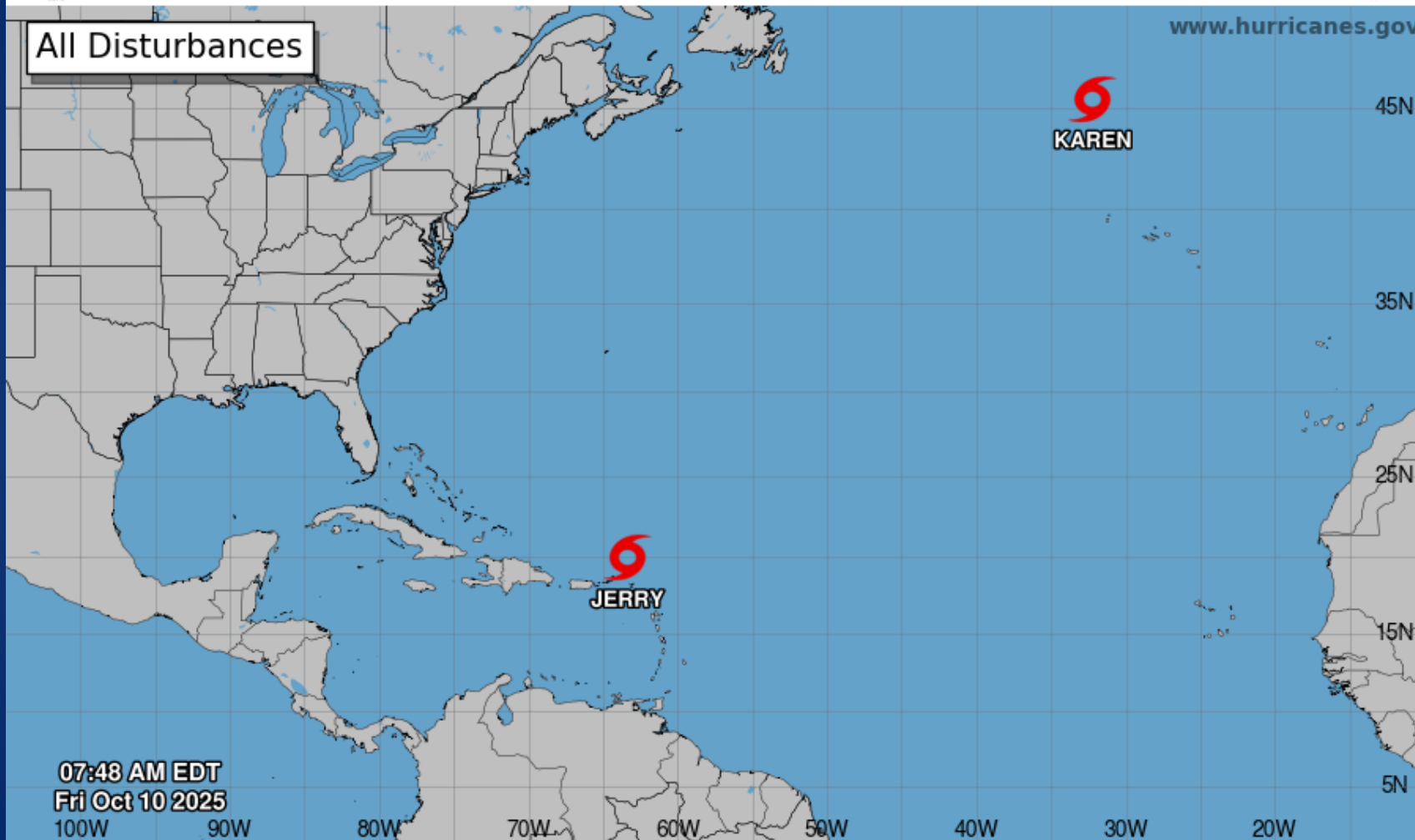
Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

