The latest updates indicate an increased chance of wind gusts exceeding 40 mph this afternoon. Due to this higher probability and the expected dry conditions, elevated fire weather is becoming more likely. This is particularly concerning across the Southern Texas Panhandle, where fuels have already demonstrated an ability to ignite. Please use caution when doing outdoor activities that might result in a spark and report any fires to authorities.


