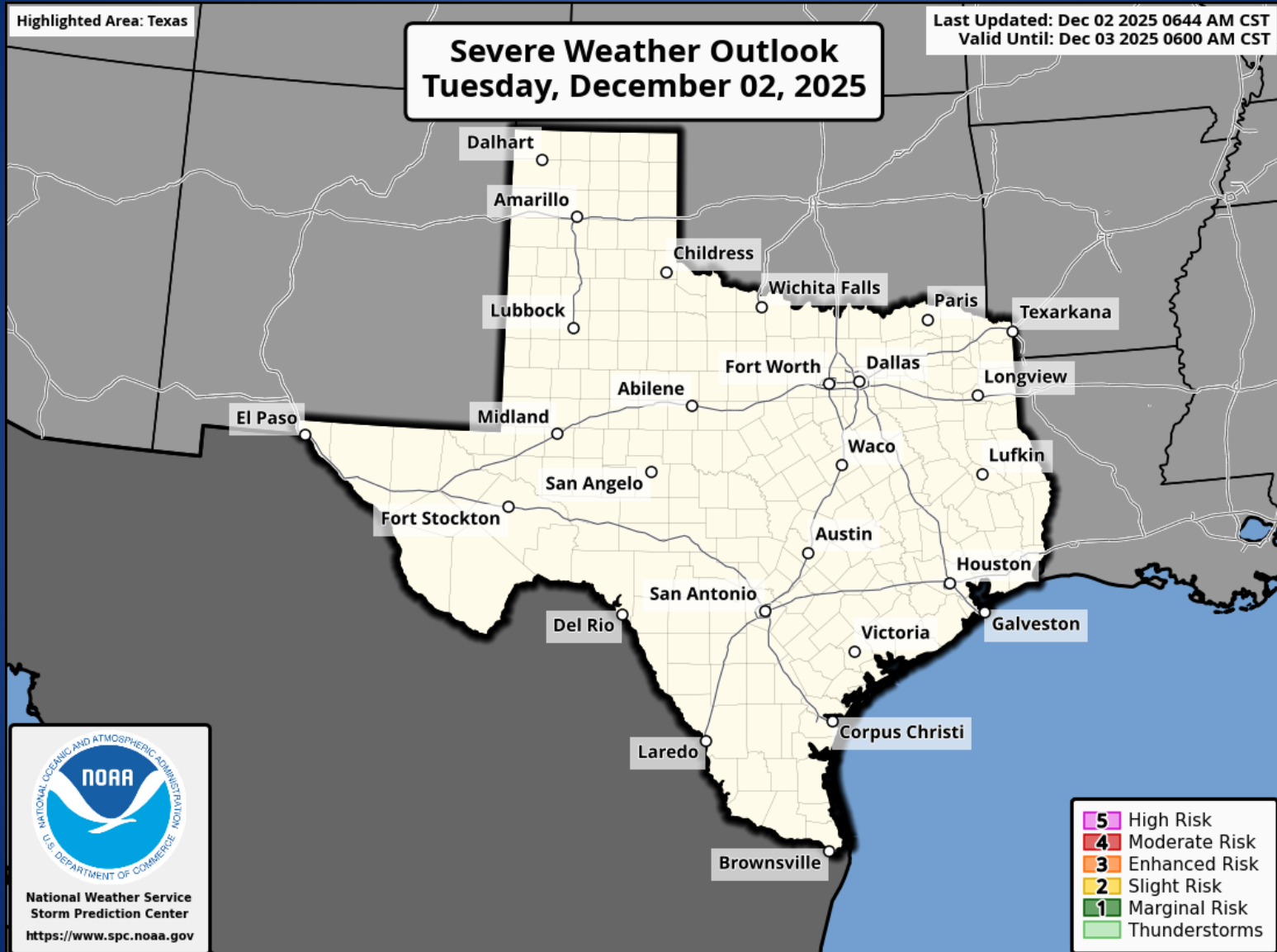

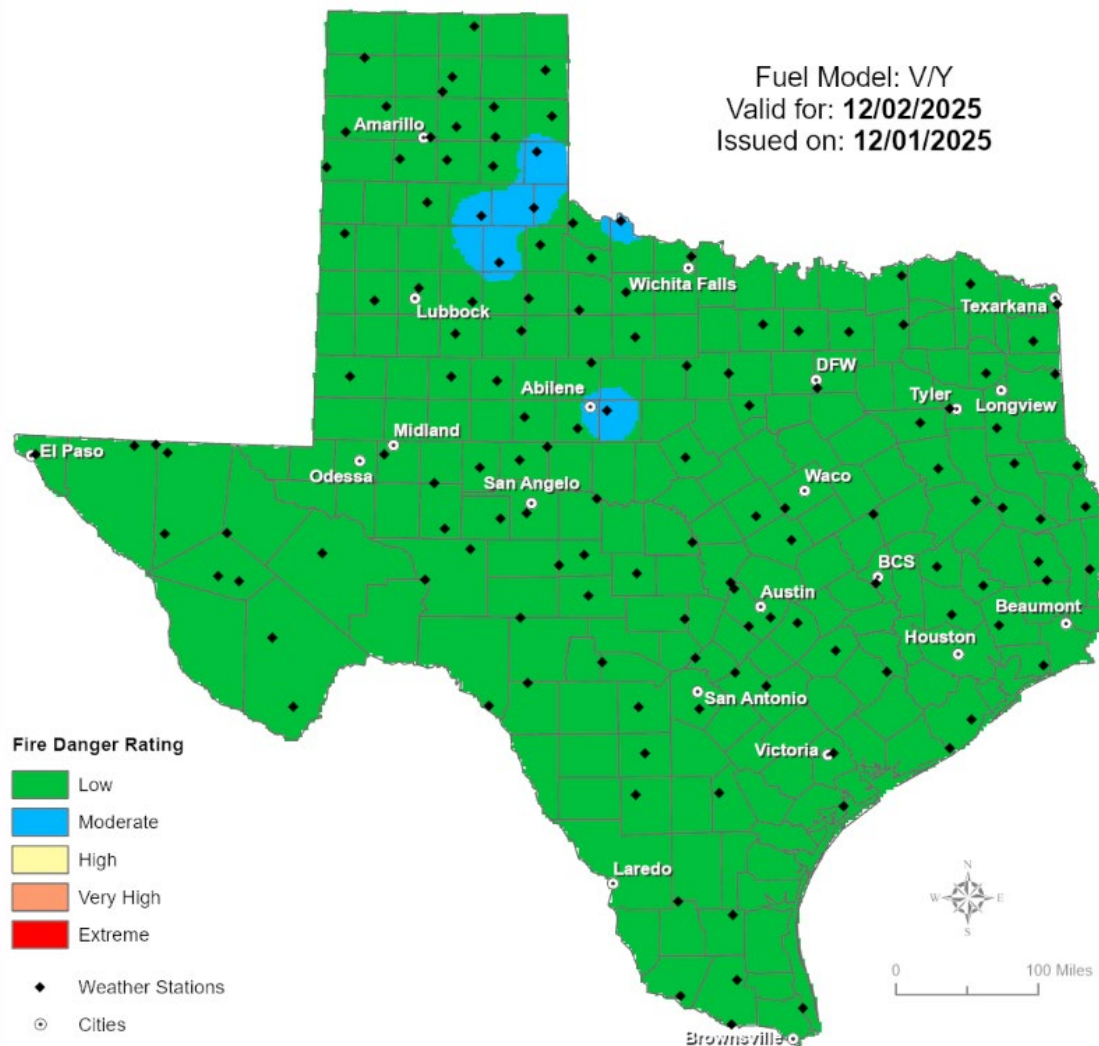