Texas A&M Fire Forest Service Fire Danger Rating



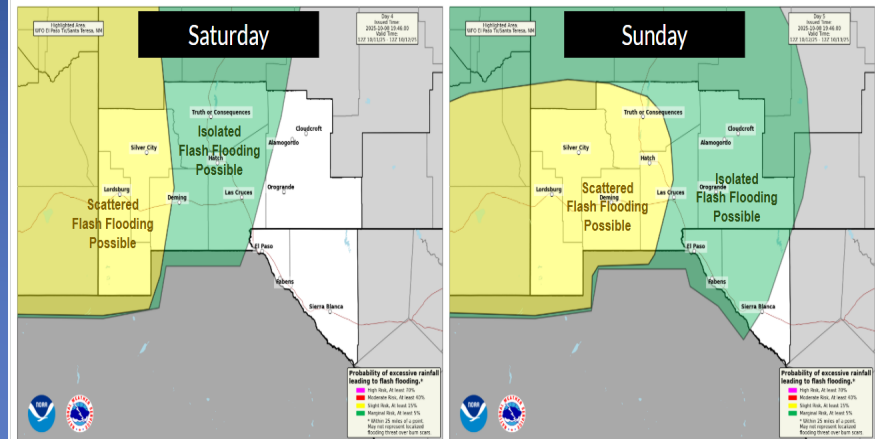

Excessive Rainfall Risk: Saturday and Sunday

6:00 AM



Heavier rainfall expected over SW New Mexico. Generally showery rainfall activity with embedded storms. Rainfall rates mostly moderate, but pockets of heavy rainfall, especially in storms.

Still a very moist environment, Thunderstorm activity likely favored west of the Rio Grande. Thus potential for local flooding may be increased, due to higher rainfall rates associated with the storms.



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We will see record atmospheric moisture levels this weekend, into early next week. With that comes the potential for excessive rainfall, resulting in local flooding and flash flooding over the weekend.

