



Post-Tropical Cyclone or Remnants



Isolated to scattered storms are expected again today, primarily across Central Texas where there is a 20-40% chance of storms. Areas to the north have a 10% chance of storms. A few storms may be strong with gusty winds, frequent lightning, and brief heavy rain. Remember, when thunder roars, go indoors! Be sure to take extra caution if on area lakes today, as gusty and erratic winds in and around storms will be hazardous to boaters.



Some of the thunderstorms will be capable of producing torrential downpours with high rainfall amounts in a short period of time. There is a Marginal Risk (level 1 out of 4) or between a 5 to 14 percent chance of seeing excessive rainfall leading to flooding. The main concern will be localized nuisance street flooding.




Another round of mainly afternoon thunderstorms is in the forecast for South Texas today as a disturbance moves across. The activity will start earlier in the day over the marine zones before transitioning inland. Otherwise, expect another hot day with heat index values around 100-110 degrees under partly cloudy skies.





# **Fire Danger Forecast**




#### **Burn Ban**




