#### **Heavy Rain Potential Focusing North/West Of Our Area**

Locally Heavy Rainfall Can't Be Completely Ruled Out



#### Key Messages

- A weakening cold front will bring a line of showers and thunderstorms on Friday.
- Rainfall will be manageable, but an isolated strong storm with locally heavy rainfall can't be ruled out, especially north of the Houston
- Marginal Risk (level 1 of 4) of Excessive Rainfall mainly for areas north of Harris County
- Slight Risk (level 2 of 4) of Excessive Rainfall for the north Burleson and north Brazos Counties.



#### Timing

Potential for showers and a few storms will carry through the weekend, but will be lighter and more scattered.



Mostly manageable rainfall, but minor flooding can occur if highest rain rates occur over vulnerable locations.





Remain weather-aware, particularly if you have plans to be out late Thursday night/early Friday morning north of the Houston metro.





**Excessive Rainfall Outlook** 2

A weakening front will move across Southeast Texas on Friday. The heavy rain threat will be focused mainly north and west of our area, though some portions of Southeast Texas can't yet rule out isolated issues if a stronger storm occurs over a spot vulnerable to flooding. The front will continue to weaken as it moves towards the coast, and the heavy rain threat will begin to wane as it moves through the area.



There is a chance of excessive rainfall and urban flooding across portions of the Four State Region late Sunday and areawide Monday.





### **Fire Danger Forecast**




