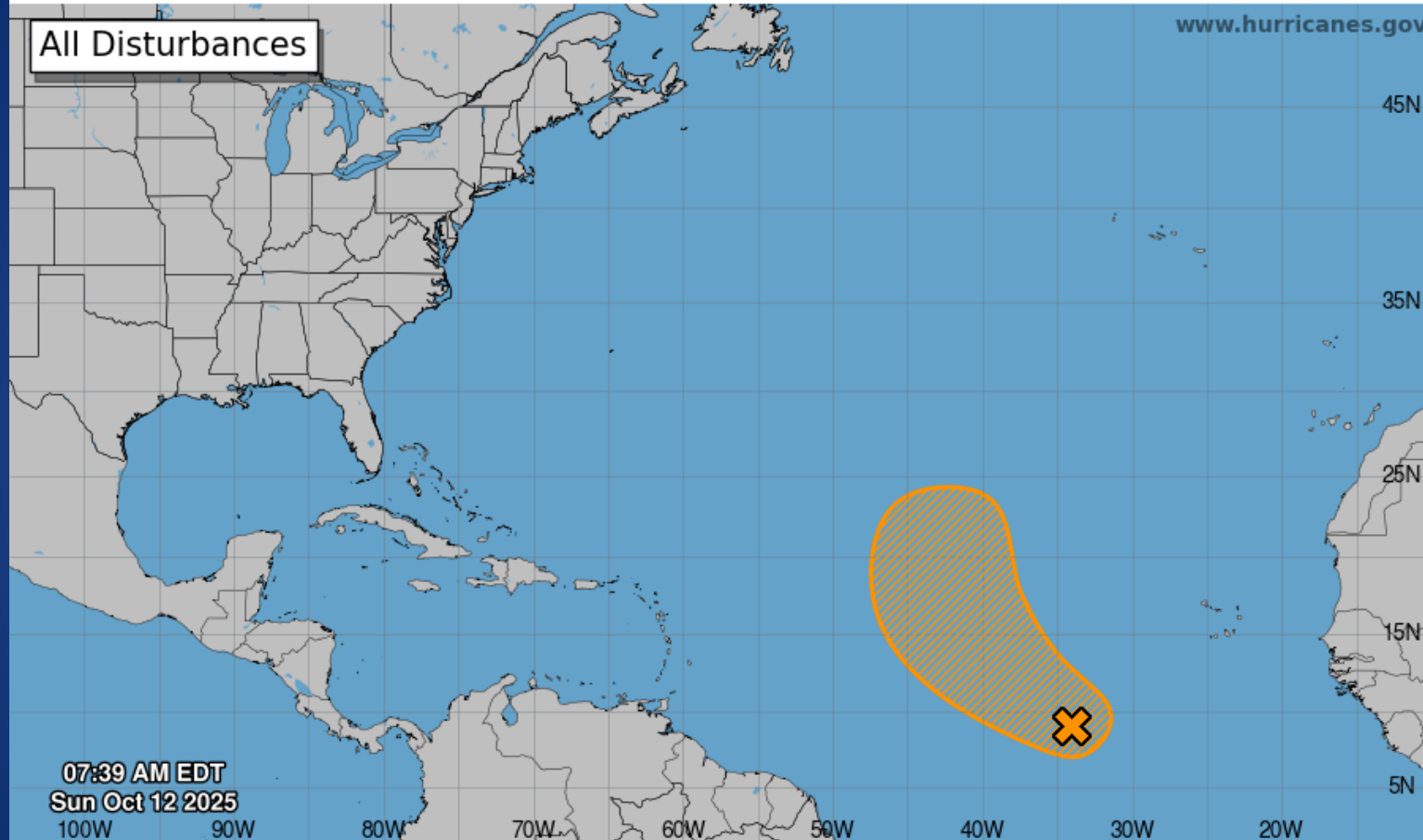
Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

