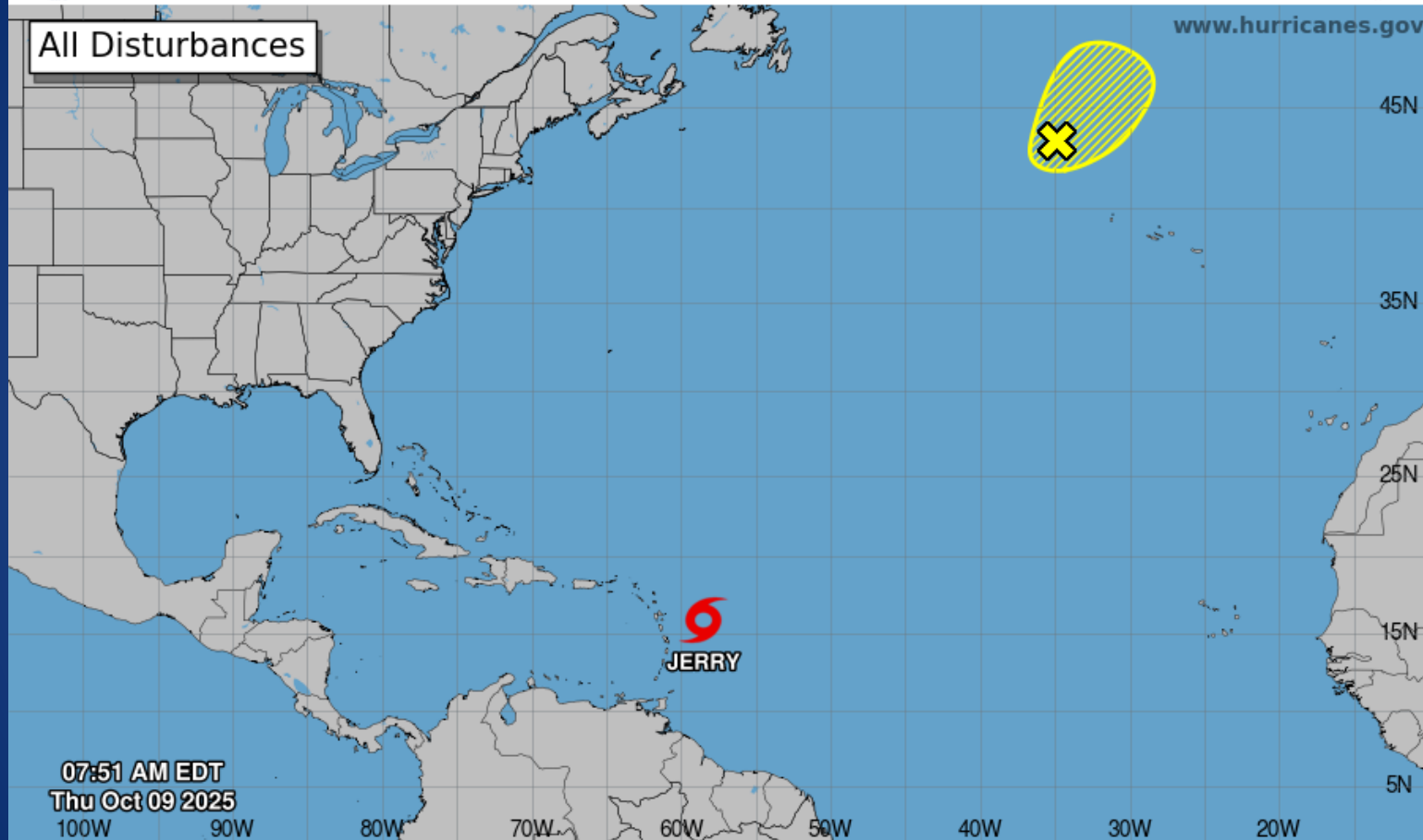
Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

