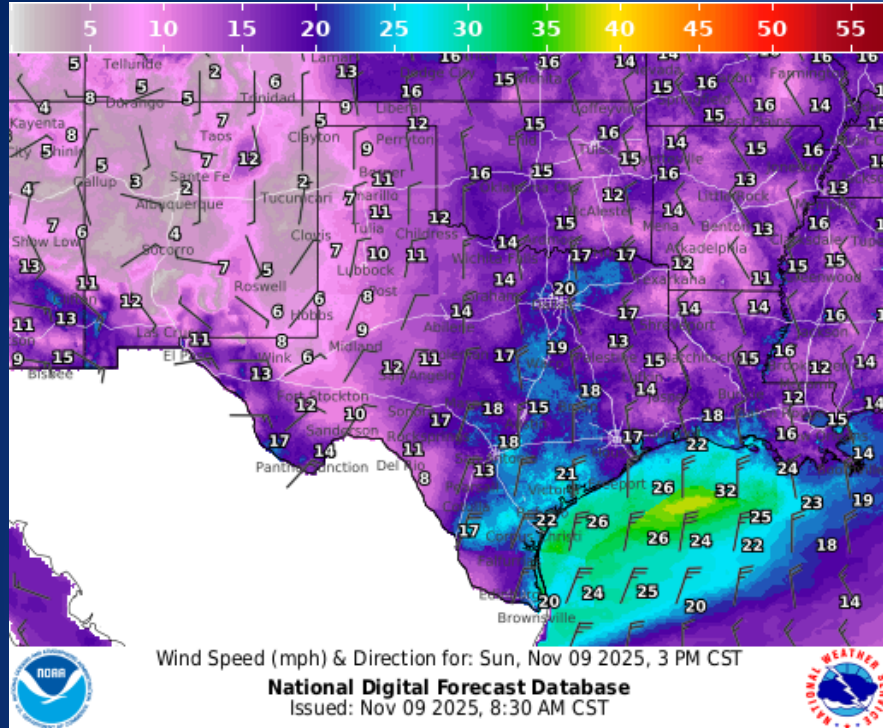

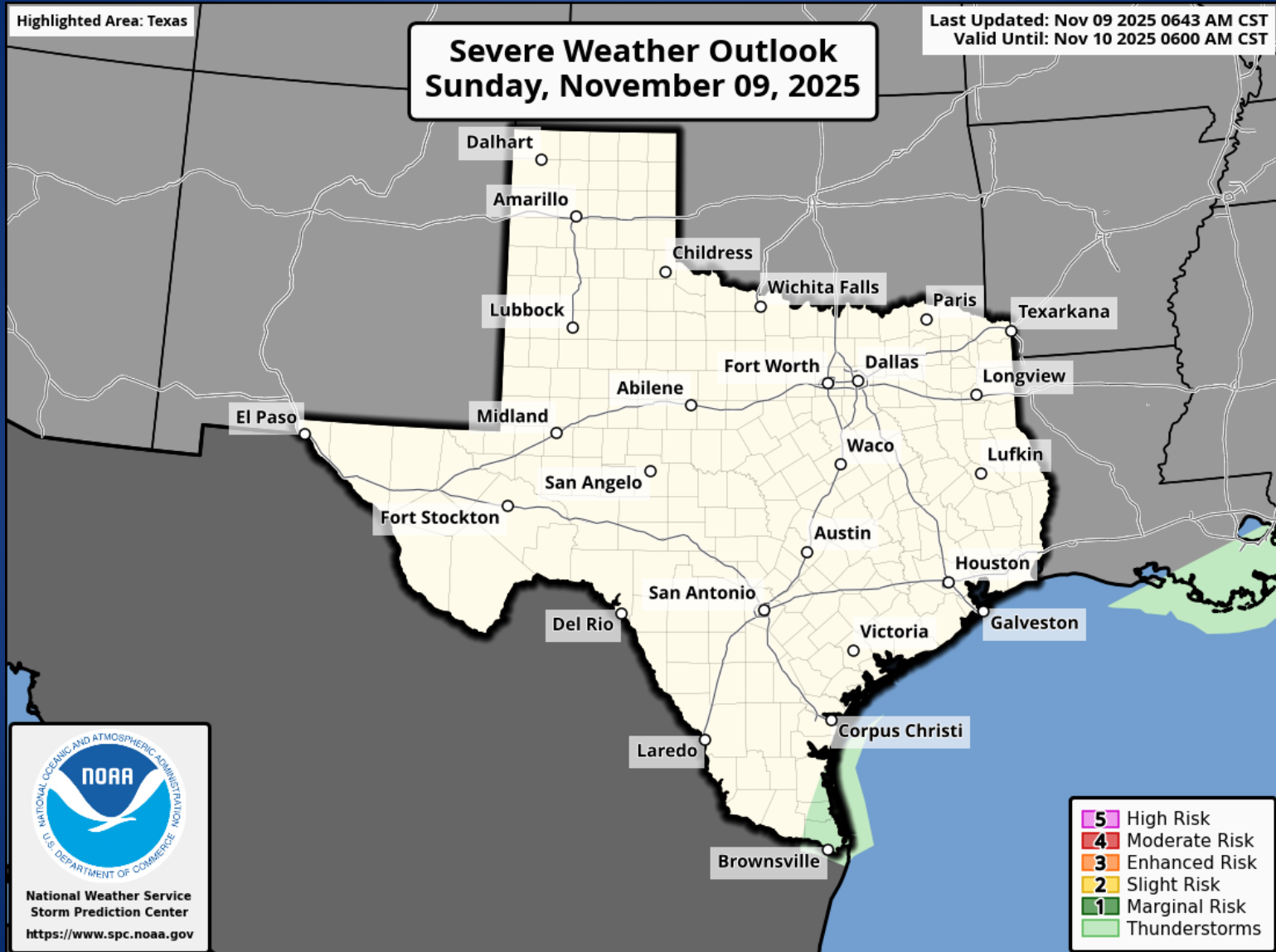

Widespread freezing temperatures expected tonight across the combined Panhandles. There is a potential for isolated areas to arrive at an overnight low a few degrees cooler than the forecast. Not everyone will reach that lowest potential, and the coldest temperatures may not last for a long period of time. Terrain and surrounding environment will play a role, and winds need to drop to zero mph to reach that coldest low temperature. The lowest temperatures expected just before and after sunrise, so don't forget those jackets and warm clothes in the morning.

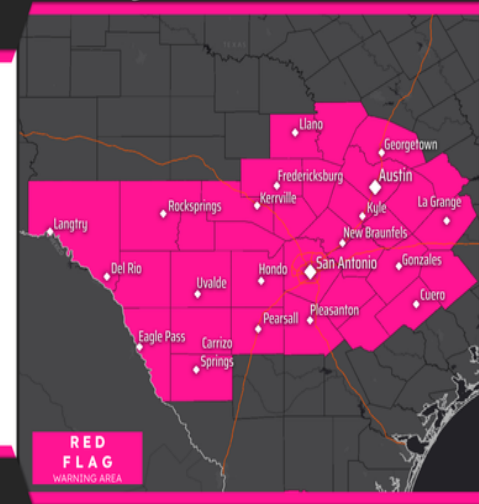

A Red Flag Warning is in effect for all of South Central Texas from 9 AM to 9 PM Sunday. North winds of 15 to 30 mph with gusts up to 40 mph, along with low relative humidity values and dry vegetation, will create weather conditions that favor the rapid spread of wildfires.

A Red Flag Warning is in effect from this morning through this evening for portions of Deep South Texas due to the combination of windy conditions and very low humidity.

The Fire Weather Watch has been upgraded to a Red Flag Warning for all South Texas from 9AM to 9 PM on Sunday. Winds will be gusty out of the N/NE 20-30 mph gusting to 40 mph and relative humidity values will drop to 15-20% behind a frontal passage. Rapidly drying fuels will lead to critical fire weather concerns. Please do your part to reduce open flames/sparks!

