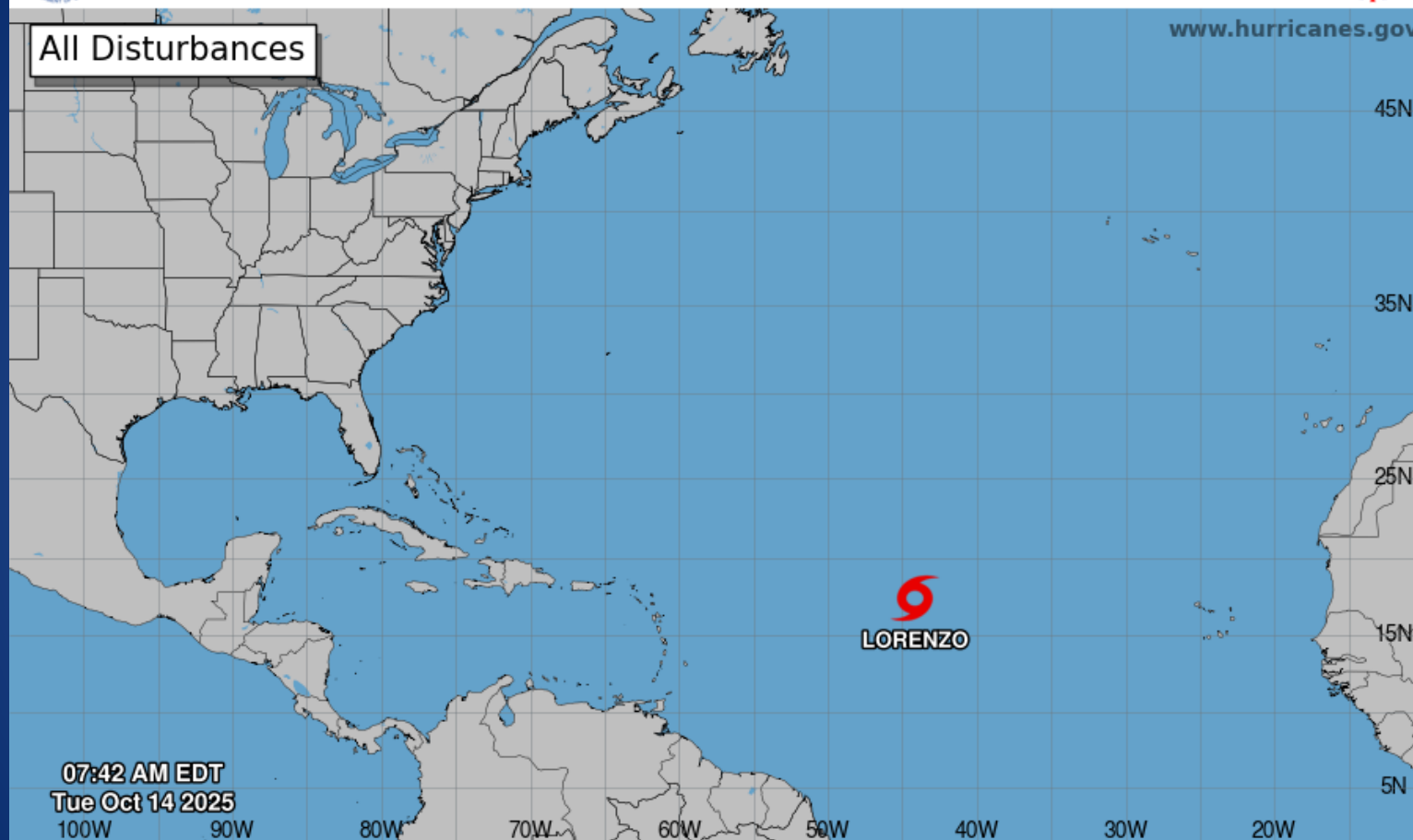
## Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

