




Wind Speeds



Seasonal & Breezy Conditions Today

Forecast High Temperatures

- Seasonal temperatures finally return to Southeast Texas with highs ranging from the upper 50s to mid 60s.
- Breezy conditions persist with 20-25 mph sustained winds and 30-35 mph gusts in the morning, then gradually reducing through the afternoon.
- Isolated light rain showers possible during the afternoon along/south of I-10.


