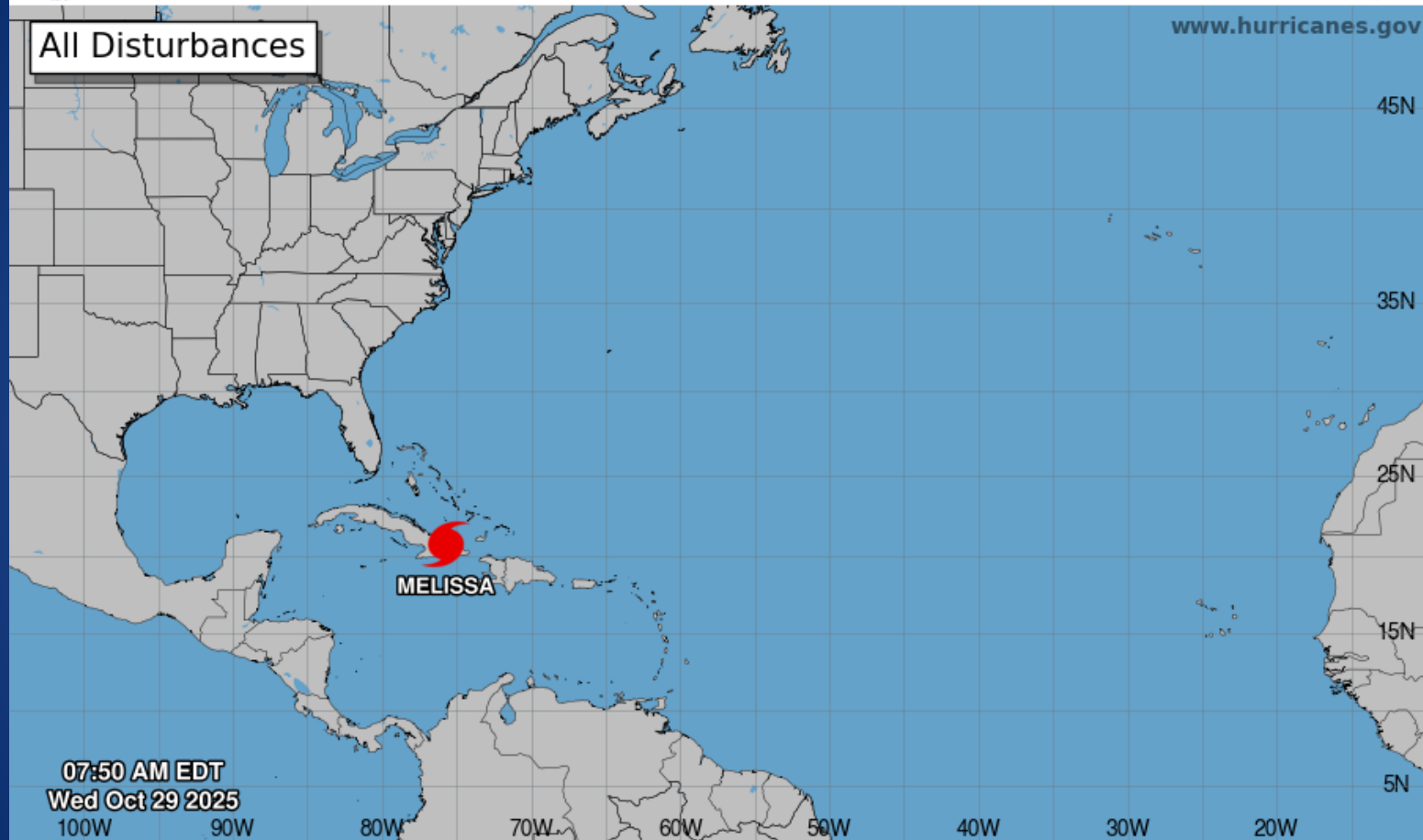
Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

