# Critical Fire Weather Tuesday Most of South Central Texas → Winds: Southerly 10 to 20 mph → Gusts: Up to 30 mph → Relative Humidity: 15 to 30% → Dry to Critically Dry Fuels → Avoid outdoor burning → Keep vehicles off dry grass → Properly discard cigarettes NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE AUSTIN/SAN ANTONIO

A Red Flag Warning is in effect for all of South Central Texas today. The combination of gusty southerly winds (up to 30 mph), very low humidity (15-30%), and dry to critically dry fuels will create an environment where new fires can start and spread rapidly. Avoid outdoor activities that could inadvertently cause a wildfire.



Red Flag Warning in effect for portions of the Brazos Valley today. Southerly winds 10-15 mph. Gusts up to 25 mph. Relative Humidity as low as 22% in the afternoon. Any Fires that develop will likely spread rapidly. Outdoor burning is not recommended. Extreme caution should be used with any equipment that can cause sparks.



Elevated fire weather conditions are expected across Chaves County, NM and the Sacromento Foothills late this morning through the afternoon today. Avoid activities that may cause a spark, and report fires to local authorities!



A Red Flag Warning is in effect as below normal rainfall, low humidity values, and gusty winds combine across the area today. Any wildfires that get started may quickly grow out of control.

#### **Key Messages**

- → Elevated fire weather danger from western north TX into southwest and central OK.
- → Southwest winds of 10-20 mph with gusts up to around 30 mph.
- → Minimum relative humidity of about 20 percent.



#### **Timing**

→ Tuesday late morning and afternoon.











# **Keetch-Byram Drought Index**