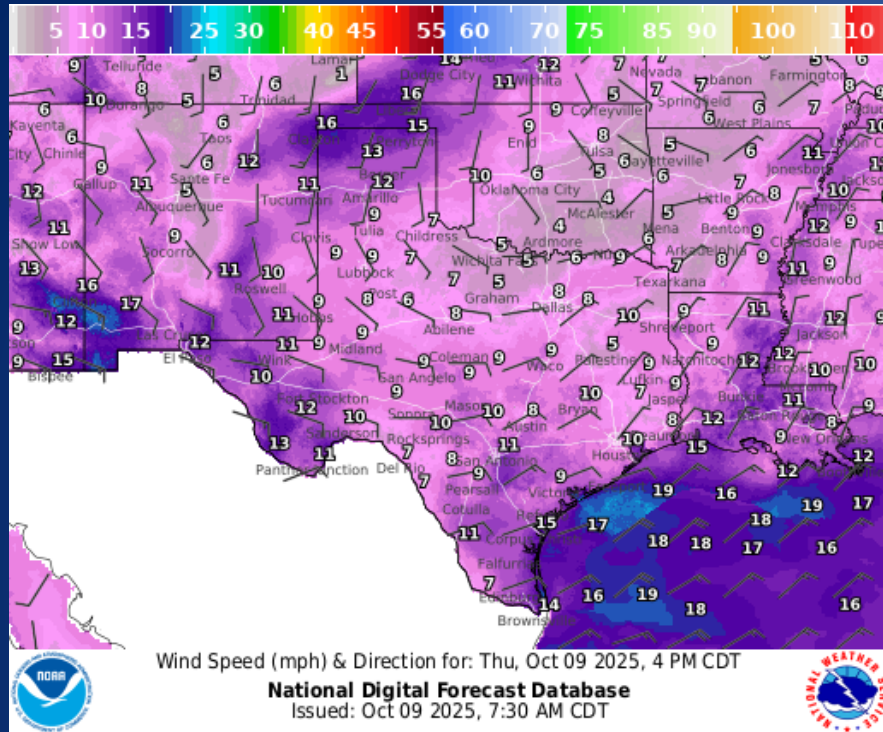

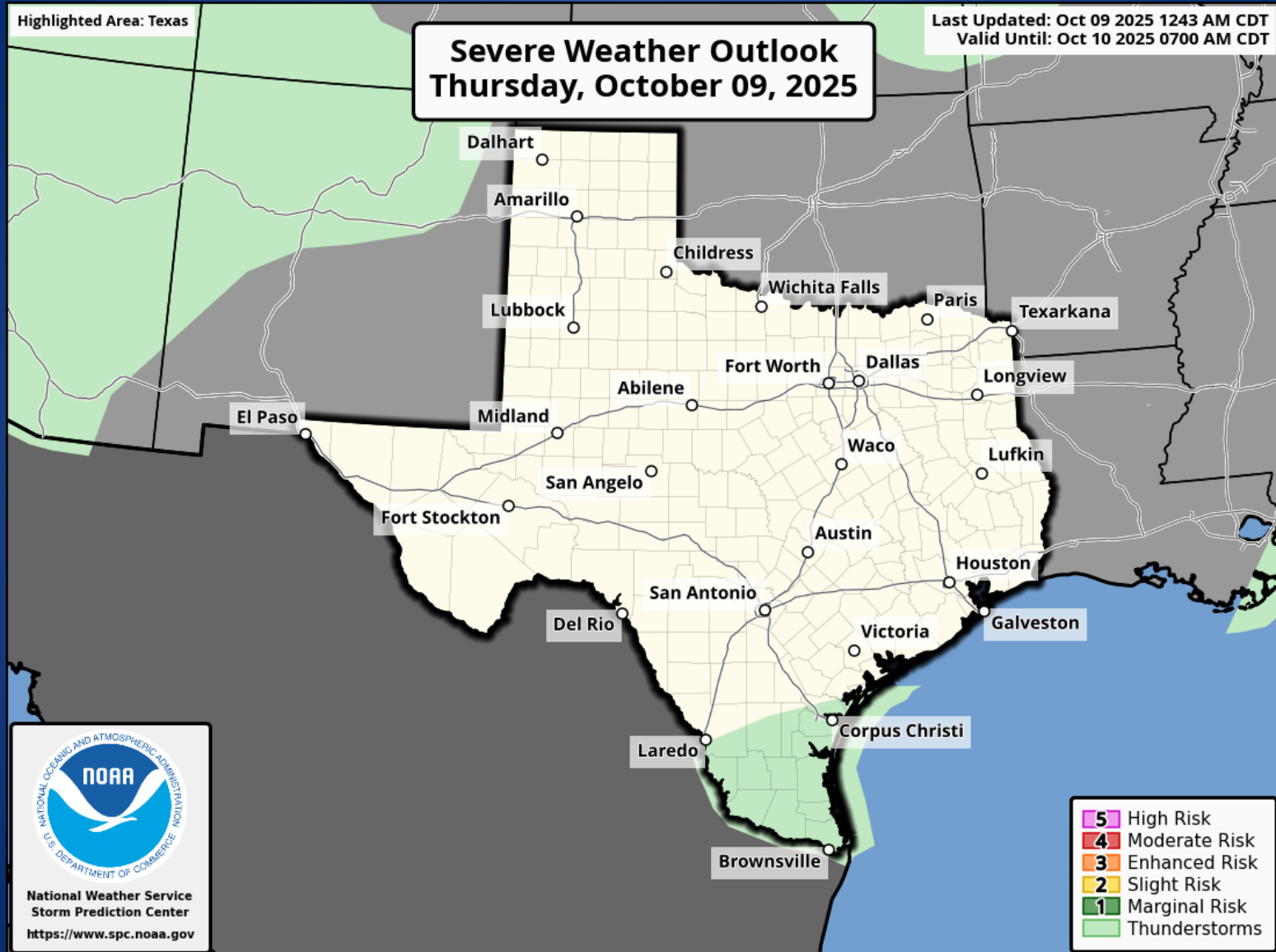

