For the bays and waterways of South Texas, the Small Craft Advisory will be in effect from 5 AM this morning until at least 6 PM Monday. A small craft advisory will also be needed for tomorrow once the Gale Warning ends (more details on the timing and winds in future forecast packages).



Due to the combination of gusty northerly winds and drier air in the wake of the cold front, a Red Flag Warning has been issued for all of Southeast Texas through 6 PM CST Monday. Obey burn bans and other restrictions. Avoid using anything that can cause sparks.

Chances remain high that temperatures tonight/Tuesday morning will fall to or below freezing across Southeast Oklahoma, Southwest Arkansas, much of North Louisiana, and portions of extreme Eastern Texas.

Remember the four P's:

- Be sure that PEOPLE have an adequate heating source and dress in layers if outside.
- Ensure PETS are brought inside or have a warm place protected from the cold.
- Take precautions now to protect any tender PLANTS.
- Wrap exposed outdoor PIPES that can be harmed by these cold temperatures.

Freezing temperatures are again expected tonight/Tuesday morning across Southeast OK, Southwest AR, much of North LA, and portions of extreme Eastern TX.





Fire Danger Forecast




Burn Ban

Keetch-Byram Drought Index



Report of 688 (No Change) fires and 98,508 (No Change) acres have been burned this year. There are 129 (-2) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 227 (+4) counties with an average over 400.
