#### • Fire Weather

 Elevated (level I of 3) fire weather concerns in the afternoons Today-Saturday for portions of E NM, OK, and TX.

#### • Severe Weather

 Marginal risk (level 1 of 5) for severe storms tomorrow in NE AR due to severe wind gust potential.

#### Flash Flooding

 Locally heavy rain through this afternoon in STX may lead to isolated flash flooding concerns in urban/poor drainage areas.



Note: Even though the image displays 5 days of forecasted rainfall, river forecasts only include 1-2 days of rainfall




No significant river flooding is expected.





















## Watches, Warnings, and Advisories

#### Wind, Severe, Winter, and Flood Hazards










High wind warning for N/C NM from 7 PM CT this evening through 10 AM CT tomorrow morning. Gusts up to 65 mph.






Marginal risk (level 1 of 5) for severe storms in NE AR. Wind gusts main threat.

Elevated (level 1 of 3) fire weather concerns for the TX/OK Panhandles, OK, N/CTX.




