




Wind Speeds

A solid freeze looks to be in play Thursday morning for any areas that fail to freeze on Wednesday. At this point all areas have a good chance to have their season ending freeze. While there will still be cold wind chills on Thursday, the wind speeds will not be as strong, so the wind chill difference will not be as much as it was on Wednesday.




A Wind Advisory remains in effect for most of South-Central Texas through 7 pm this evening. Secure loose objects and holiday decorations. Avoid outdoor burning and dispose of matches/cigarettes properly. Follow burn bans.


The combination of strong northwesterly winds, very low humidity, rapidly drying grasses and brush, and warm temperatures (70s to lower 80s) will produce high to potentially extreme fire weather conditions on Wednesday. Most critical times will be from mid morning to late afternoon. Farmers, ranchers, and others should avoid any activity that could create sparks that produces a rapidly spreading wildfire.




Stronger northerly winds and low relative humidity behind a cold front will result in critical fire weather conditions on Wednesday. A Red Flag Warning is in effect Wednesday morning through Wednesday evening across all of South Texas.




A Wind Advisory is in effect for all of North and Central Texas through 6 PM today. Strong winds will continue in the wake of Tuesday's cold front, with peak gusts of 35 to 45 mph and sustained northwest winds of 20 to 30 mph. Drivers, especially those in high-profile vehicles, should exercise extra caution.





## **Keetch-Byram Drought Index**



Report of 652 (no change) fires and 97,952 (no change) acres have been burned this year. There are 141 (-3) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 201 (+3) counties with an average over 400.
