**STATEWIDE CURRENT SITUATION:** On November 19, Governor Greg Abbott directed the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM) to increase the readiness level of the Texas State Emergency Operations Center (SOC) to Level III (Increased Readiness) in preparation for severe storms threatening the state.

On November 18, Governor Abbott directed TDEM to activate state emergency response resources ahead of potential severe weather expected to affect large areas of the state.

### OPERATIONAL PRIORITIES:

1. Protect life and property.
2. Support rapid & effective response.
3. Collect and disseminate accurate incident information to improve decision-making.
4. Accurately track incident costs associated with assigned resources for cost recovery.

### Region 2 (Includes DDs 3, 4, and 22)

DD 4 – Dallas/Ft. Worth (Includes Collin, Dallas, Denton, Ellis, Erath, Hood, Hunt, Johnson, Kaufman, Navarro, Palo Pinto, Parker, Rockwall, Somervell, Tarrant, and Wise Counties): On November 19, Disaster District Emergency Operations Center (DDEOC) 4 activated to Level III.

DD 22 – Sherman (Includes Cooke, Fannin, and Grayson Counties): [On November 19, DDEOC 22 activated to Level III.](#)

### **Region 6 (Includes DDs 17, 18, and 24)**

DD 17 – Victoria (Includes Calhoun, DeWitt, Goliad, Gonzales, Lavaca, Jackson, and Victoria Counties)

**Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service Texas Task Force 1 (TEEX/TX-TF1):**  
[TX-TF1 activated eight Swift Water Rescue boat squads, two Water Group Supervisors, and six Helicopter Search and Rescue swimmers.](#)

**Texas A&M Forest Service (TAMFS):**

[One Texas Intrastate Fire Mutual Aid System \(TIFMAS\) Strike Team \(ST\) is activated and pre-positioned in Kerrville. The ST consists of 22 personnel, two Type 1 Engines, two Type 3 Engines, two Type 6 Engines, and one Tender.](#)

**Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD):**

[TPWD has prepared and identified Statewide resources consisting of Texas Game](#)

Wardens and State Park Police Officers ready to support as needed in response to the increased Severe Weather Threat affecting the State of Texas. Resources include Swift Water Rescue boat teams, helicopters with hoisting capabilities, and UAS teams. TPWD Game Wardens are working closely with TDEM and other partners through the State Operations Center to ensure TPWD resources and first responders are available should they be needed.

**Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT):**

TxDOT is working to maintain safe roadways for the traveling public. As of 1:00 AM on November 20, no state-maintained road locations are impacted by weather.

**Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS):**

DSHS was requested to provide a DSHS Liaison Officer (LNO) and a State Coordination Officer (SCO) and a Medical Incident Support Team (MIST).

**Texas Emergency Medical Task Force (EMTF):**

EMTF assets have been activated to Kerr Co. to support the current incident 25-0039. They join EMTF assets already in Kerr Co. for incident 25-0026 who continue to work alongside state partners for search and recovery efforts.

**Texas Military Department (TMD):**

TMD has activated one Rotary Wing Medium Mission Ready Package (MRP) with hoist capability in support of TX-TF1. TMD has activated 72 personnel, 20 vehicles, and 2 aircraft.
