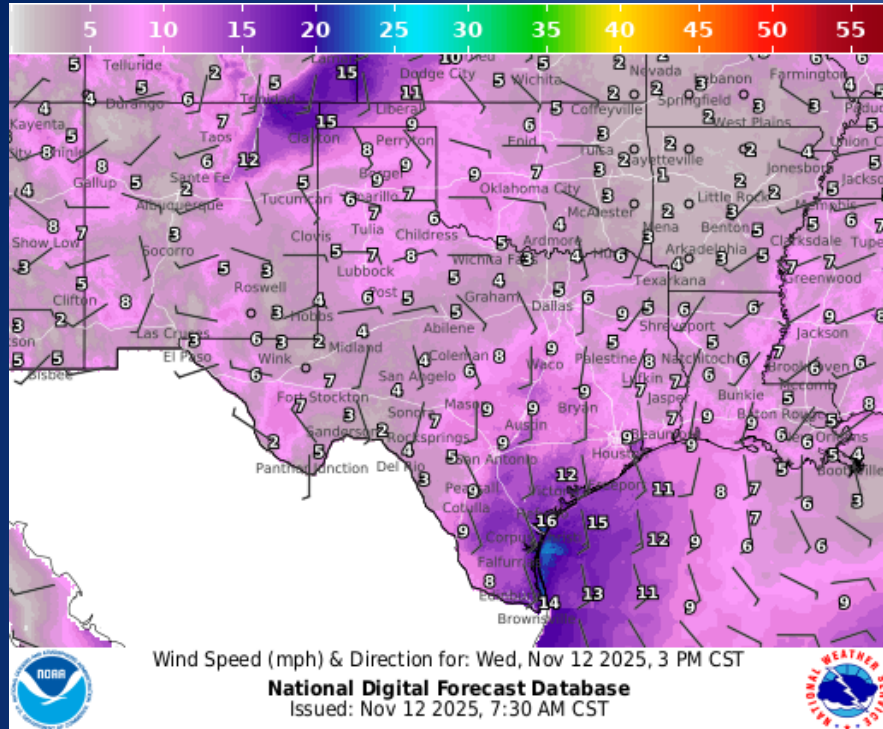

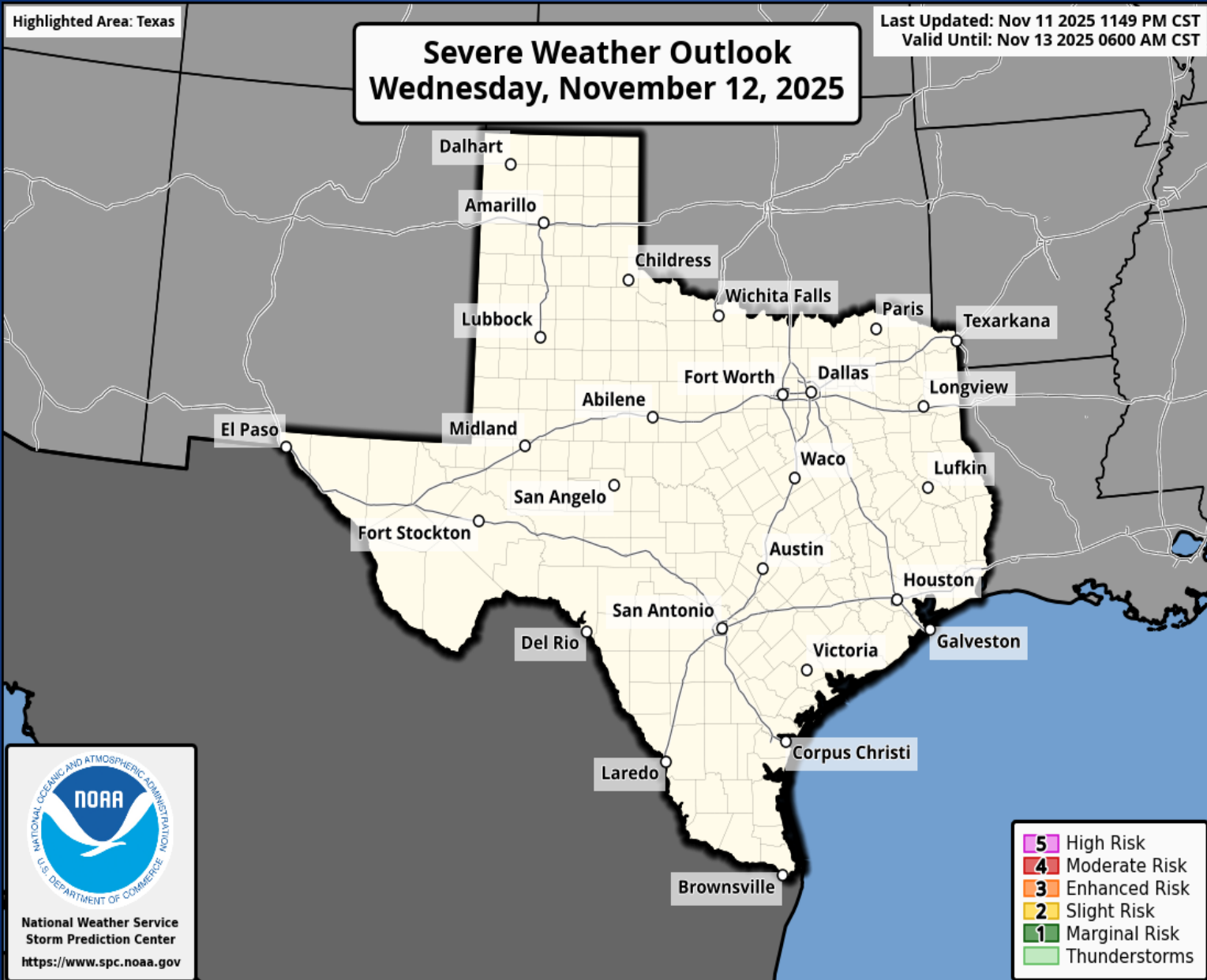


Wind Speeds

- Critically Dry Fuels

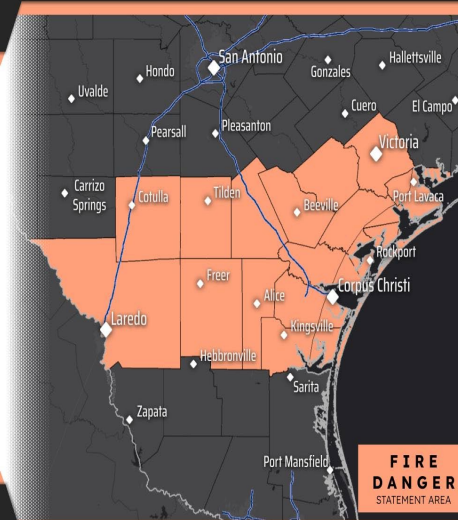


- Avoid open flames or sparks

A combination of low minimum relative humidity, moderate winds and critically dry fuels will lead to elevated fire weather conditions across all of South Texas.

