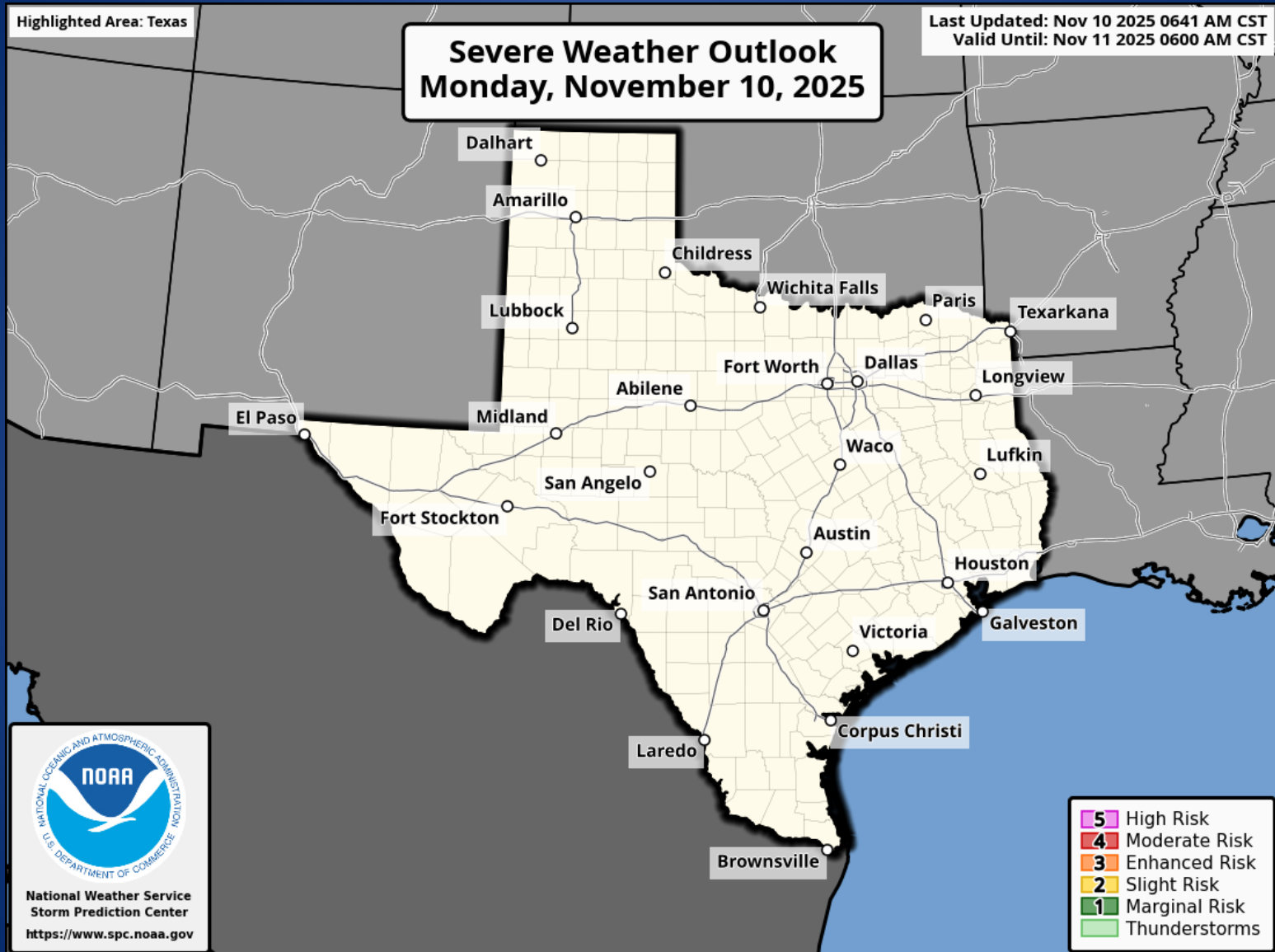

A HIGH SURF ADVISORY and a HIGH RISK of rip currents remain in effect at the local beaches.

