- **Minor with isolated moderate flooding in SE LA. Cresting and improvements after Wednesday. Impacts to homes and roads.**




Note: Numerical levels (e.g. level 1 of 4) will not be assigned to riverine flooding due to the varying levels of impacts across flood categories.


Minor to isolated moderate river flooding in SE LA will hold through the week with crests around mid-week. Impacts to homes and roads.

- **Tangipahoa River at Robert: Crests overnight. Entrance to Hidden Oaks campground under water.**
- **Bogue Chitto River near Bush: Crests Tuesday. Homes in low-lying areas downstream of Hwy 21 will flood.**
- **Bogue Chitto at Franklinton: Crests today. Bogue Chitto Heights Subdivision begins to flood, damaging some homes.**











Today's Tornado & Severe Wind / Hail Probabilities













Excessive Rainfall Outlook






Tomorrow's Tornado & Severe Wind / Hail Probabilities










Elevated (level 1 of 3) fire weather conditions in N/W-C TX.



December 30, 2025