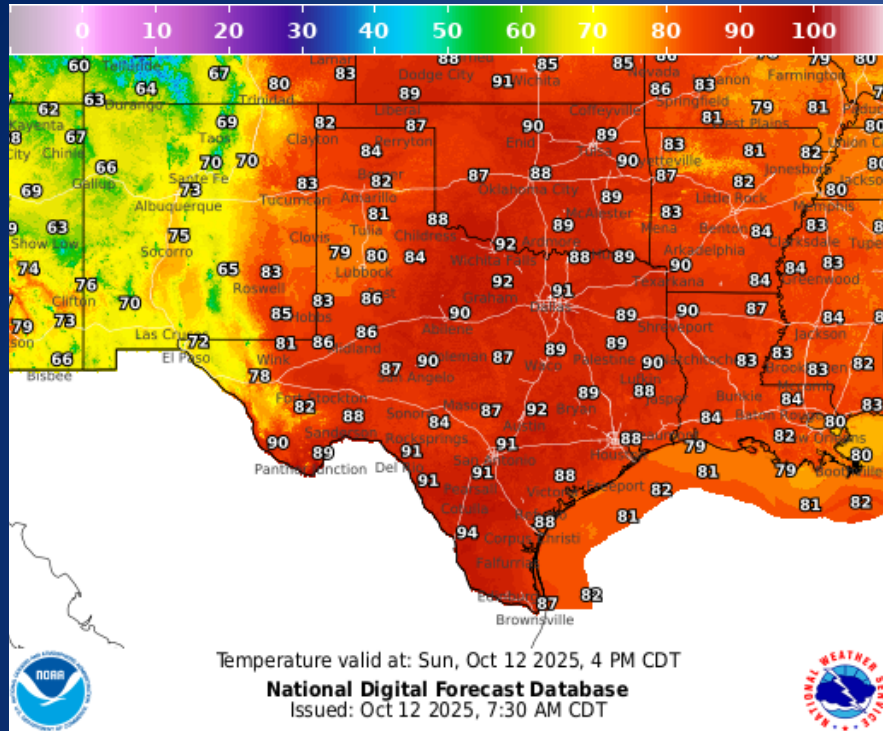

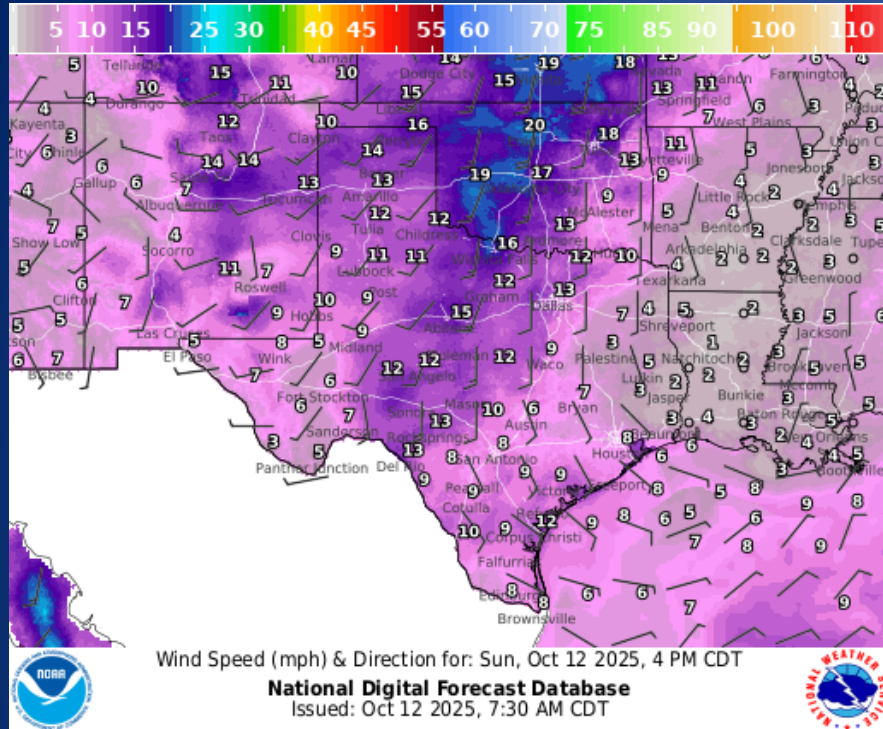

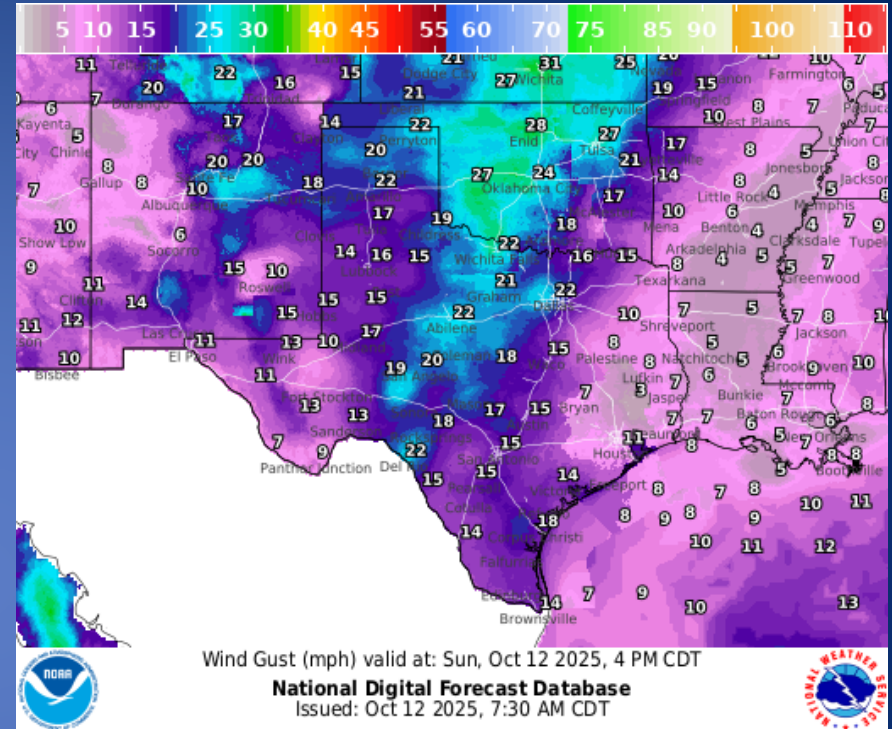

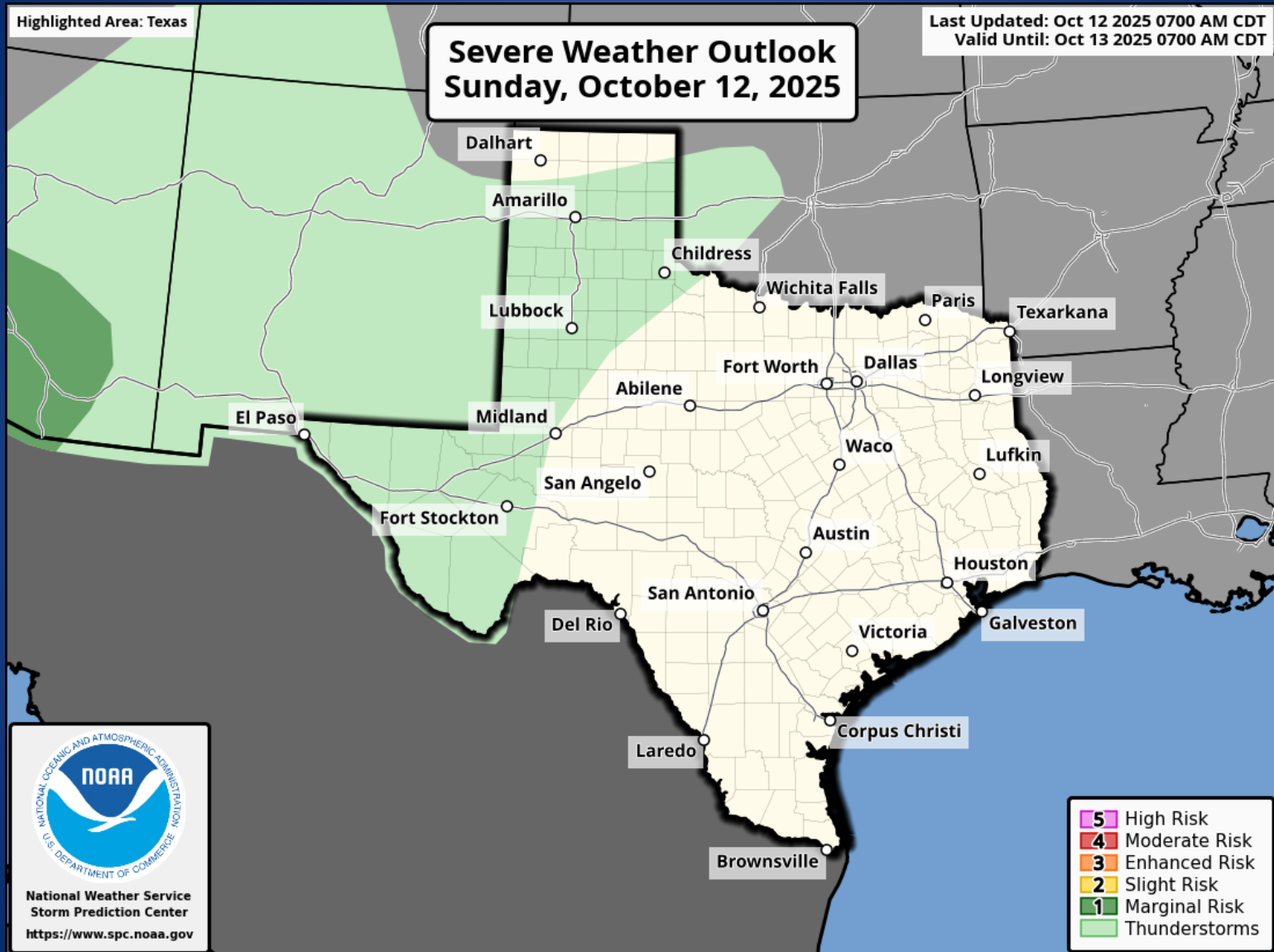

Middle Texas Coast, Bays, and Barrier Islands

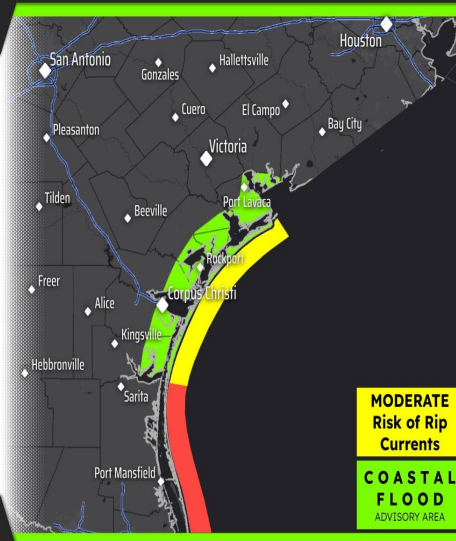


- Inundation up to 1.5 feet

Weather Scenario

→ Tropical remnants from TS Raymond keep moisture above record levels, resulting in scattered to widespread showers and isolated thunderstorms on Sunday



→ Greatest threat: Southwestern NM
→ Lower threat: Northern areas



→ Mostly light-moderate rain rates over a long duration (rain slowly piles up)
→ Isolated storms bring a quick 0.5-1"