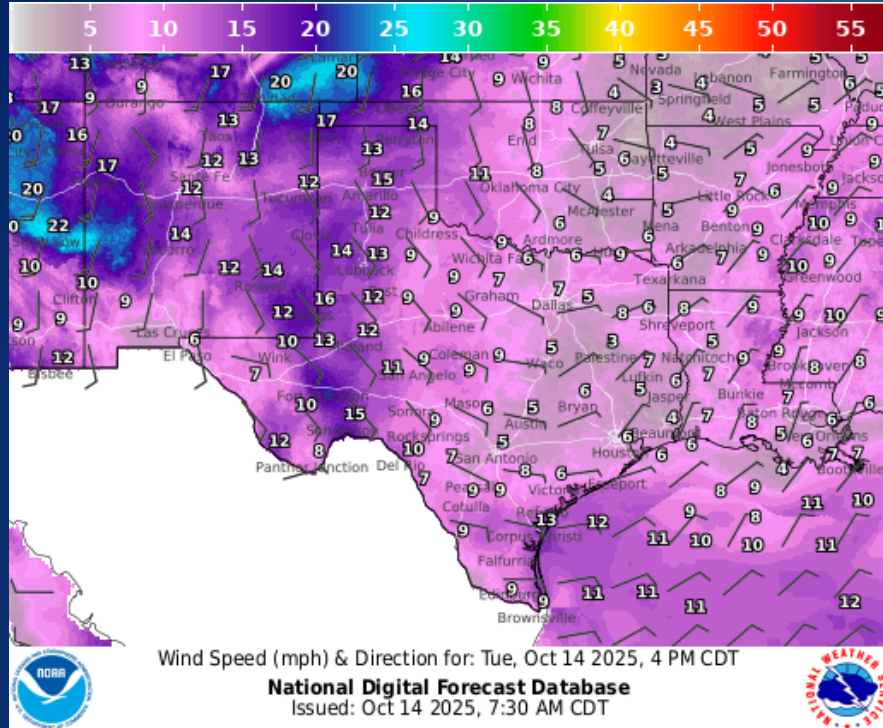

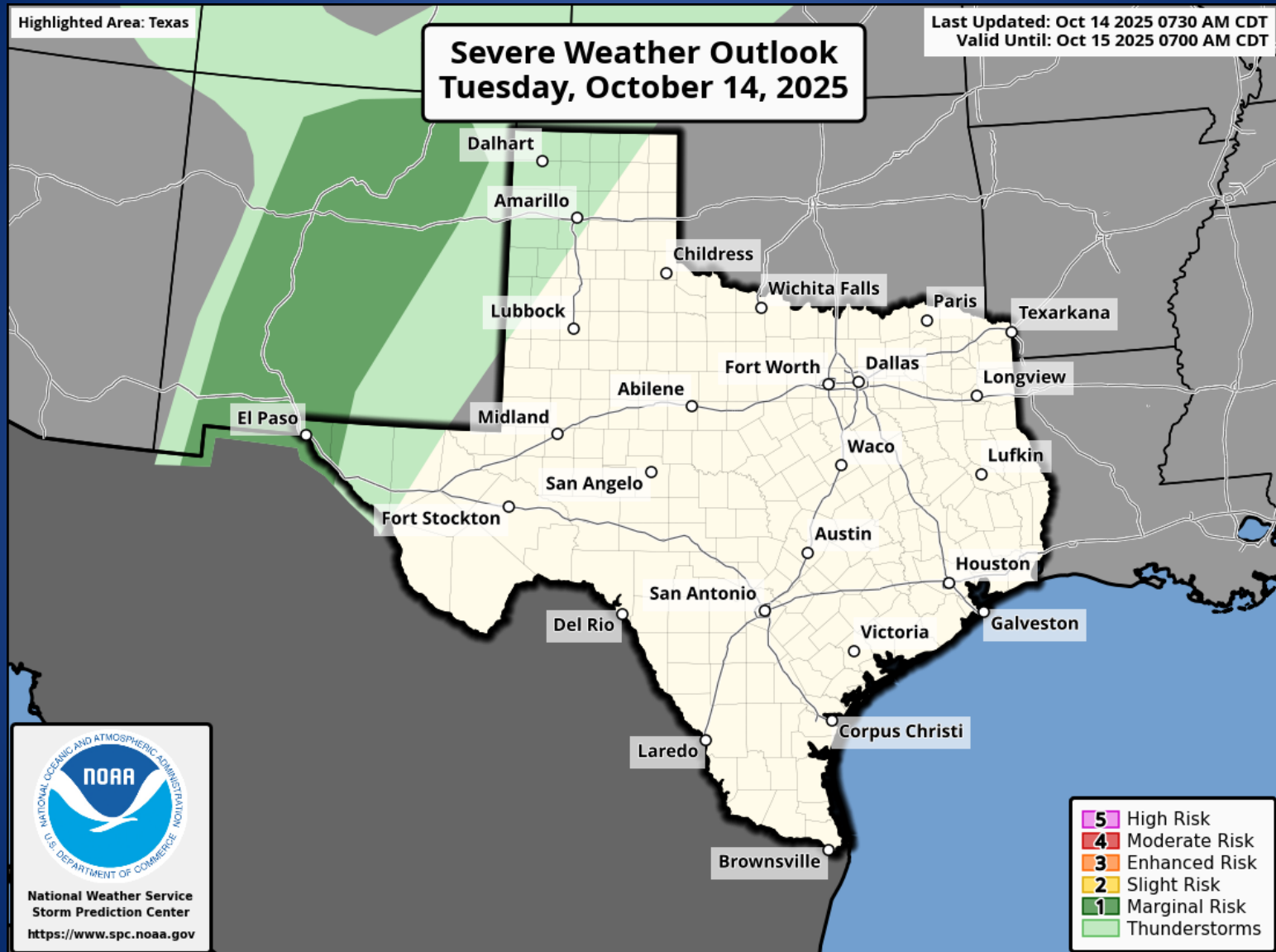

Thunderstorms will develop late in the afternoon and into the evening hours.



