There is a 20% to 35% chance for thunderstorms to develop this afternoon and evening across the Panhandles. Potential is present for thunderstorms to become strong to severe, especially in the Eastern Panhandles. The main threat remains hail up to 2" in diameter and wind gusts up to 70 mph possible. While the chance for a tornado is very low chance, the ingredients in play today make it impossible to rule out.




There is a risk for severe storms on Monday afternoon into the evening hours across portions of northern and western Oklahoma and adjacent western north Texas. The potential severe hazards are up to golf ball size hail and 70 mph damaging wind gusts.

Fire Danger Forecast








