damaging winds are the main threats, although a tornado is also possible. Locally heavy rainfall is possible.





Fire Danger Forecast