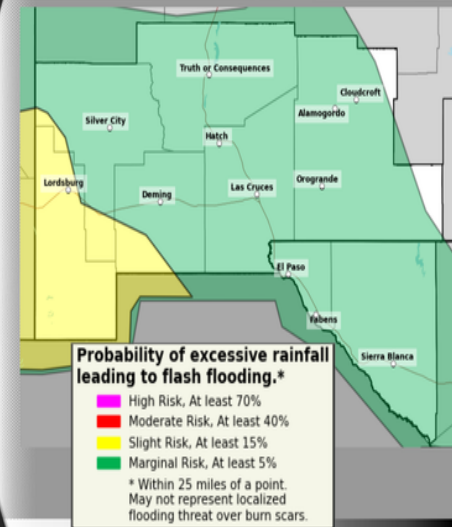

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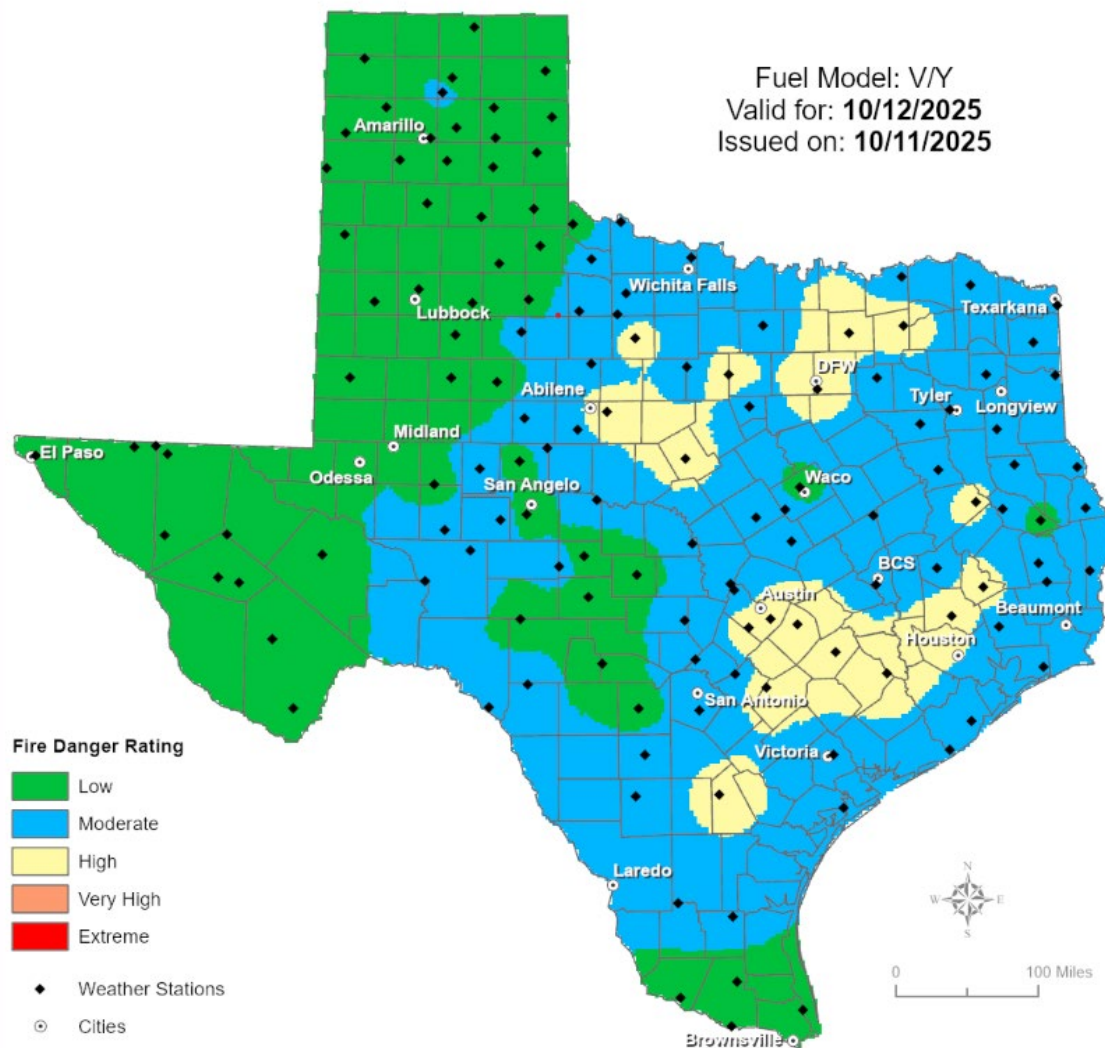
Excessive Rainfall Outlook for Sunday. Highest threat for flooding is in southwest NM, then into far west TX.