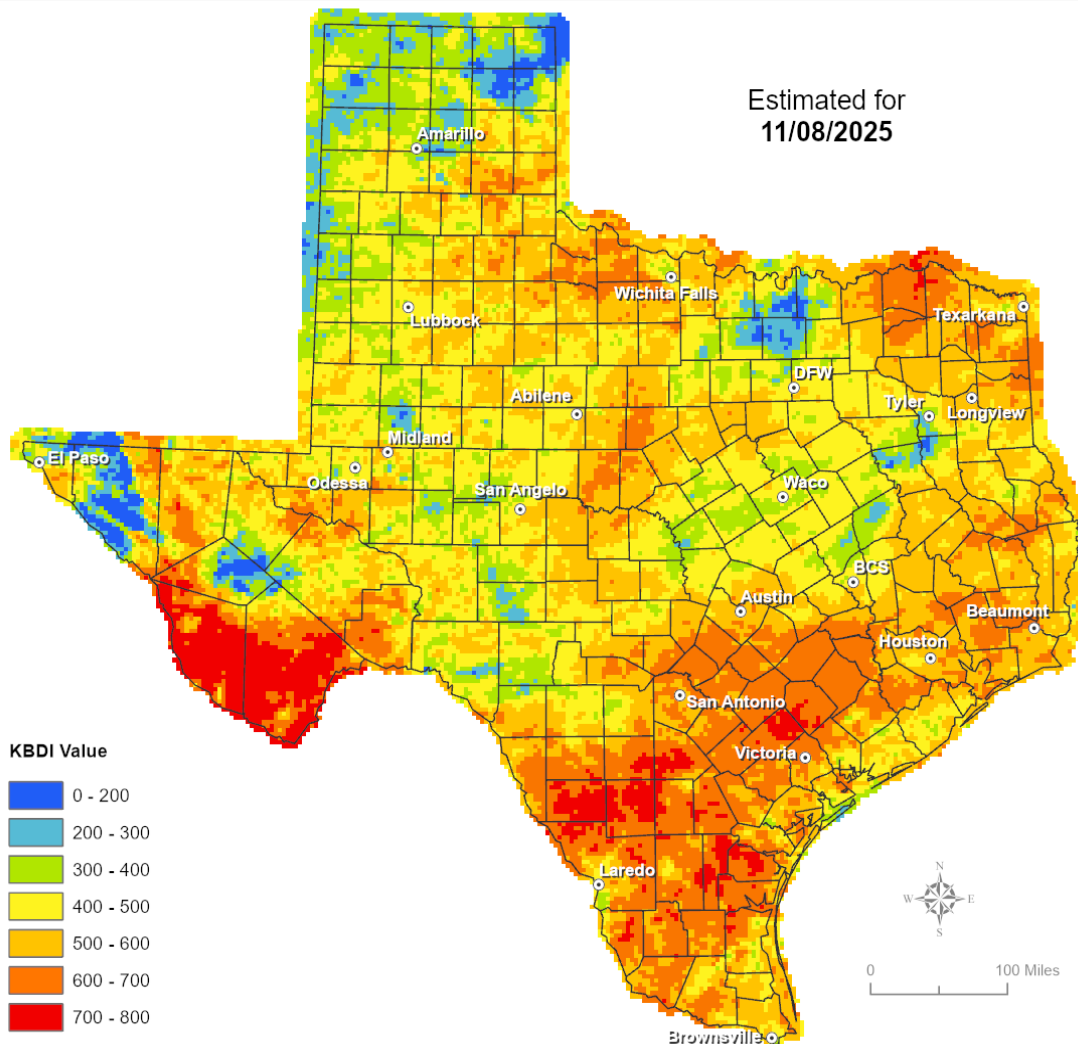

Report of 688 (No Change) fires and 98,508 (No Change) acres have been burned this year. There are 131 (No Change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 223 (+2) counties with an average over 400.