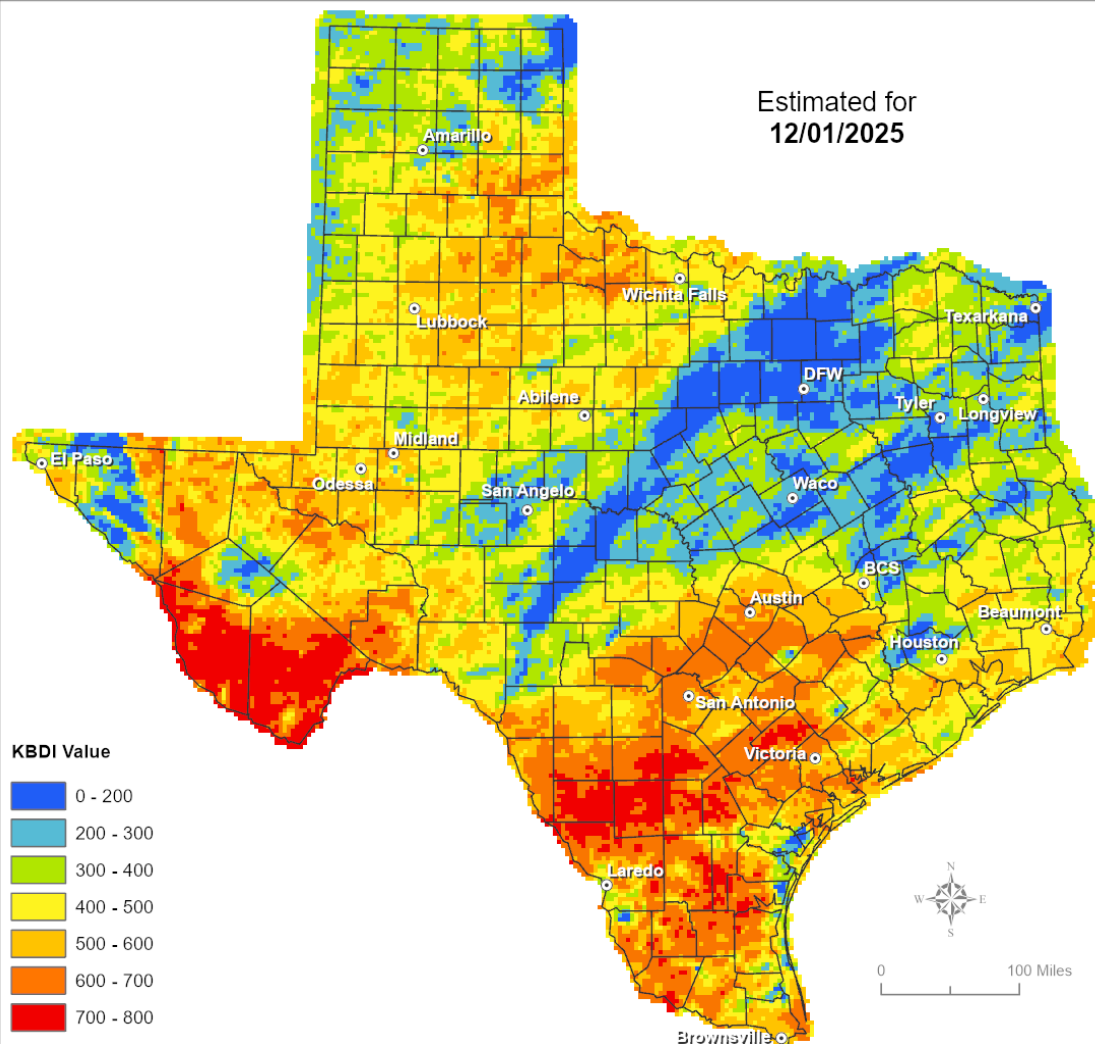

Keetch-Byram Drought Index

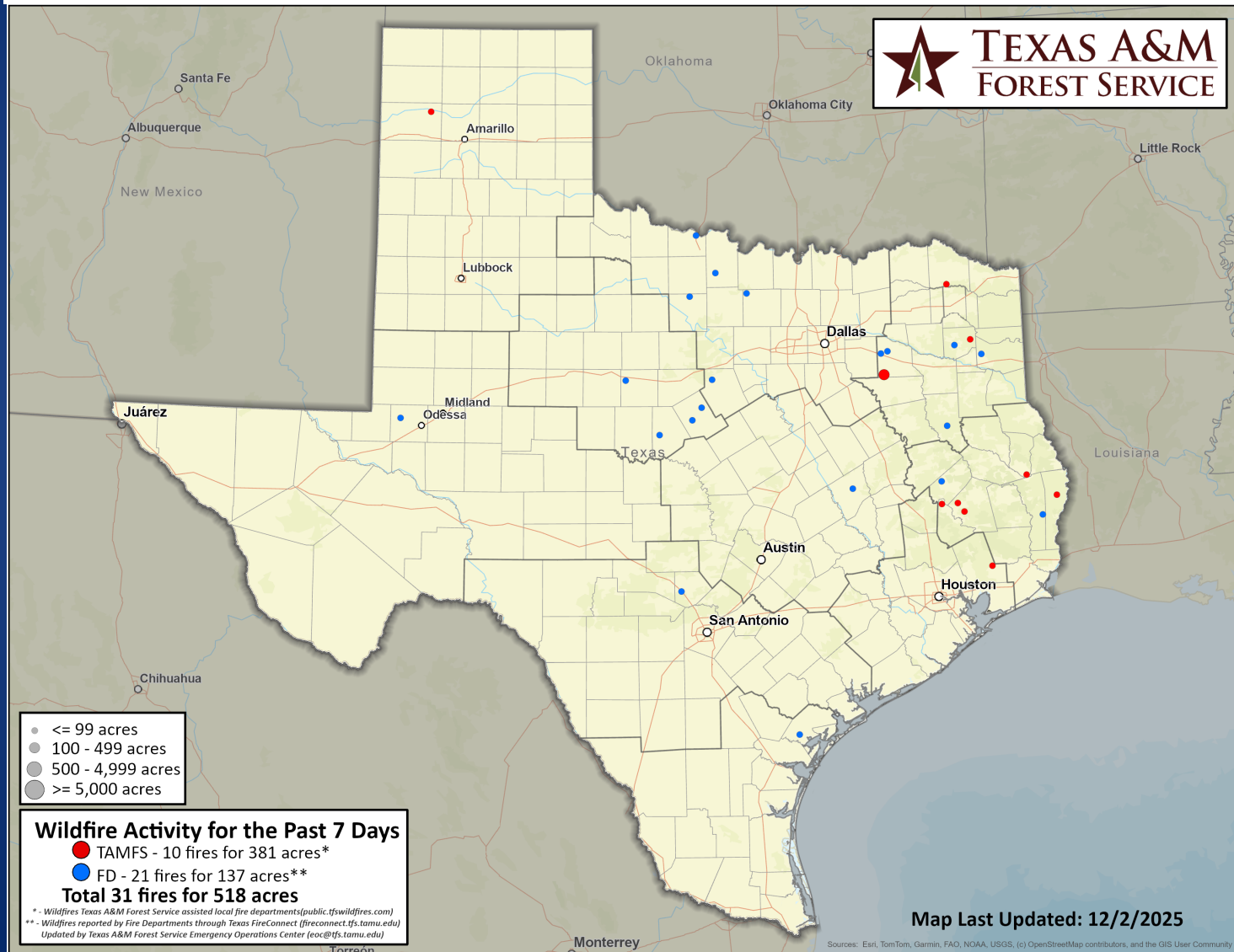
(4 km x 4 km resolution)

Report of 792 (+9) fires and 100,315 (+298) acres have been burned this year. There are 109 (-9) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 147 (-1) counties with an average over 400.