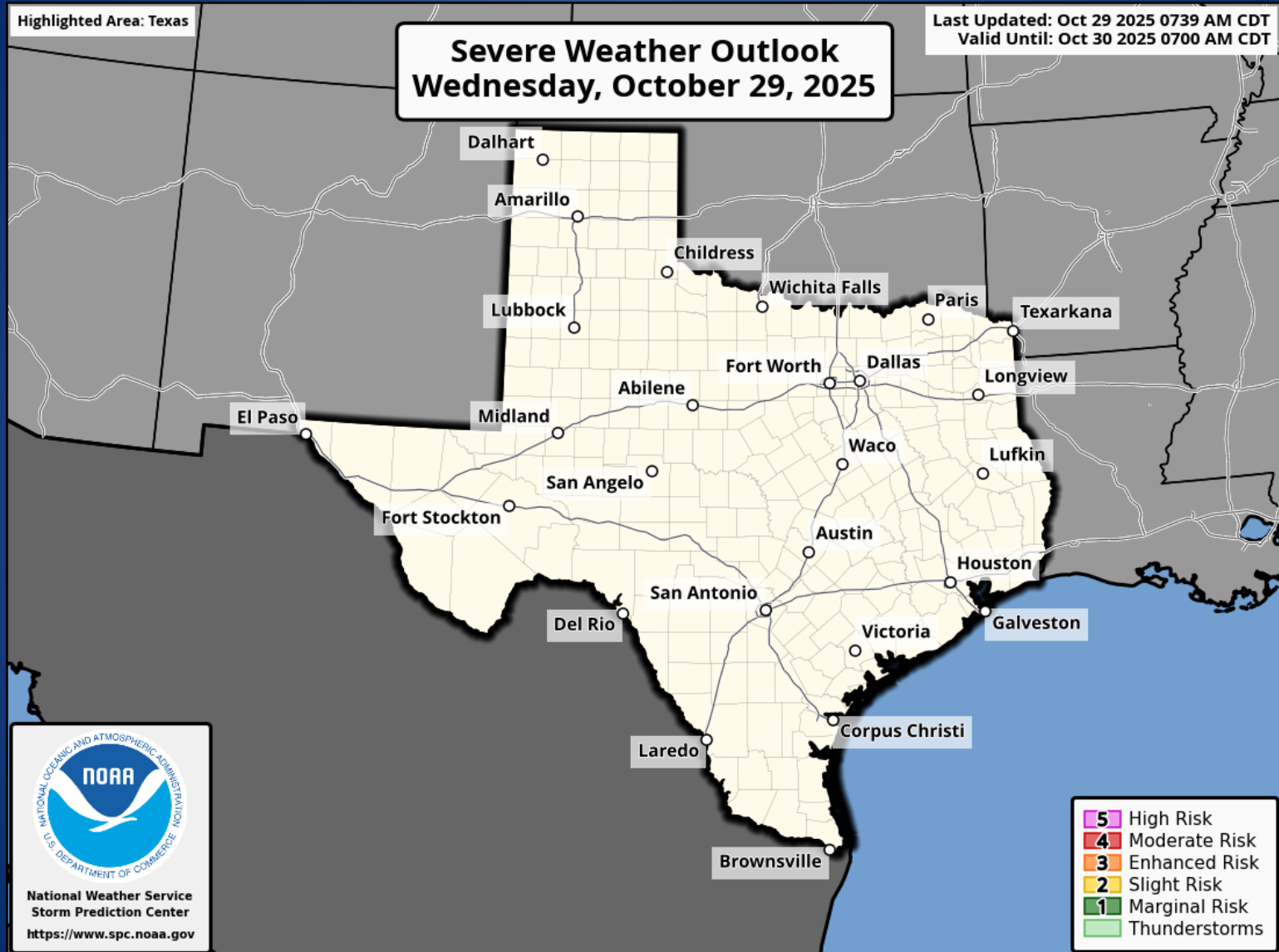

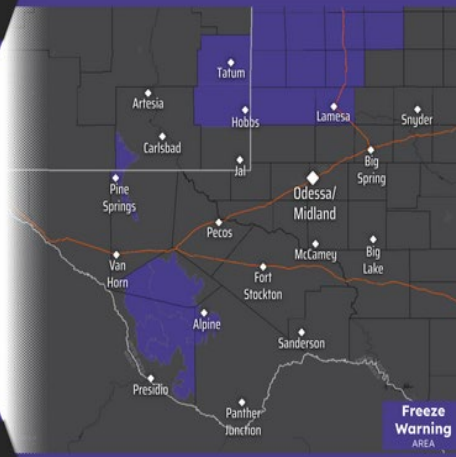

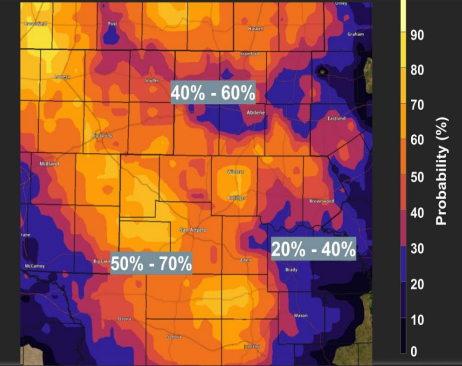
Frost/Light Freeze Possible Thursday Morning

Key Messages

- There is a medium to high chance (50-70%) of low temperatures dropping below 35 degrees across much of the area on Thursday. A frost or light freeze is becoming increasingly likely.

