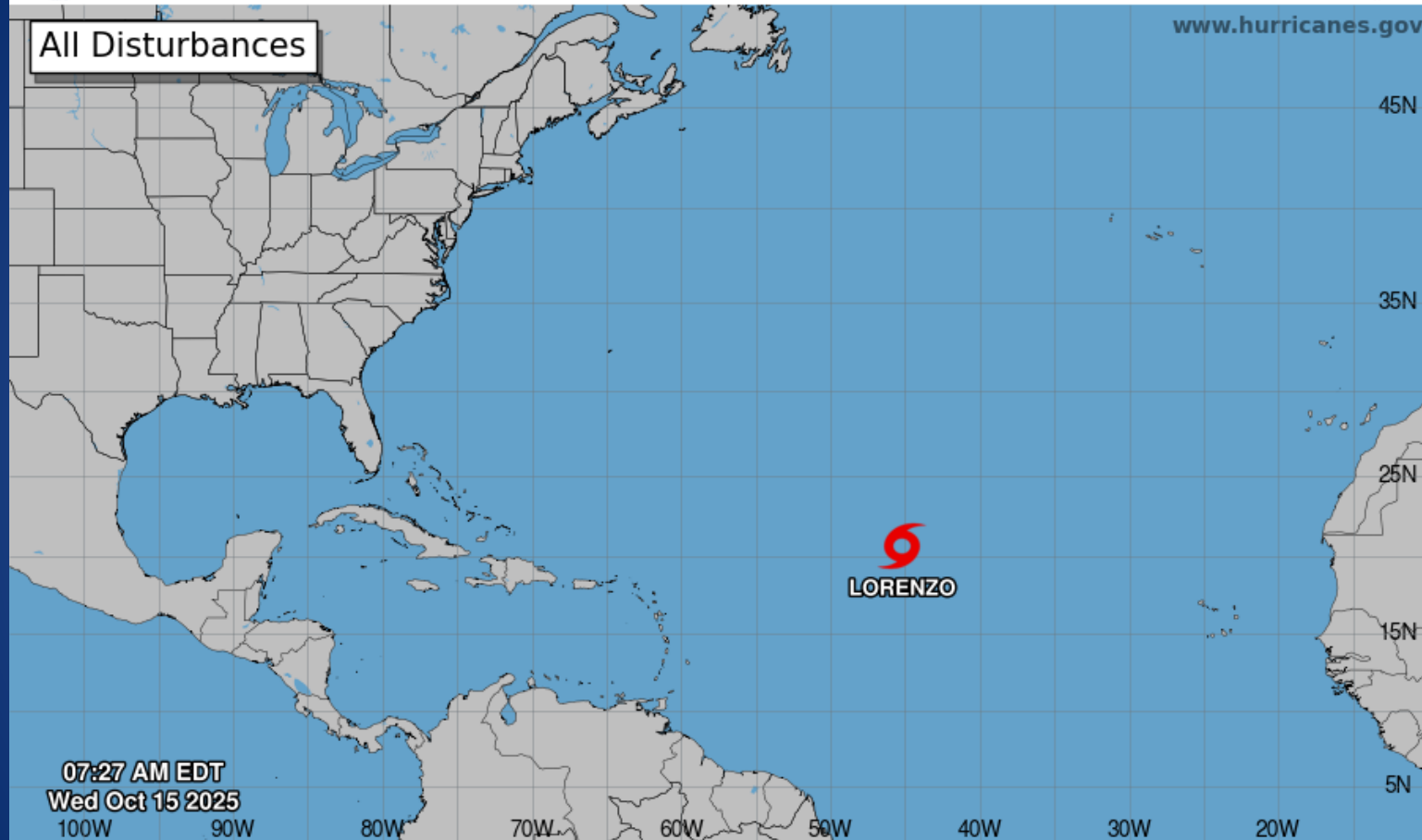
Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