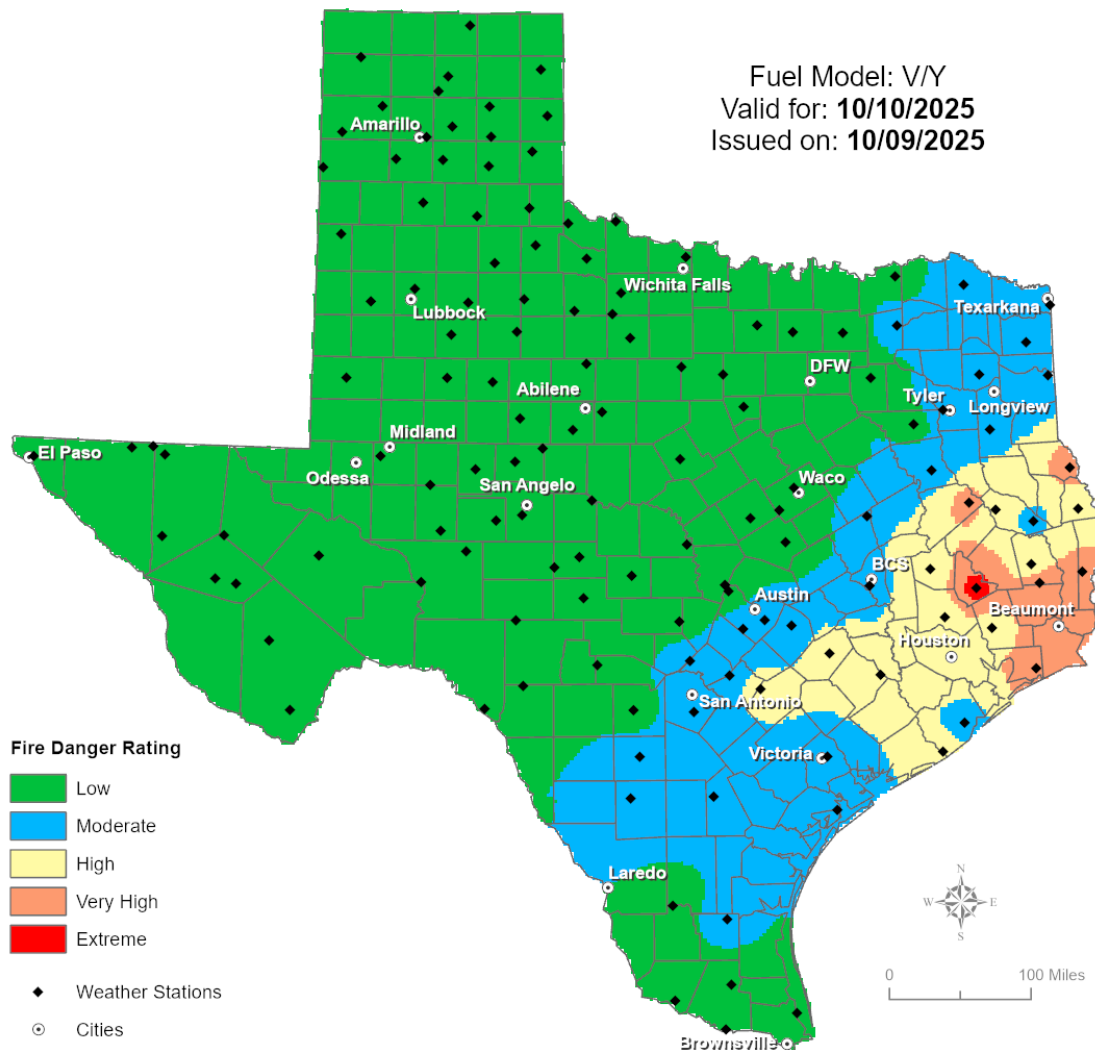

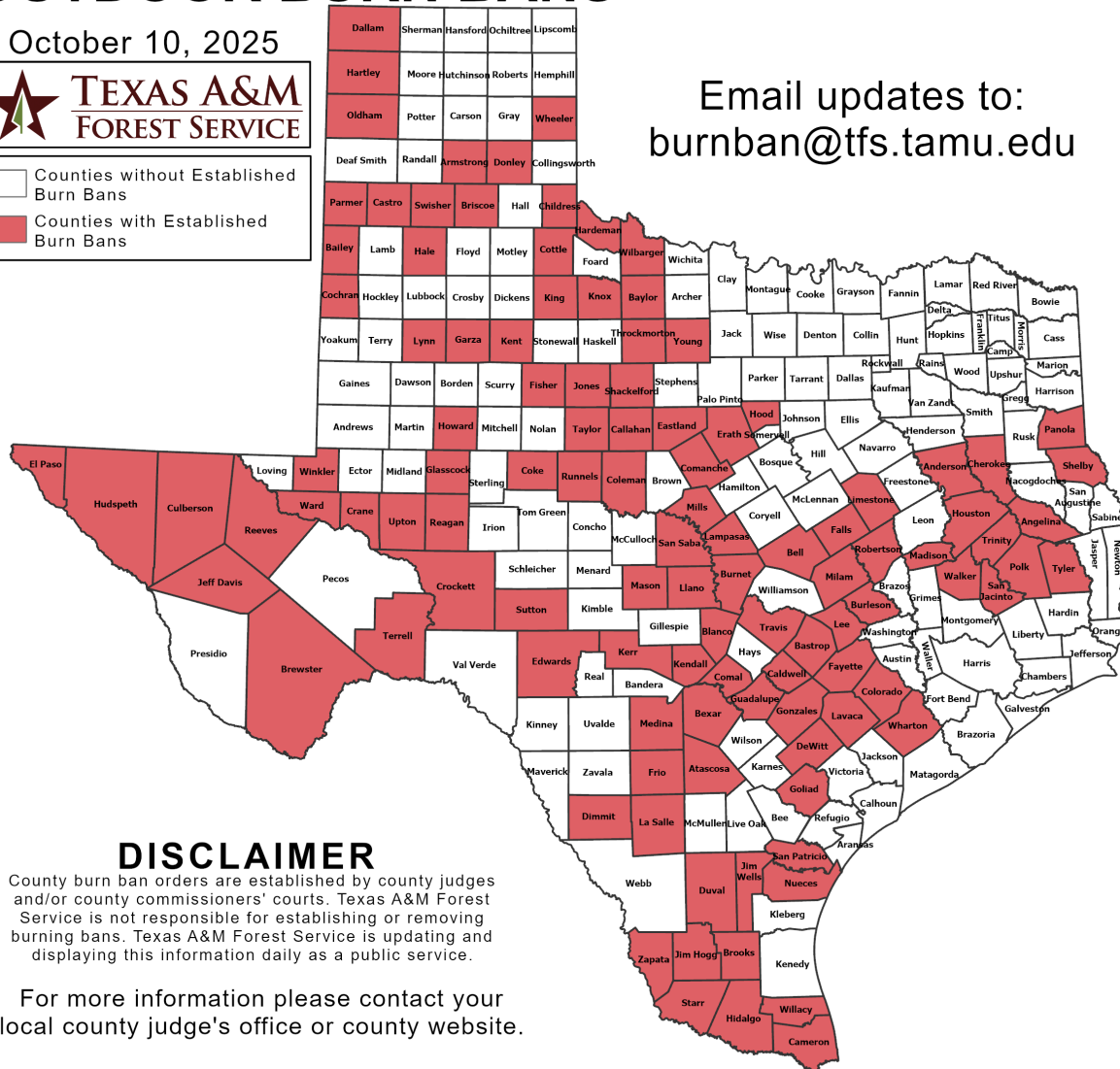