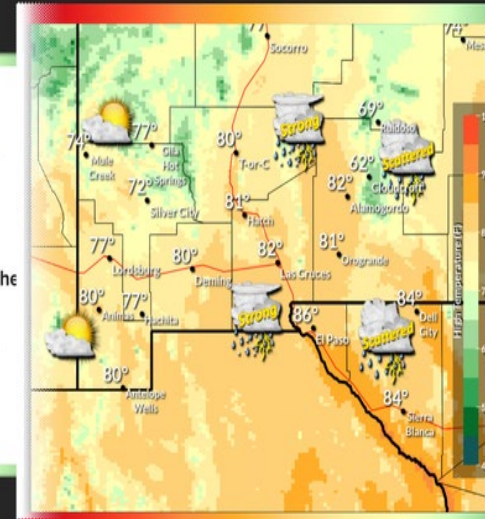

## Keetch-Byram Drought Index

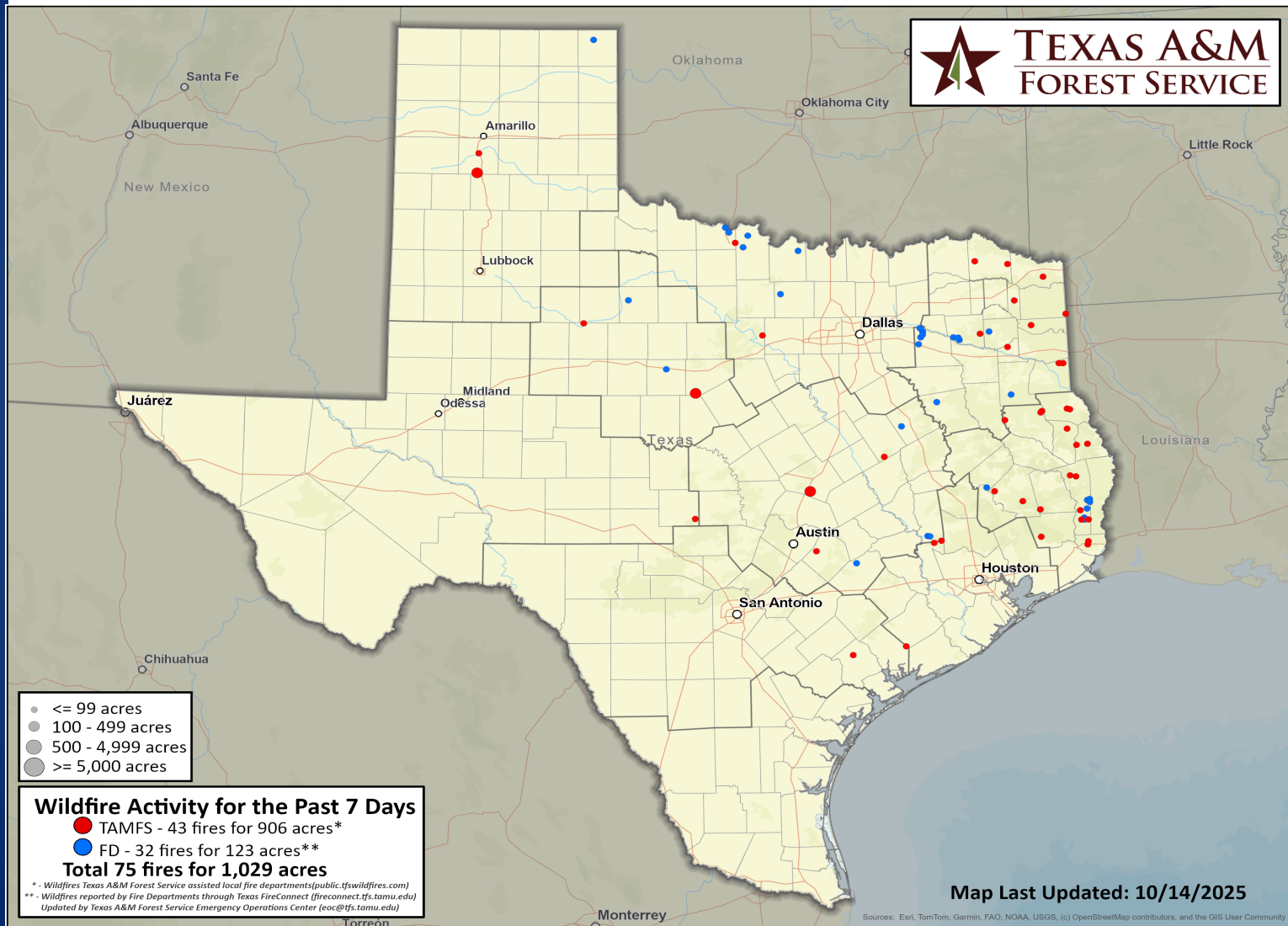