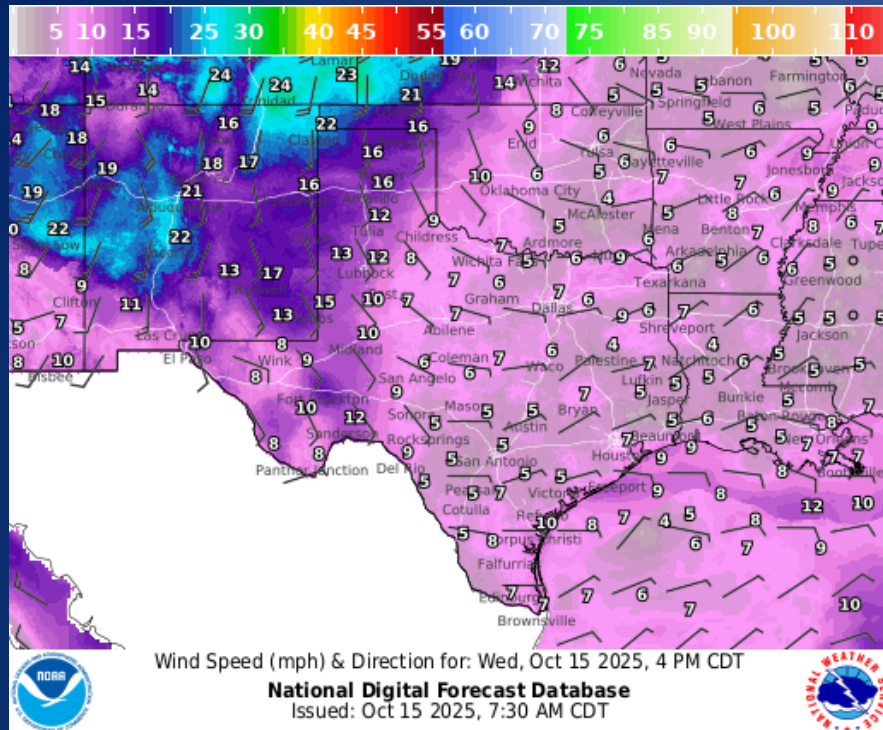

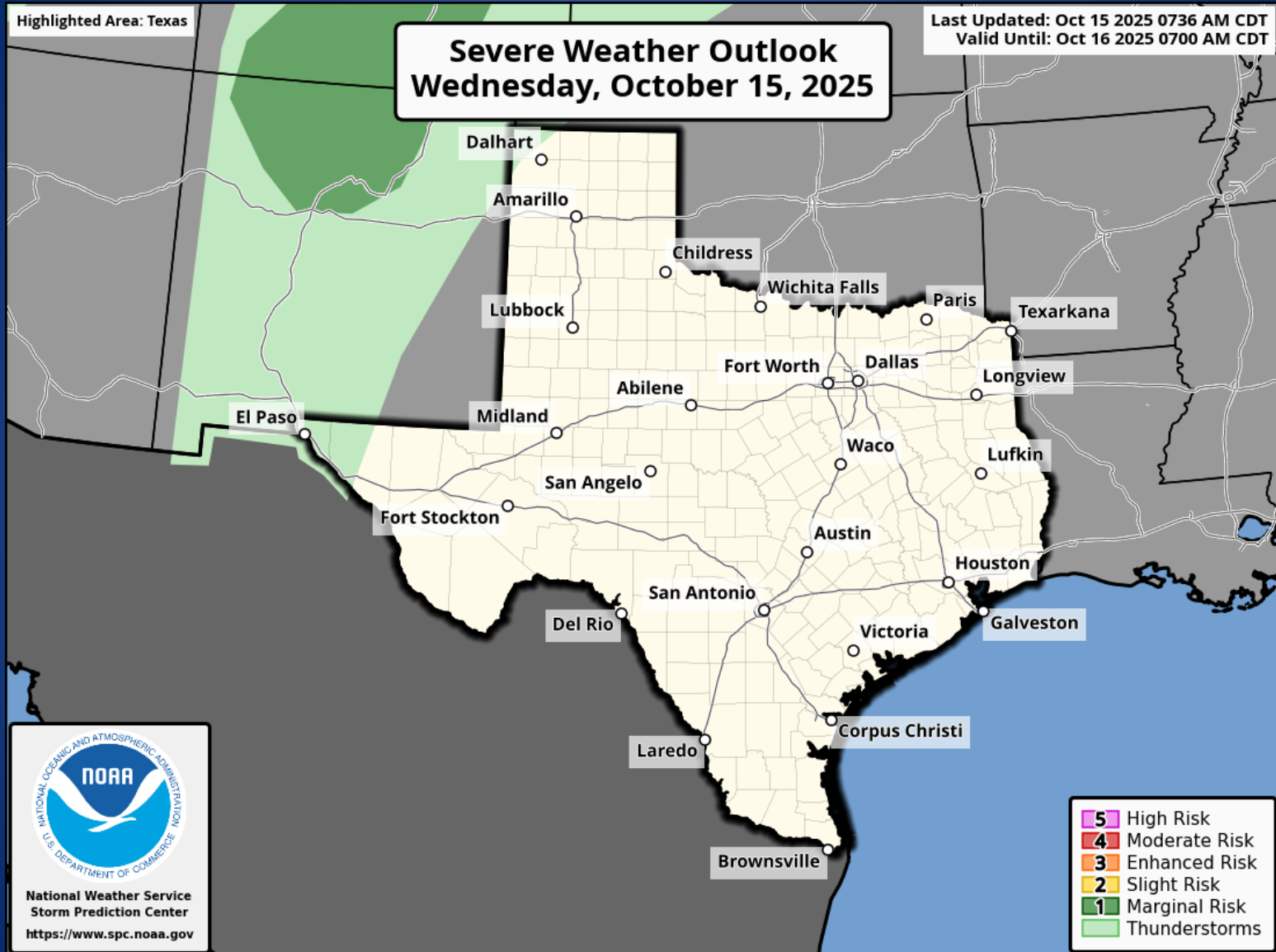

Warm and dry weather will bring a greater risk of fire across Southeast Texas

Only you can prevent wildfires! Here's how:



AVOID any activities that could spark a wildfire, as fires could spread rapidly



Do NOT leave a fire unattended or burn unnecessarily.



Secure tow chains to avoid dragging and sparking. NEVER park or drive over tall grass.



Contact law enforcement or the fire department if you smell smoke or see fire!



NEVER toss lit cigarettes on the ground!

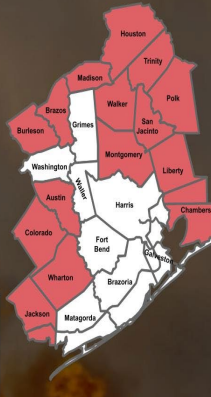

Fire Weather Outlook for Southeast Texas (Updated Tue Oct 14, 2025). Warm and dry weather is bringing a greater risk of fire. You can prevent wildfires! Key safety tips include: Avoid activities that could spark a fire, never leave a fire unattended, secure tow chains to prevent dragging/sparking, and never toss lit cigarettes on the ground. Check the fire danger map and outdoor burn bans for your county!

Elevated Fire Danger Wednesday



Key Message

Elevated Fire Danger expected on Wednesday from noon to 6 pm. The highest fire danger is expected for all of southeast Texas, Central, and Southwest Louisiana. Fires can spread rapidly in these conditions. Outside burning is discouraged except by experienced fire personnel.



Hazards

Relative Humidity: As low as 30 to 35 percent.

20 Foot Winds: East-Northeast 5 to 10 mph.

Fuels: Increasing drought across the region will continue to make smaller fuels available for burning. KBDI values are between 550 and 750 area wide.



Actions

Avoid activities that cause open flames or sparks. Properly discard of cigarettes.