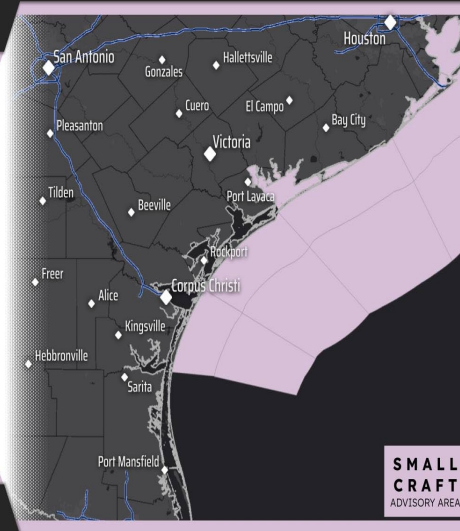
- Wind and wave conditions will be hazardous for small craft.

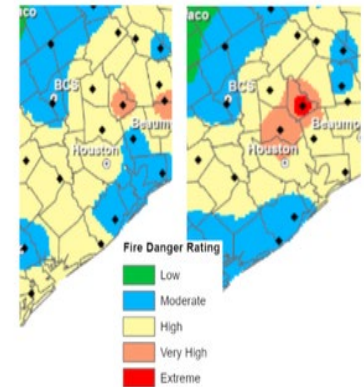
FIRE WEATHER SAFETY

