





Wind Speeds







A cold front will bring strong winds Wednesday into early Thursday. A Small Craft Advisory is in effect from noon Wednesday through early Thursday morning for the Gulf waters and the Bays. We are looking at northerly winds of 15-25 knots with gusts reaching 30 knots, along with seas building up to 7 feet. These conditions will be hazardous for smaller vessels, so if you're an inexperienced mariner, you'll definitely want to think about staying in port until things calm down later this evening.

An approaching cold front will move across the Middle Texas Coast and Gulf waters Wednesday afternoon through Thursday morning leading to hazardous conditions associated with a strong northerly winds and seas increasing to 5-7 ft. As such, a Small Craft Advisory has been issued for this period, with bays/waterways starting at 6 PM Wed and remaining in effect through 6 AM Thu.







Report of 65 (No Change) fires and 1,026 (No Change) acres have been burned this year. There are 135 (+1) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 188 (+3) counties with an average over 400.