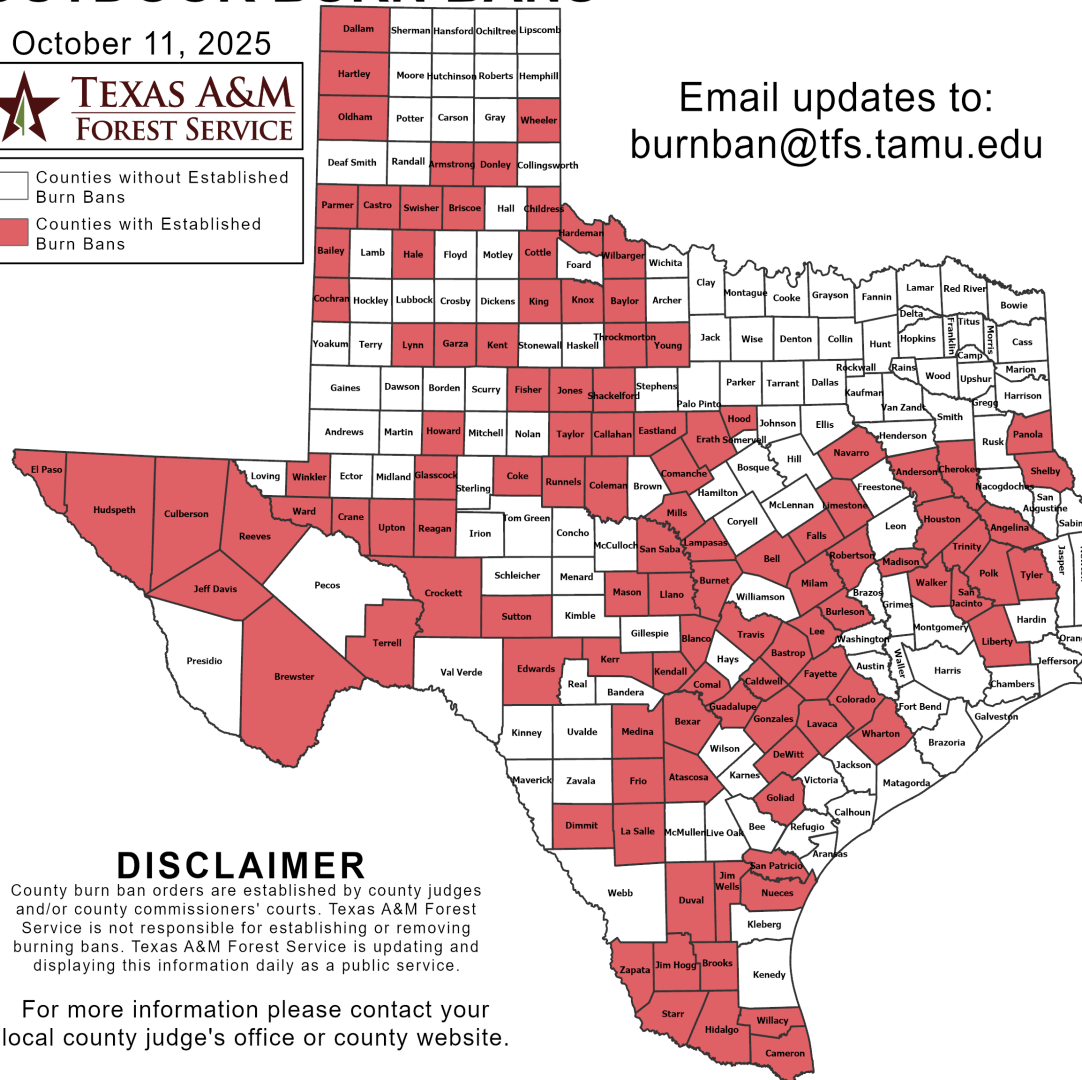

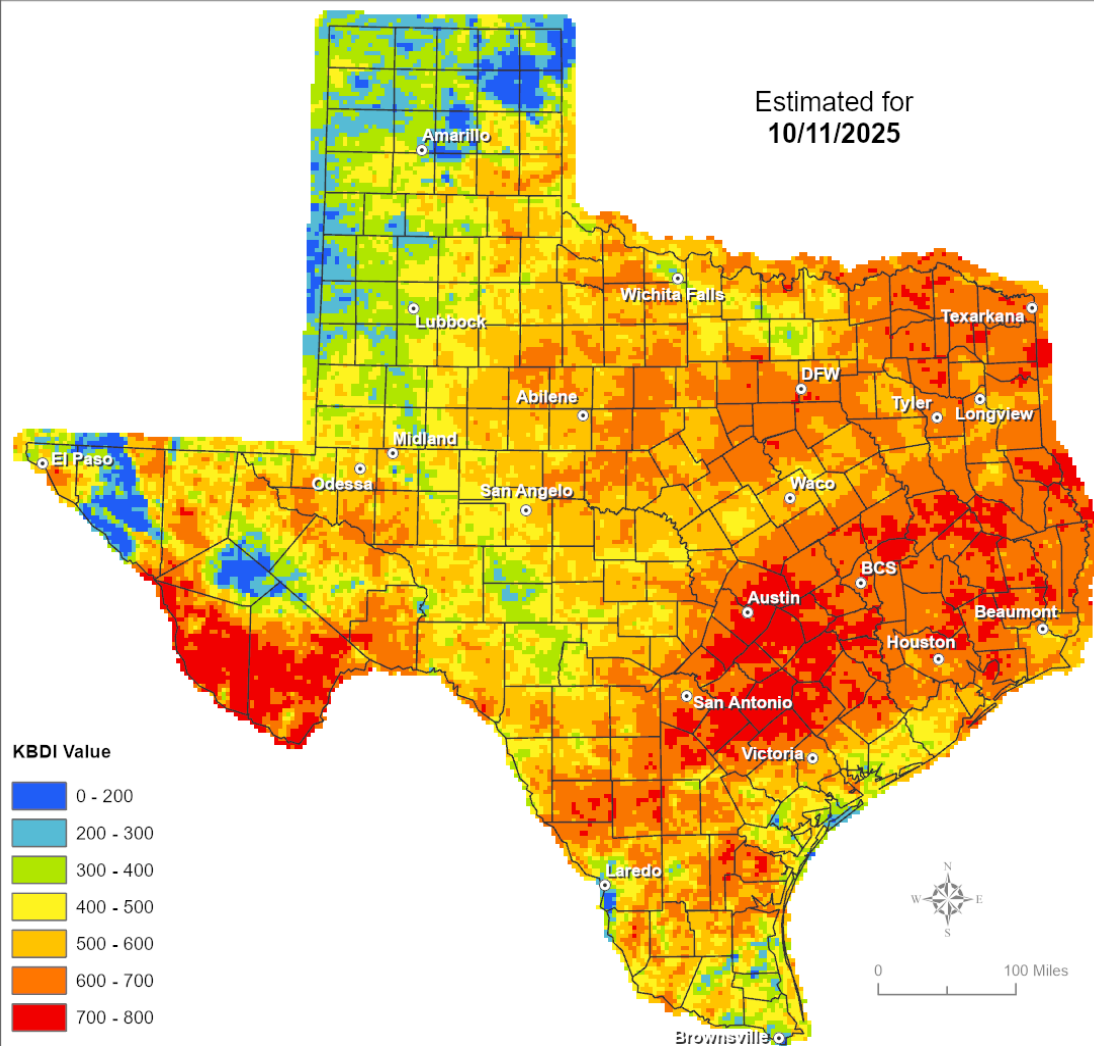

Keetch-Byram Drought Index