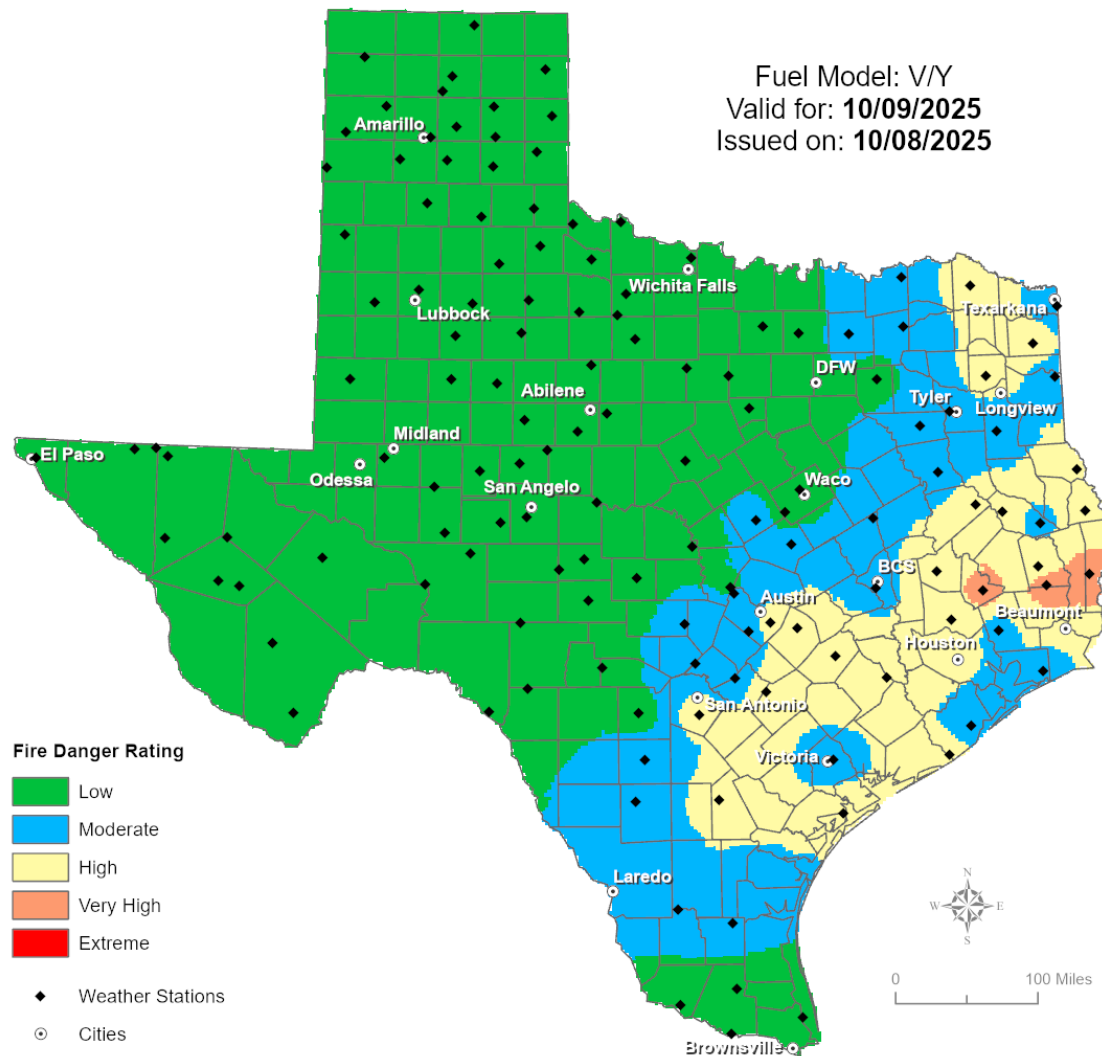

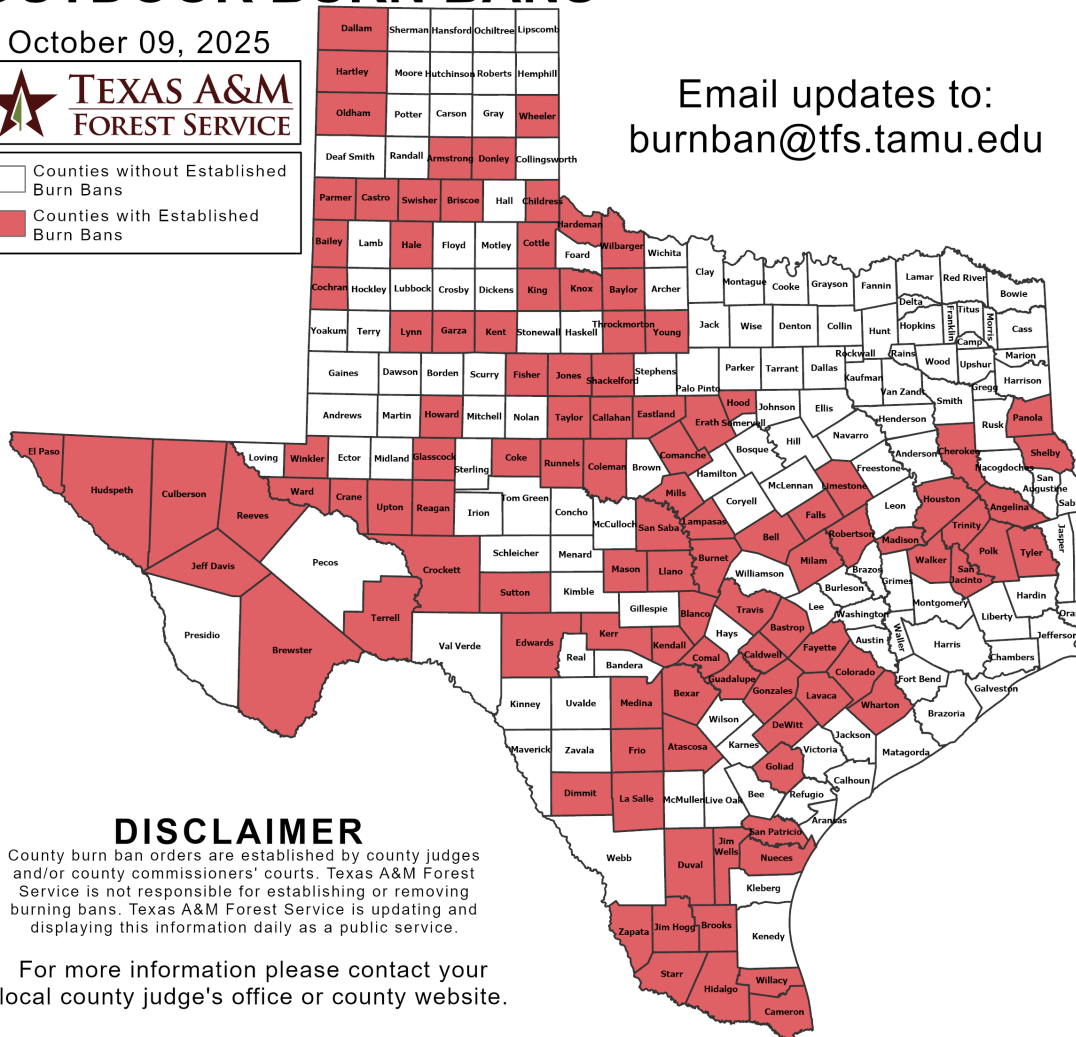

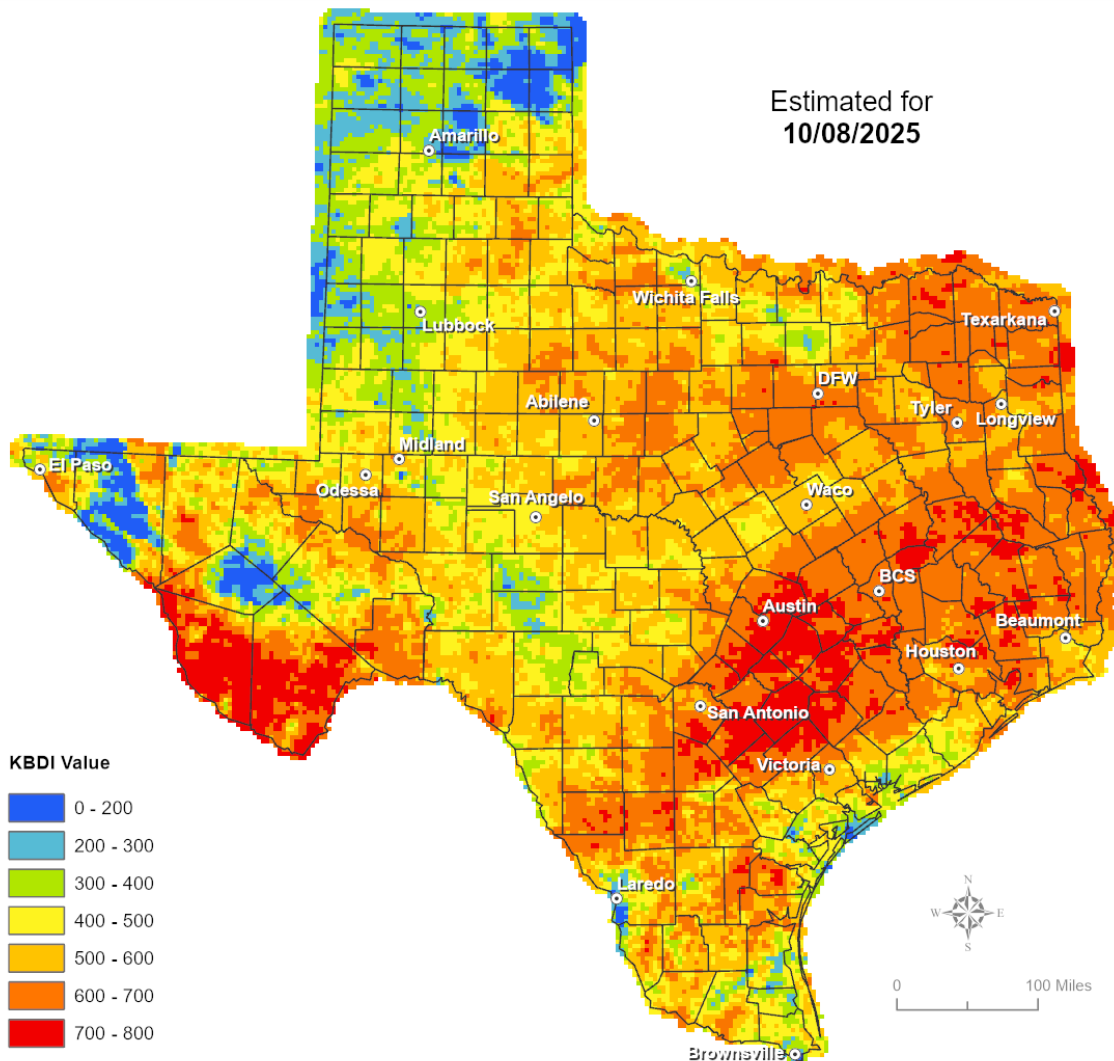

