
#### Saturday Morning Fog / Freezing Fog




Fog and freezing fog will continue to be possible across parts of OK and north TX through the midmorning hours. The fog could cause slick roadways and reduce visibility.



A Dense Fog Advisory remains in effect through 10 am this morning for areas mainly near and north of I-20. Visibility may drop to a quarter of a mile or less at times, so remember to slow down, use low beam headlights, and give yourself extra time to get to your destination.

#### **Hazardous Weather**




A High Wind Warning will be in effect for the Guadalupe/Delaware Mountains, including the Carlsbad Caverns from Noon CST/11 AM MST Saturday afternoon through 9 PM CST/8 PM MST Saturday evening. 

#### **Fire Danger Forecast**




#### **Burn Ban**

#### **Keetch-Byram Drought Index**


