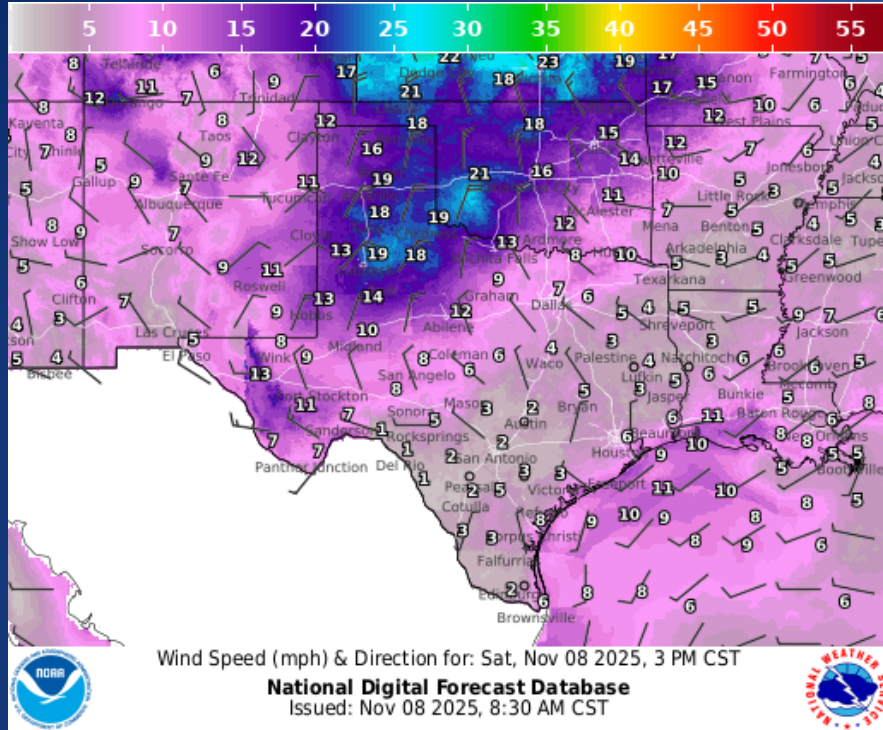

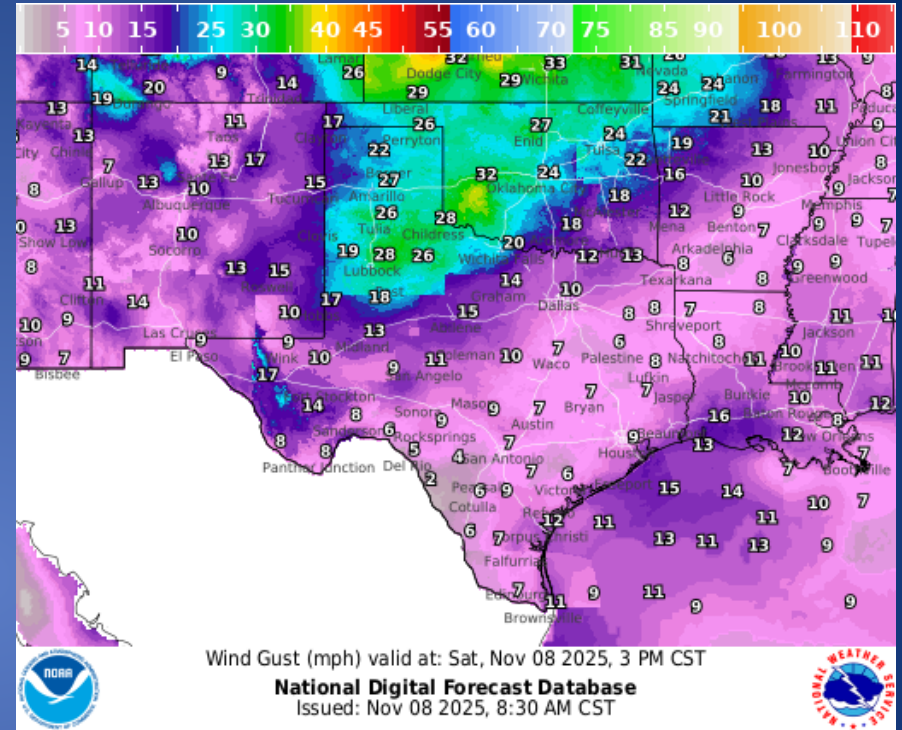

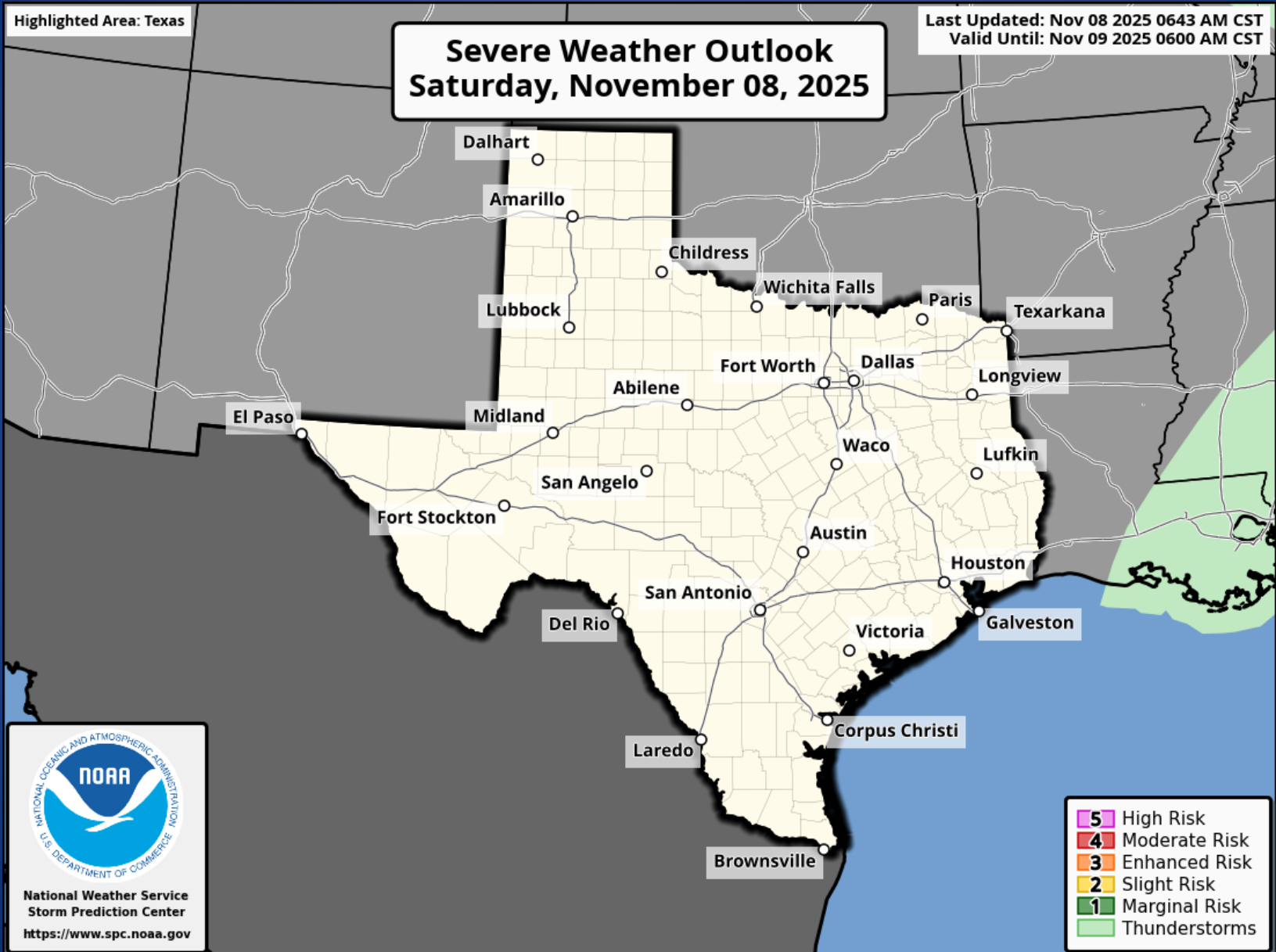