Keetch-Byram Drought Index

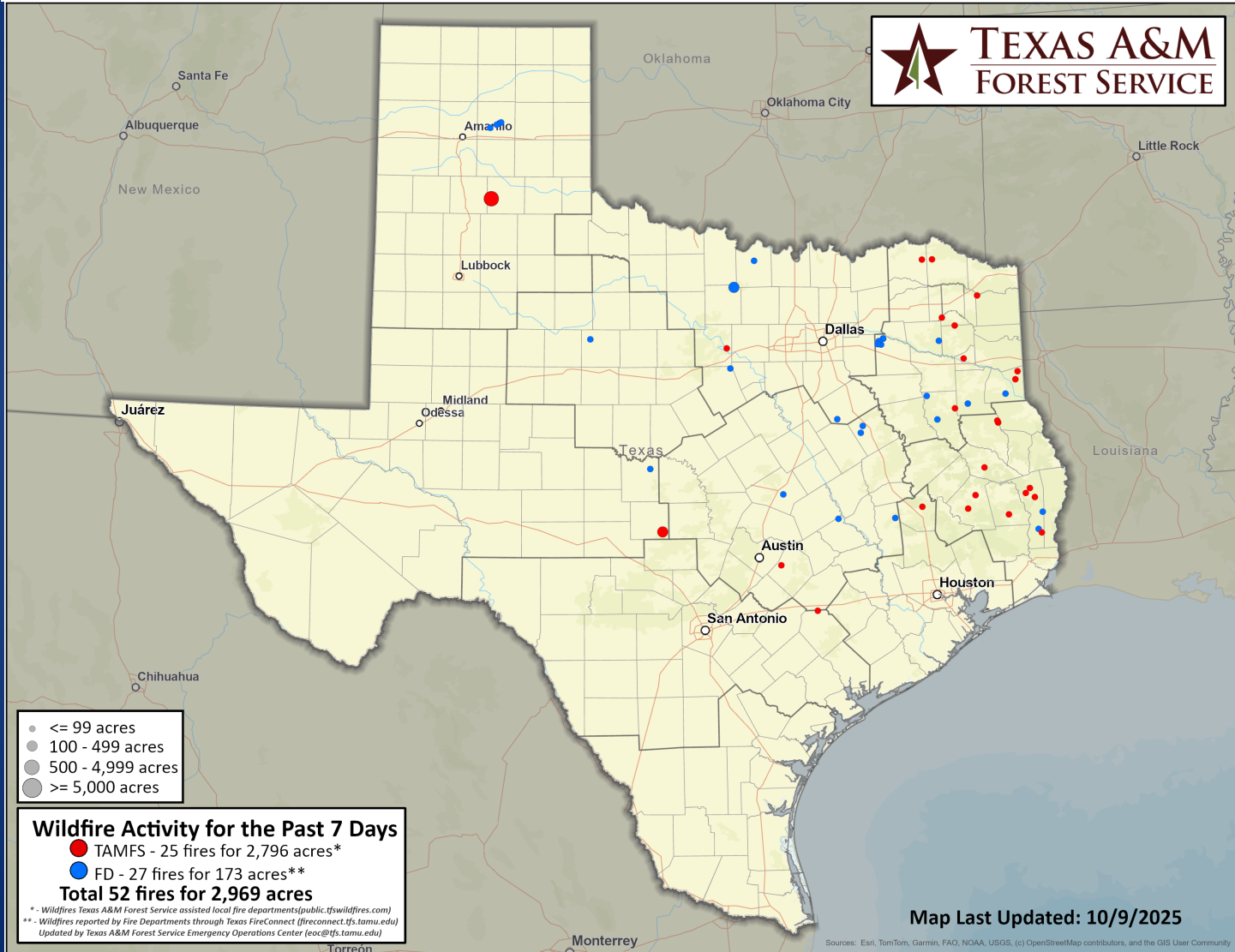