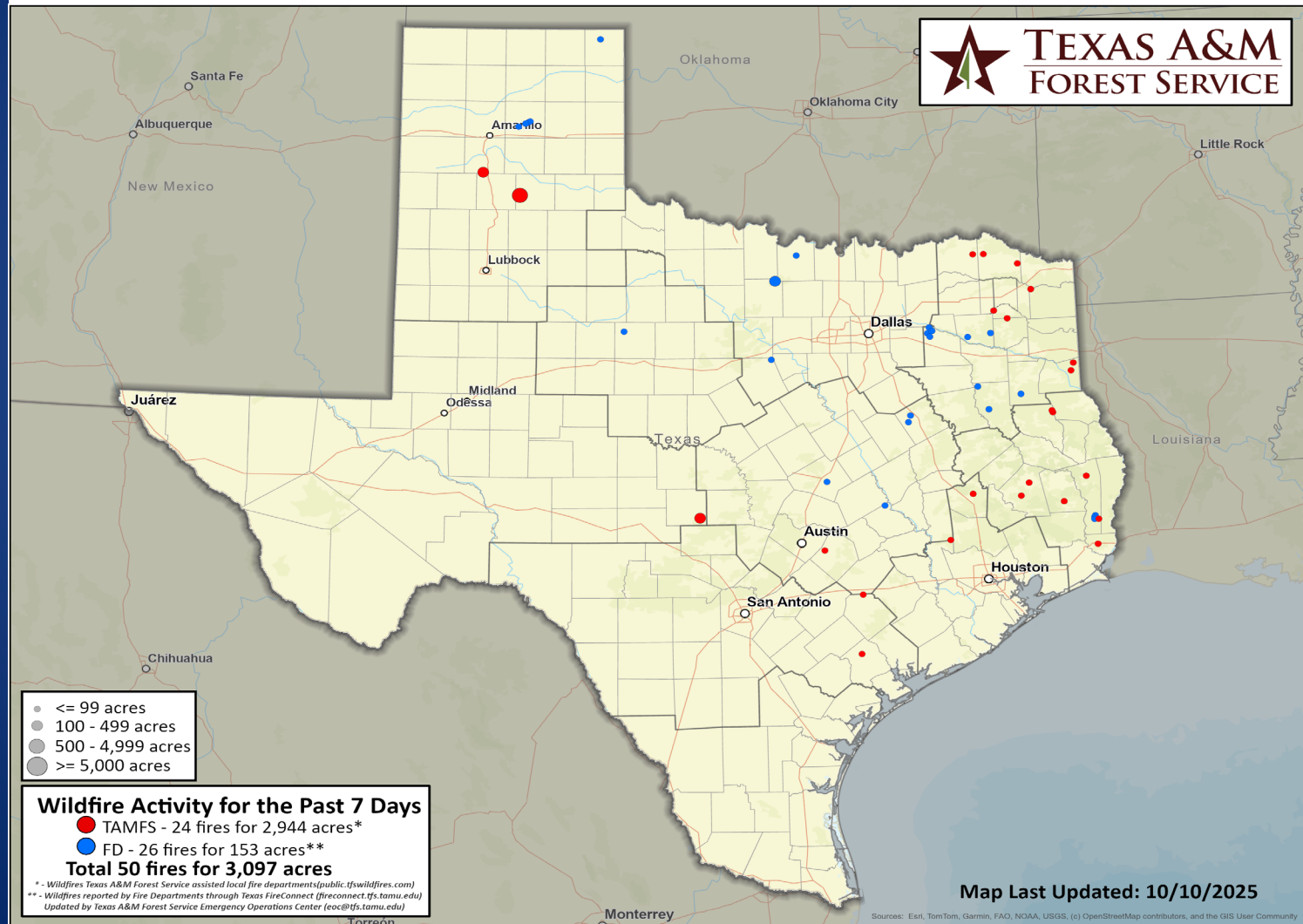

Report of 551 (No Change) fires and 95,387 (No Change) acres have been burned this year. There are 113 (No Change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 224 (+1) counties with an average over 400.