With strong winds expected in the wake of the cold front, the Gale Watch has been upgraded to a Gale Warning beginning at 8 AM for the Gulf Waters. Prior to the Gale Warning, a Small Craft Advisory will be in effect from 5 AM this morning to 8 AM (when the Gale Warning begins) for the Gulf waters. For the bays and waterways of South Texas, the Small Craft Advisory will be in effect from 5 AM this morning until at least 6 PM Monday. A small craft advisory will also be needed for tomorrow once the Gale Warning ends (more details on the timing and winds in future forecast packages).

Freezing temperatures are again expected tonight/Tuesday morning across Southeast OK, Southwest AR, much of North LA, and portions of extreme Eastern TX.

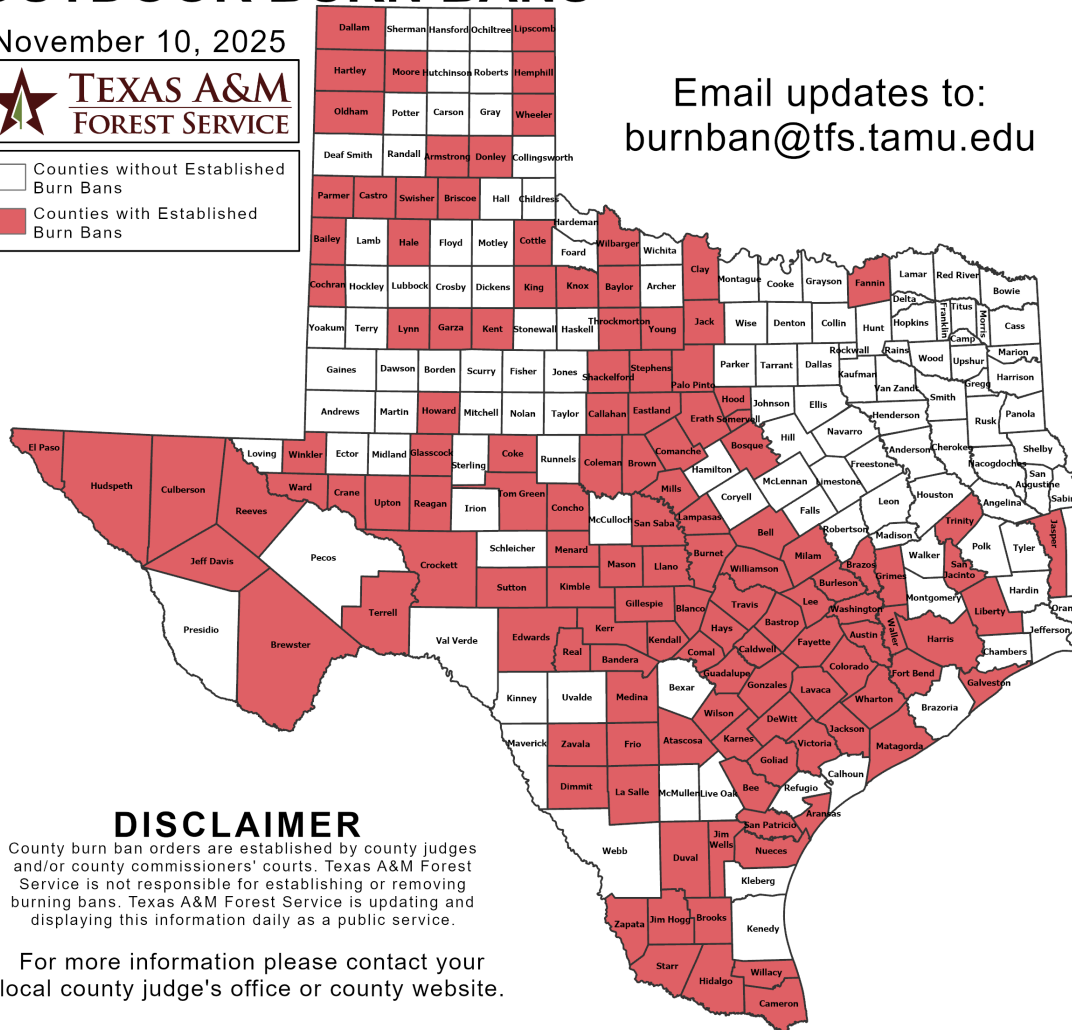

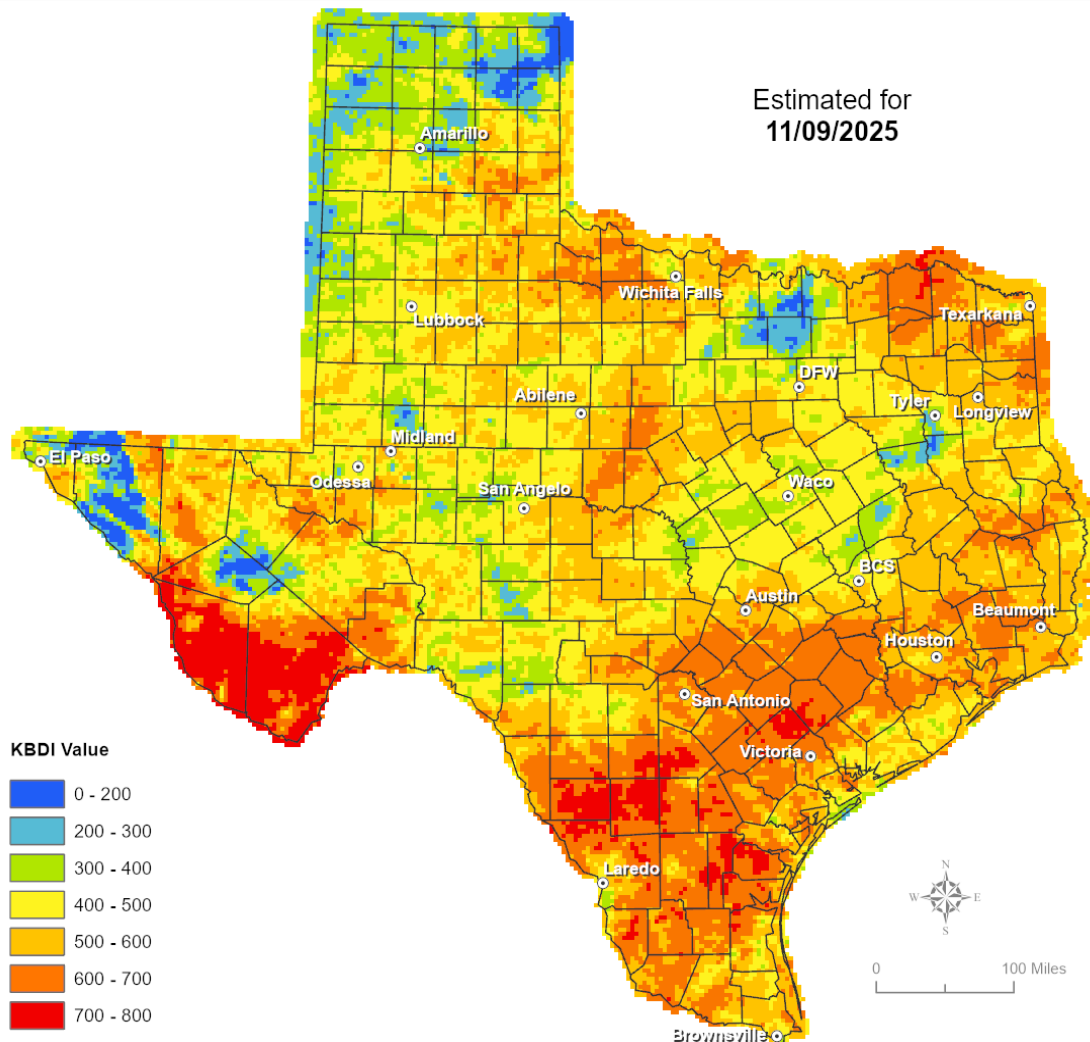

Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Report of 688 (No Change) fires and 98,508 (No Change) acres have been burned this year. There are 129 (-2) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 227 (+4) counties with an average over 400.