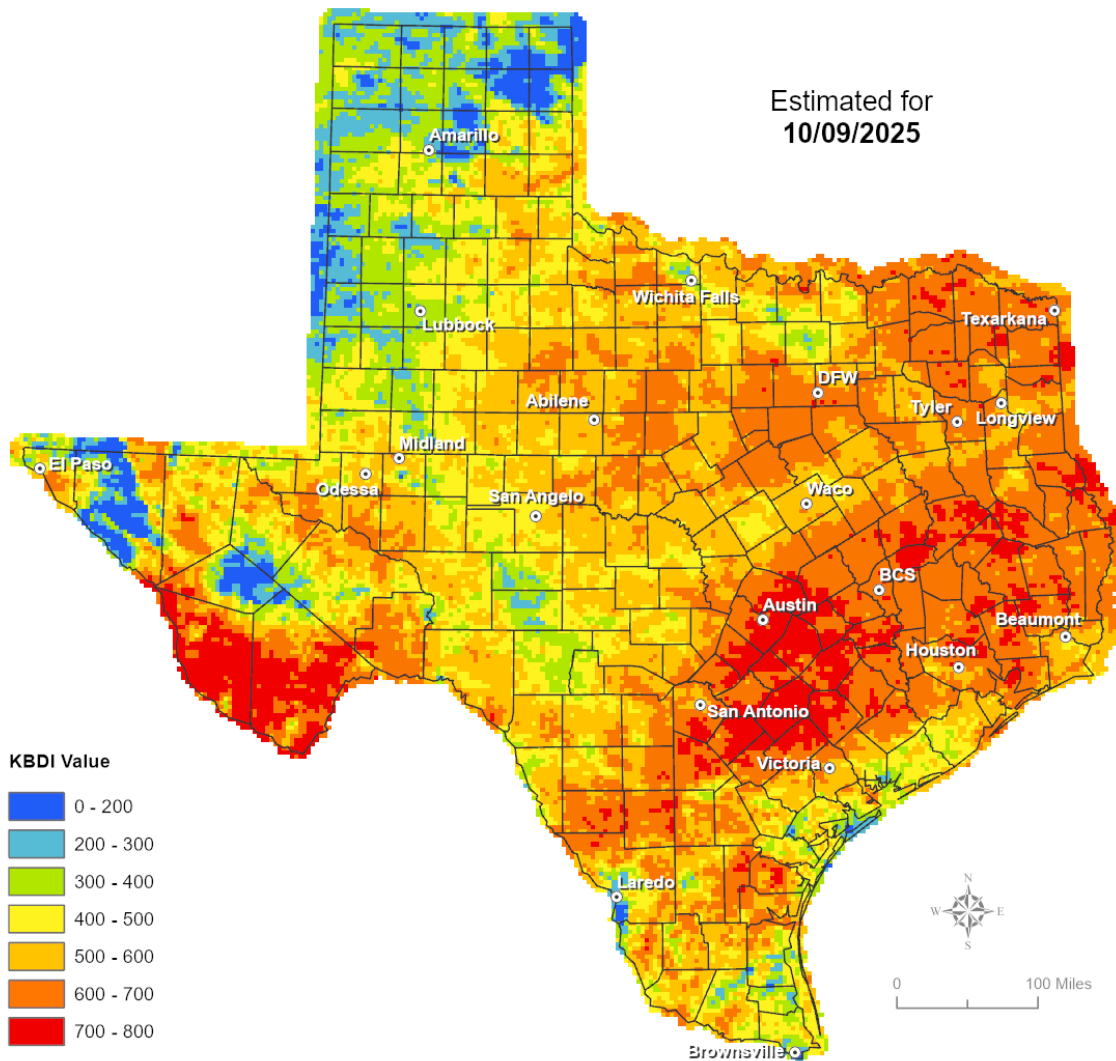

