




A cold front will move through during the day with an associated wind shift. Winds will shift from the south and southwest to the north by late morning with some gusts behind the front of 25 to 35 mph.





Elevated fire weather conditions are in store today across portions of west Texas and southeast New Mexico. Avoid outdoor burning activities today, and report fires to local authorities!