Wind Speeds

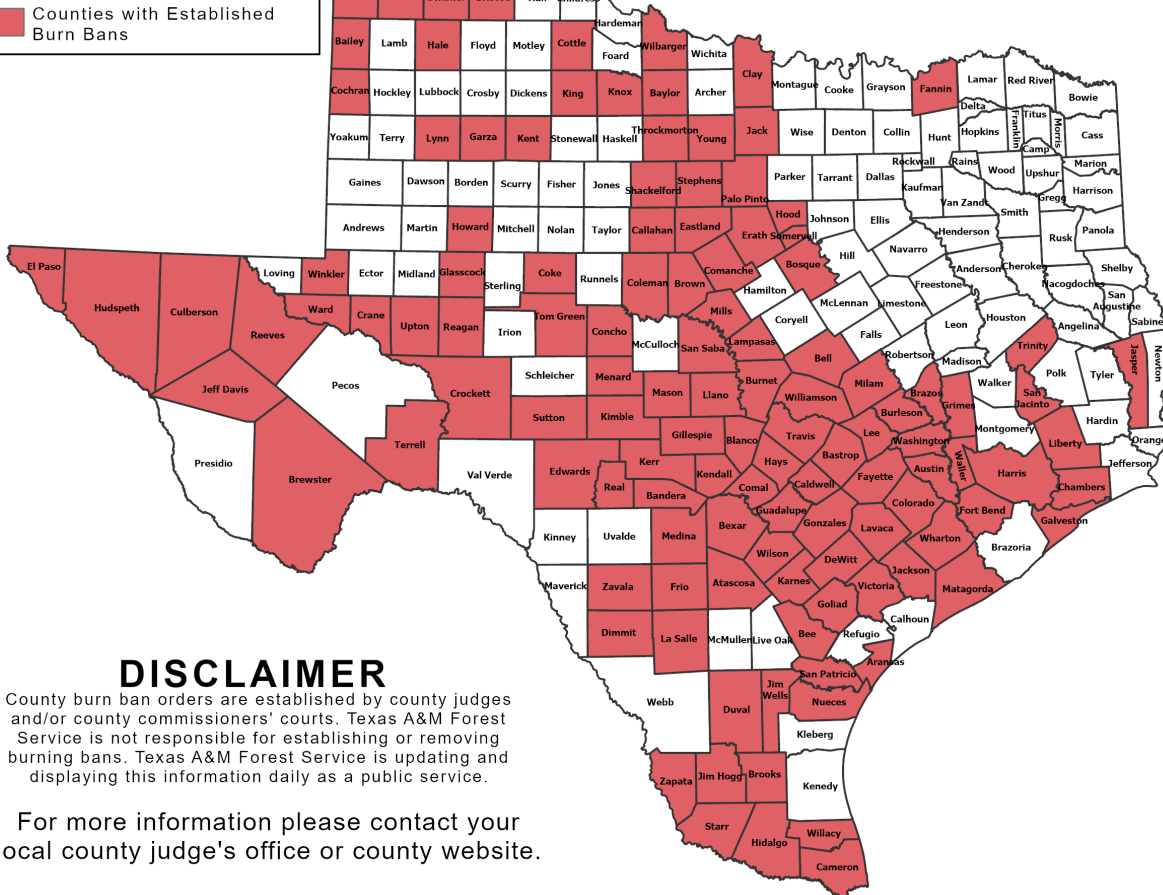

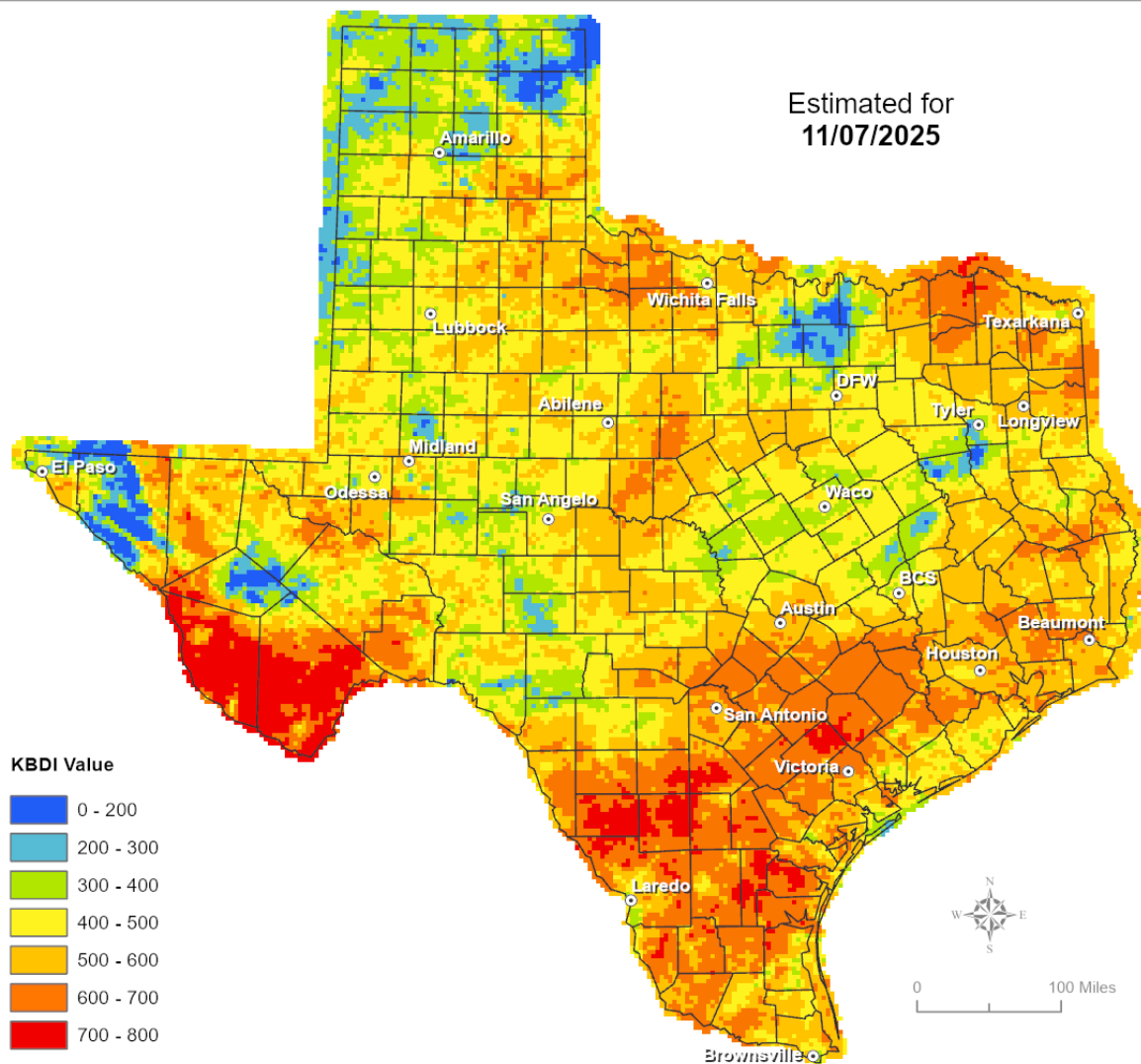

Report of 688 (+3) fires and 98,508 (+55) acres have been burned this year. There are 131 (No Change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 221 (+2) counties with an average over 400.