Keetch-Byram Drought Index

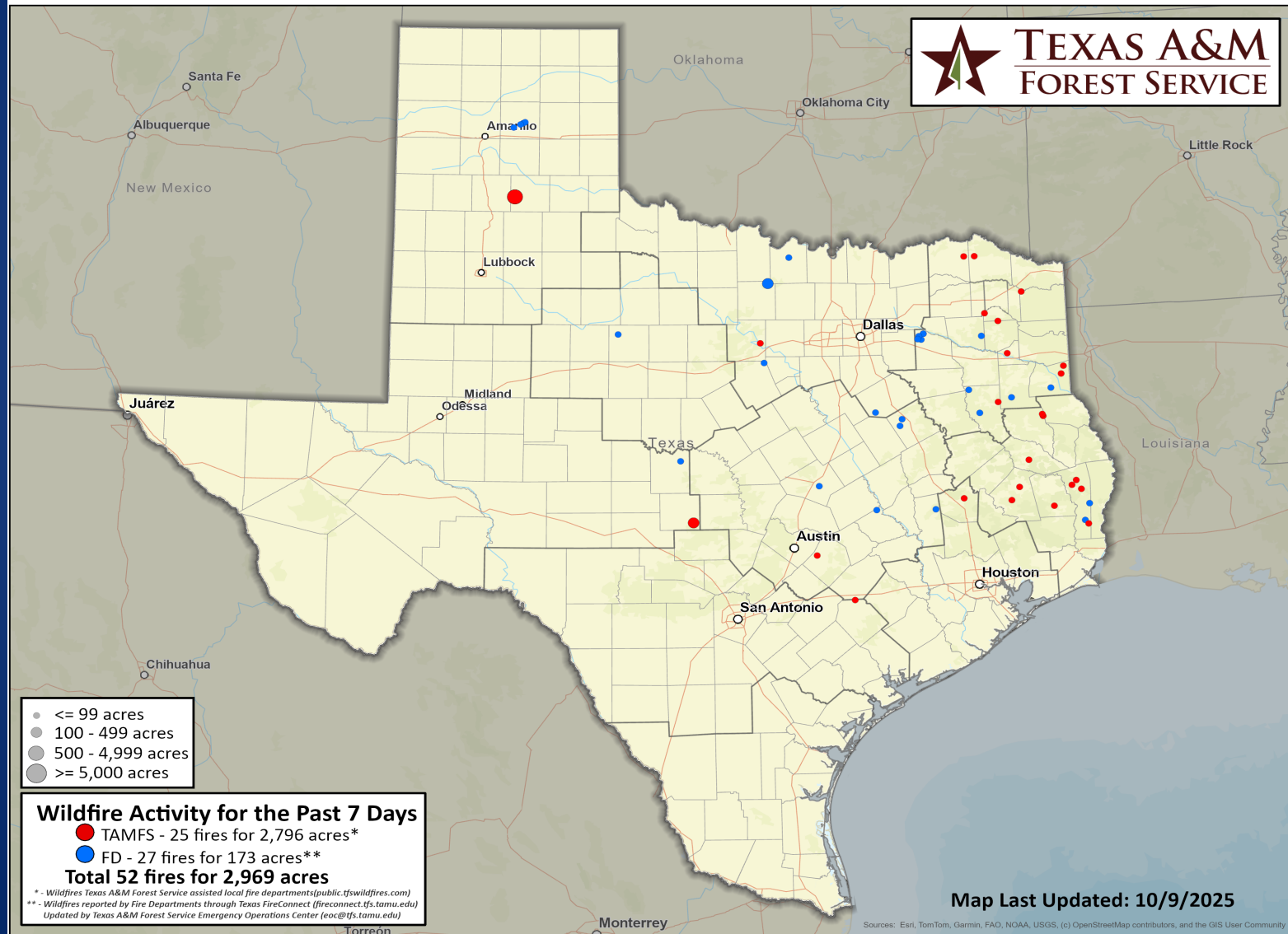