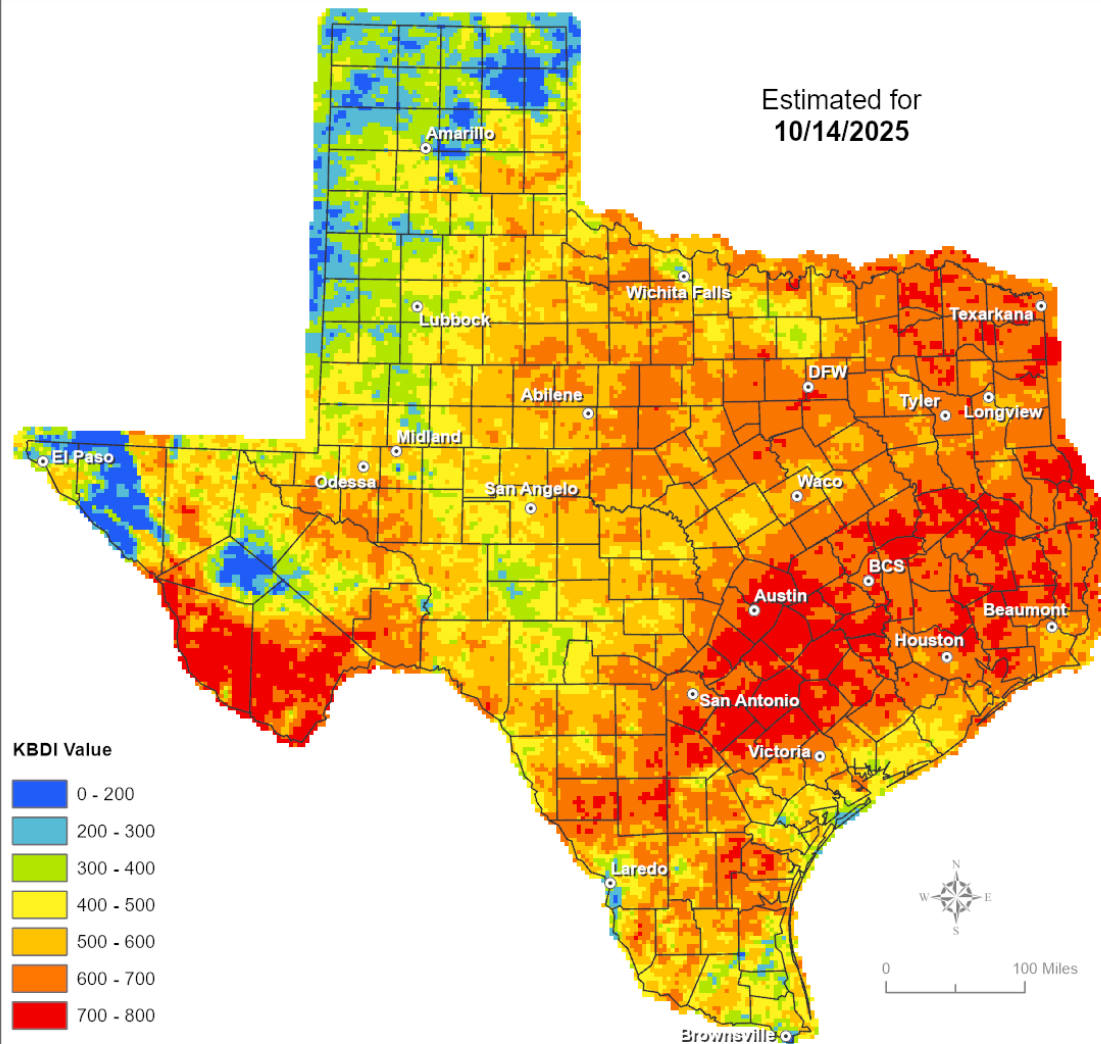

Report of 584 (+8) fires and 96,079 (+315) acres have been burned this year. There are 140 (+17) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 226 (no change) counties with an average over 400.
