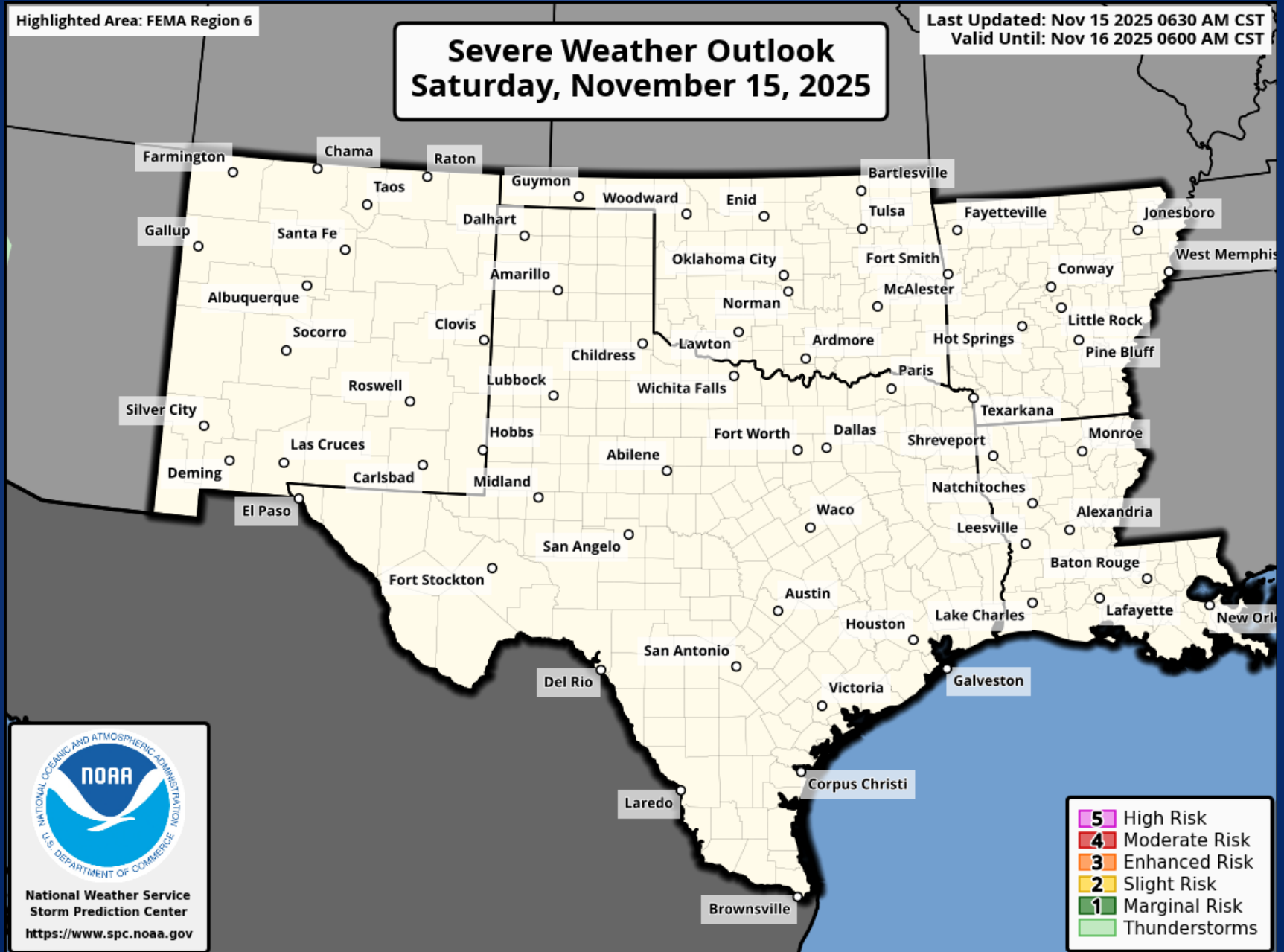

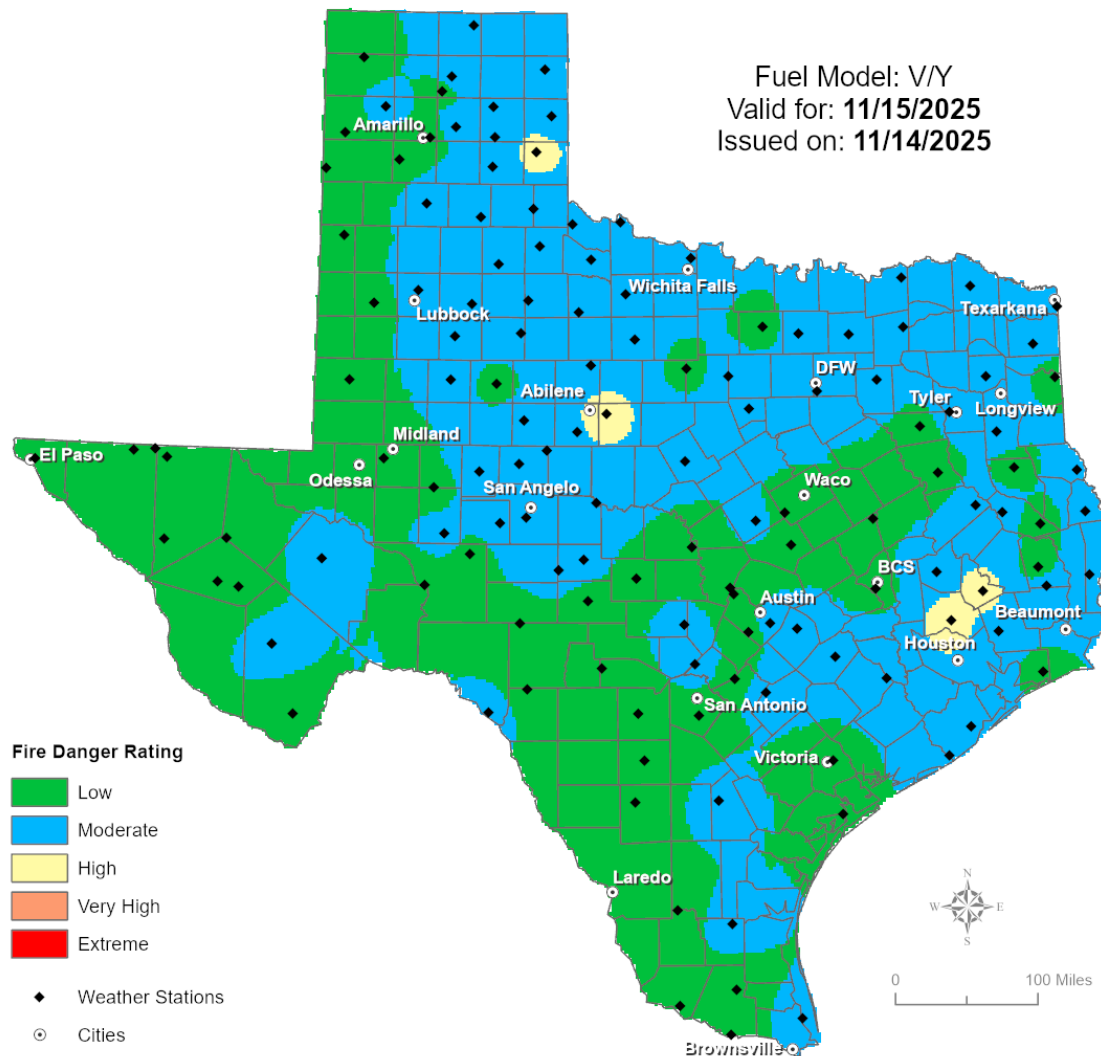

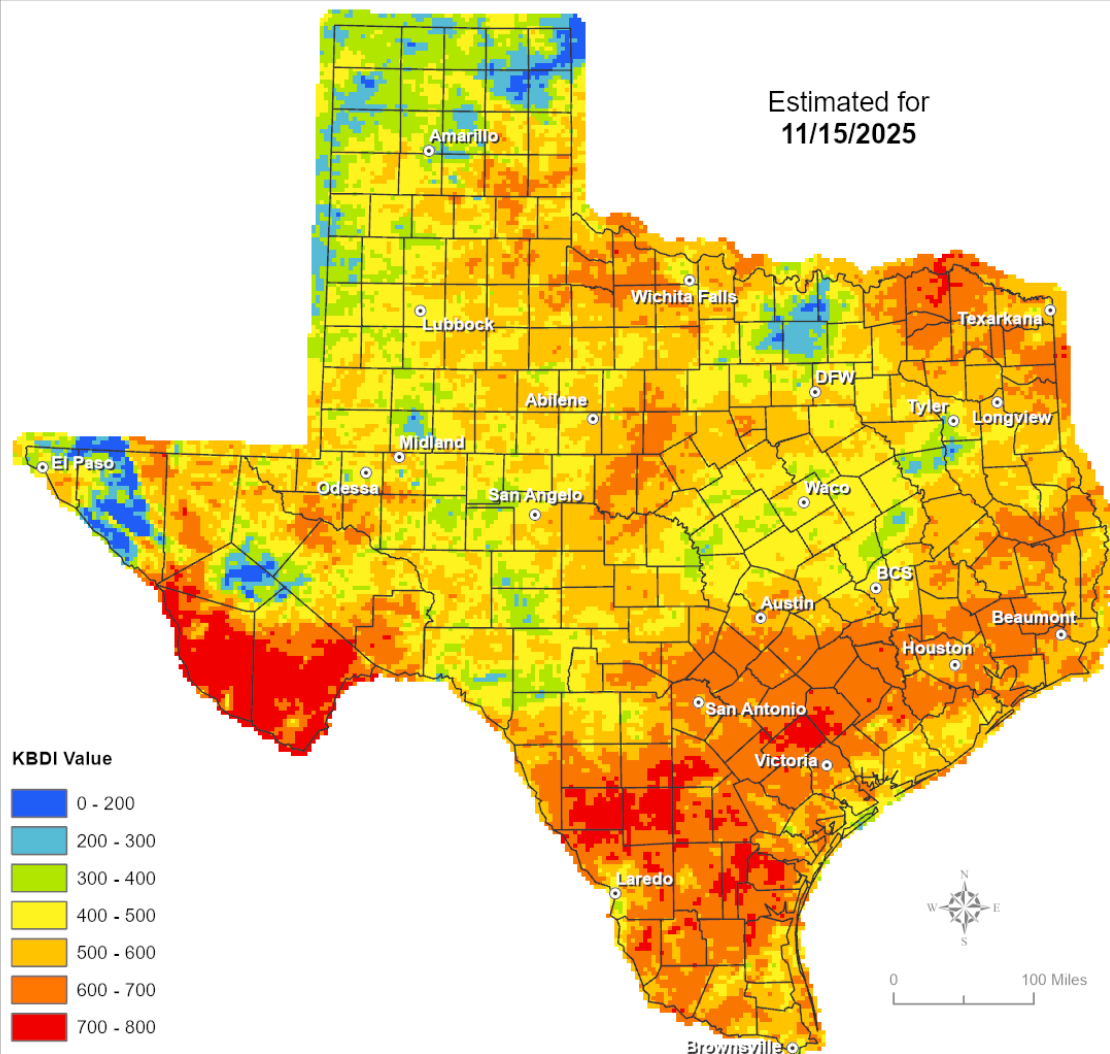

Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Report of 736 (None) fires and 99,249 (None) acres have been burned this year. There are 140 (no change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 231 (+1) counties with an average over 400.