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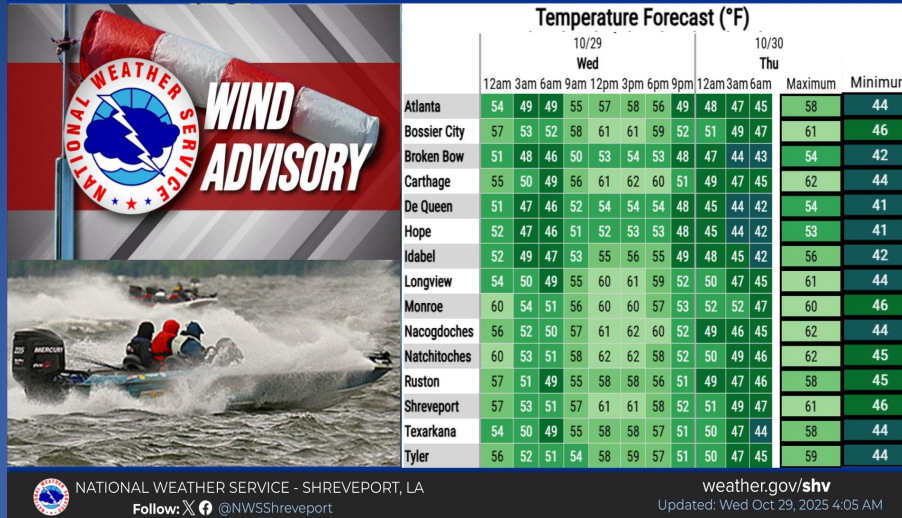

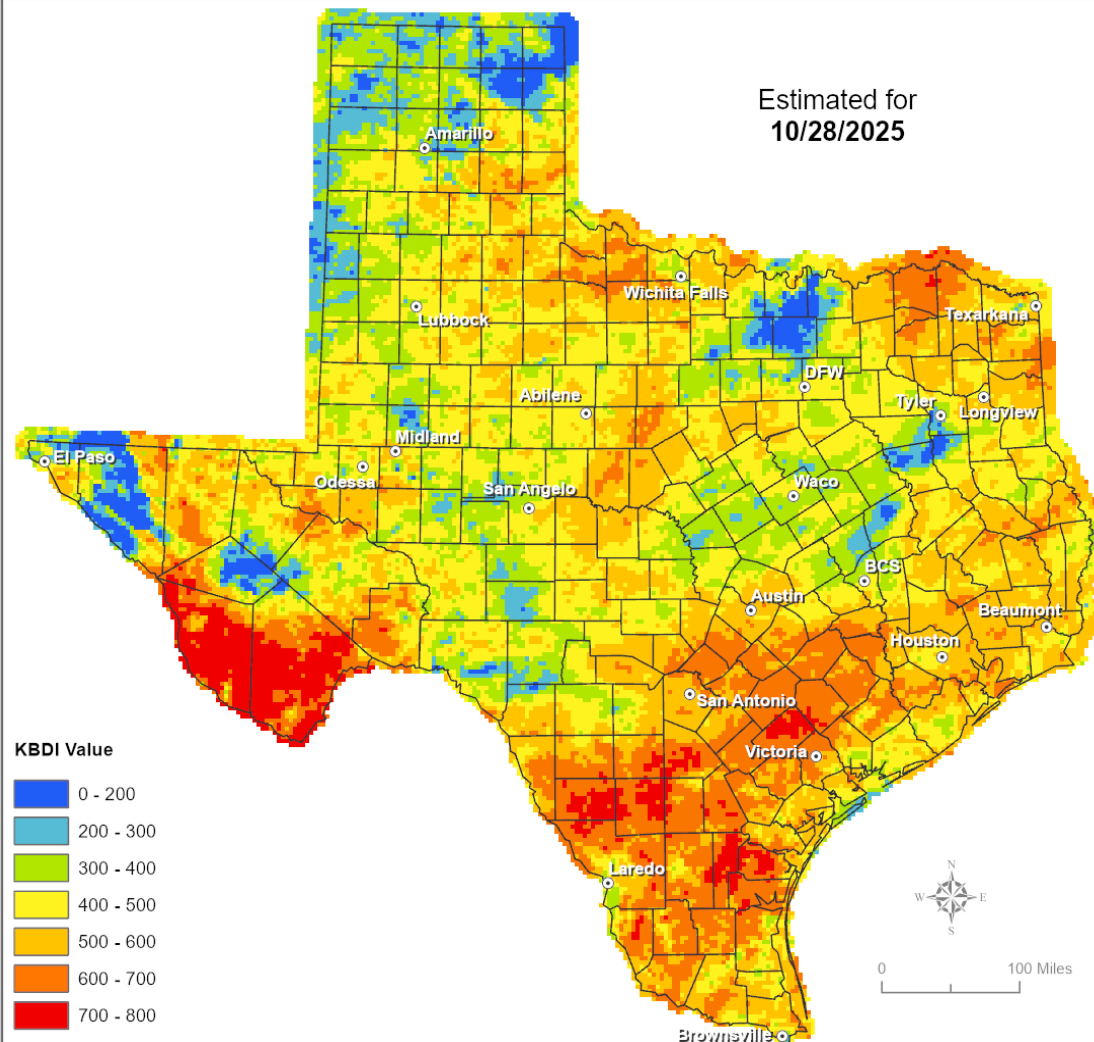