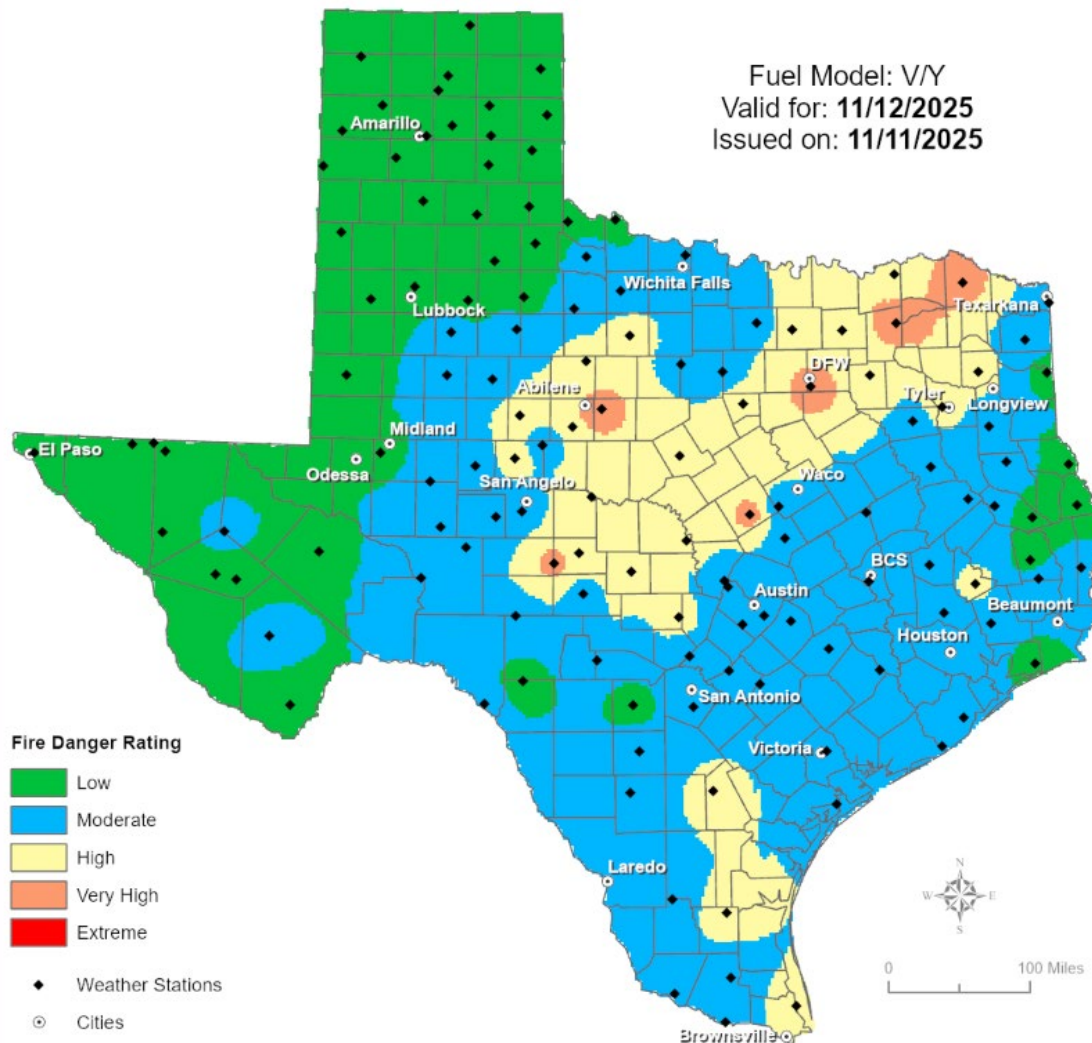

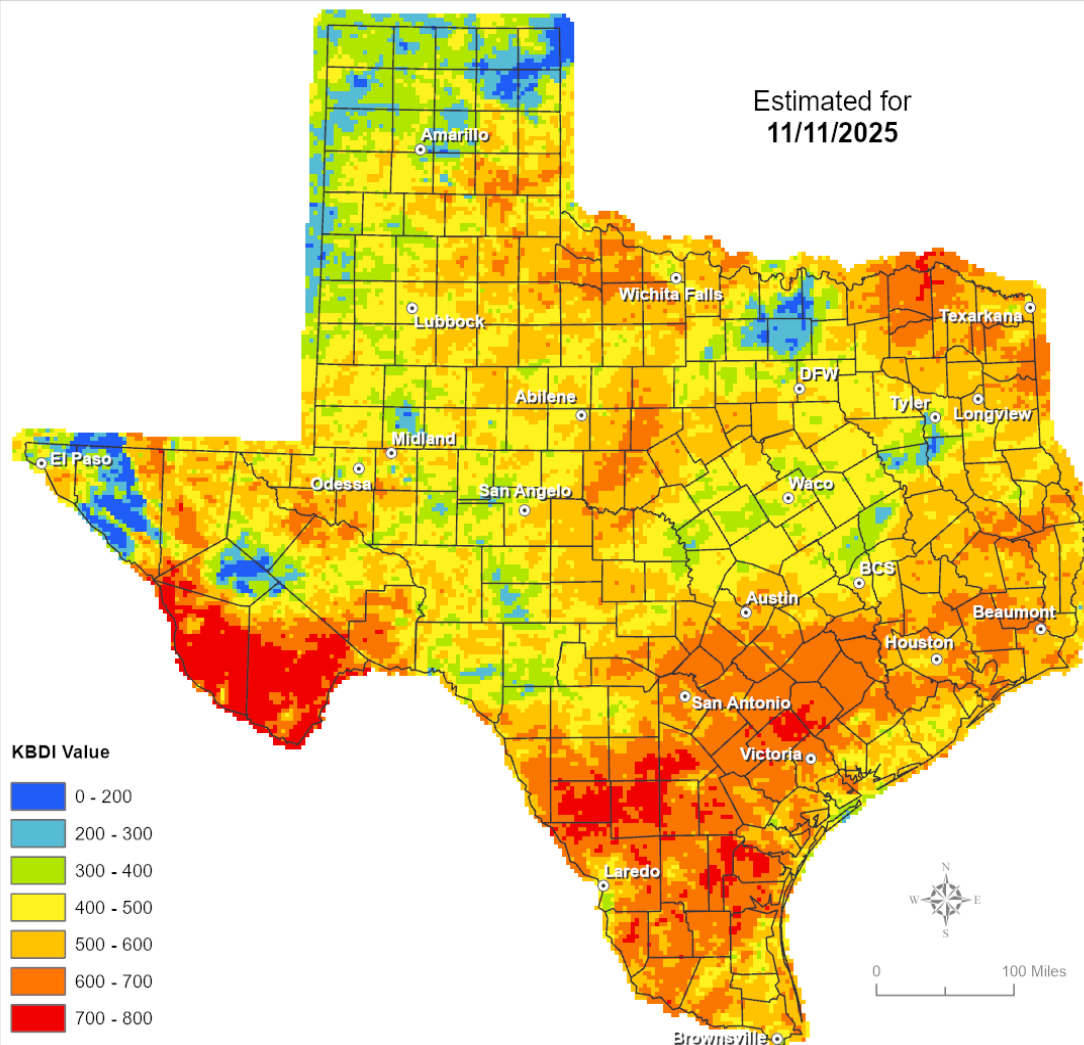

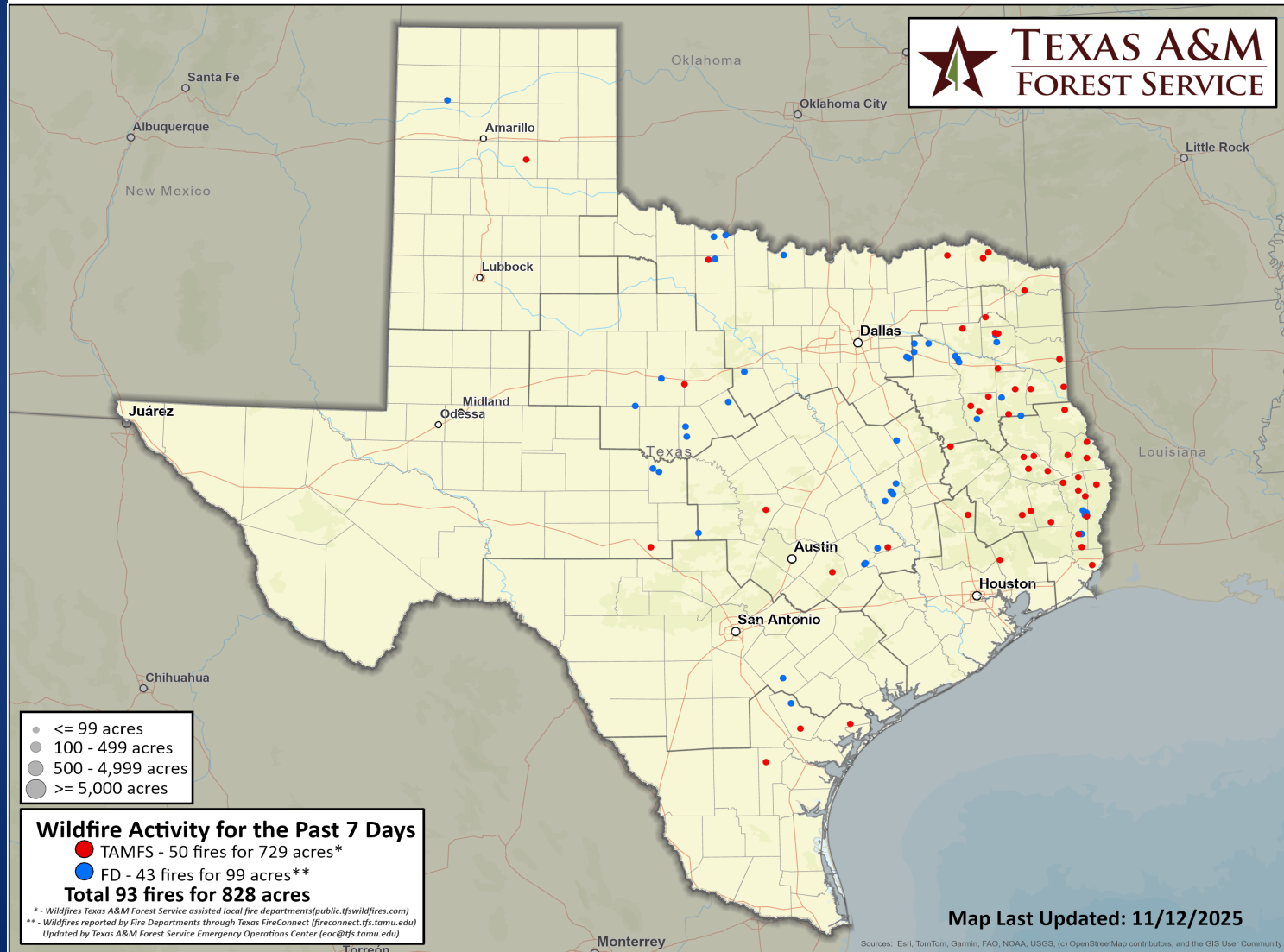

Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Report of 719 (+31) fires and 98,508 (+327) acres have been burned this year. There are 137 (+1) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 229 (No Change) counties with an average over 400.
